RACE 1 – LUXBET 2YO HCP– 1220 METRES

Prior to correct weight Anthony Darmanin, rider of **Remigny**, wished to view the official patrol films for the home straight. After doing so he was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Track was a soft six and was downgraded to a soft seven at 12.20 pm.

Gee Gee Cats - shifted in abruptly on jumping away, raced three wide without cover throughout. Performed below market expectations. Rider T Baker explained that after racing wide the gelding failed to respond to his riding from the 300 metres.

Gee Gees Saint Nik - inconvenienced on jumping away. Over raced in the middle stages, laid in in the home straight. Raced four wide without cover throughout.

Gee Gee Countryboy - rider Sigrid Carr reported that the colt raced greenly.

Gee Gees Americane - on jumping away had to be checked when tightened for room between **Boss Cat** which was taken outwards by **My Biddy**, and **Gee Gees Saint Nik** which was taken inwards by **Gee Gee Cats** which shifted in abruptly.

My Biddy – Laid in under pressure over the final 100 metres.

Luicille - slow into stride, 1 length

Remigny - near the 50 metres had to be restrained when disappointed for a run between **Need A Queen** (Chris Graham) and **My Biddy** (David Pires) which laid in under pressure. David Pires was reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding and notified that he must straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.

Track downgraded to a soft seven at 12.20 pm.

RACE 2 – SALVATION ARMY LONGEST LUNCH 2 JULY MAIDEN – 1420 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when the connections of the second placegetter **Manilenya** wished to view the official photo. After doing so they were satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Aly's Tycoon- raced greenly, performed below expectations. Rider Stephanie Thornton explained that the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions.

Dragonbite - passing the 1200 metres had to be restrained away from the heels of **Manilenya** (C Graham) which shifted in when not fully clear. Chris Graham was advised to exercise more care when allowing his mounts to shift ground.

Mighty Hoffa - raced three wide without cover throughout, before tiring from the 400 metres.

Victory Medal - performed poorly. Rider Bulent Muhcu explained that his saddle slipped shortly after the start placing him at a severe disadvantage. B Muhcu further added that the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions and was reluctant to stretch out. **Victory Medal** underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had not raced in excess of 12 months and was passed suitable to take its place in the race.

The track was downgraded to a heavy 8 at 1.00 pm.

RACE 3 – SENIORS FESTIVAL BM72 HCP – 1220 METRES

Naadam was a late scratching at 12.40 pm due to the downgrade in the track conditions.

Meconsul - performed below market expectations. Rider Troy Baker explained that the gelding was reluctant to stretch out in the prevailing conditions.

Classic Outlaw - performed below expectations. Rider Chantal Willis explained that the gelding raced keenly in the early stages and failed to respond to her riding from the 400 metres. Chantal Willis further explained that in her opinion the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions.

Kool Kash - slow into stride, 1 length.

RACE 4 – RF (BOB) FERGUSON MDN/CL1 – 2130 METRES

Please Dance (NZ) - over raced in the early stages when being restrained.

Aljazmic- inconvenienced passing the 1800 metres. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Cincha - performed below expectations. Rider Troy Baker explained that the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions.

Costly Affair - passing the 800 metres got its head up when over racing and shifted out abruptly inconveniencing **Aljazmic**.

RACE 5 – RAYNER TRANSPORT CLASS 2 HCP – 1220 METRES

Fragment - rider Brendon McCoull was reprimanded under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on eight occasions prior to the 100 metres.

West on Broadway - performed below expectations. Rider David Pires stated that the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions.

Swinging Ali - raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Mel Likes Vodka - trainer Mr John Hill was reprimanded under AR 140A(i) in that when saddling the mare, he failed to add the foam packing. In not taking any further action Stewards took into consideration that the weight of the missing object caused no alteration to the weight of the saddle and Mr Hill's unblemished record under this rule.

RACE 6 – E (TED) COX MEMORIAL BM62 HCP – 1220 METRES

Lady Jane was a late scratching at 2.06 pm due to the track downgrade.

Rougeau was a late scratching at 2.23 pm due to the downgrade of the track conditions.

Ty Dash - approaching the 100 metres held up for clear racing room and had to be restrained behind the tiring **What An Option**.

Gee Gees Style - bumped with **Time Commands** approaching the 100 metres.

Lazy Democracy - bumped on jumping away with **Rearview**.

Rearview - bumped on jumping.

Tillation - slow into stride, 1 length.

Qui Samer - rider Brendon McCoull was reminded of his obligations under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres.

RACE 7 – GARY WILSON BM62 HCP – 1620 METRES

Sir Marmaduke - over raced in the early and middle stages.

Strathalbyn - raced wide without cover throughout.

Glory Blaze - over raced in the early and middle stages. Rider Chantal Willis was advised of her obligations in relation to whip use when out of contention.

Geeges Lillybet - slow into stride, 1 length.

RACE 8 – ATA CELEBRATES 50 YEARS CLASS 1 HCP – 1420 METRES

Trusted Warrior - slow into stride, 1 length.

Gee Gees Cool Gal - bumped with **Give Us A Winner** on jumping away.

Give Us A Winner - bumped on jumping, raced wide without cover throughout.

Weekend Whisky - rider Troy Baker was reminded of his obligations under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres.

Country Way (NZ) - bumped approaching the 800 metres with **Weekend Whisky**.

Cousin White Foot - performed below market expectations. Rider David Pires stated that the mare travelled well in the run but failed to respond to his riding from the 600 metres and, in his opinion, failed to handle the track conditions.

GENERAL

Devonport DRC meeting - 4 June 2017 Race 6

Jockey Chris Graham **It's A Battle** was severely reprimanded under AR137(a) careless riding, in that near the 200 metres he permitted his mount to shift, tightening **Toakio Tower** onto **Spihro** resulting in **Toakio Tower** having to be restrained. In not taking any further action Stewards took into account the racing manners of **It's A Battle**.

Tasmanian Racing Club Trials - 30 May 2017

Trainer Scott Brunton was fined the sum of \$50 under AR87A(2) for leading horses without rearing bits.
