Trainer Scott Brunton was fined \$50 under LR 13.3 for the late notification of a rider on Telfi Hero in Race 2.

RACE 1 – WOLF BLASS 2YO MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 1100 METRES

Shackley's Hill – Slow into stride (1L). Inclined to lay in over the final 100 metres.

Bloomin' Late – Jumped awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride (1L).

La Superba – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection before being passed fit to race today.

Gee Gees Roughie – Brushed with **La Superba** near the 300 metres when attempting to obtain clear running.

The Greatness – Slow into stride (1L). Inclined to lay in in the home straight.

RACE 2 – SCHWEPPE'S PLATE MAIDEN 2YO & UPWARDS – SET WEIGHTS – 1400 METRES

Acheeva Dream – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Irish Jeff – Gelding caught its flank on the barrier gate and underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection behind the barriers before being passed fit to race today.

Mighty Hoffa – Jumped outwards at the start bumping with **Irish Jeff**. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Fancy Danz – Slow into stride.

Manilenya – When passing the 400 metres, laid in under pressure and bumped with **Mighty Hoffa**. Rider David Pires stated that the filly raced flat between the 600 – 400 metres and in his opinion the filly has come to the end of its preparation.

Miss Che Che – Rider Sigrid Carr was issued with a severe reprimand under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) for using her whip eight (8) times prior to the 100 metres.

RACE 3 – LUXBET PLATE 3YO MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 1200 METRES

Hot Chisel – Raced greenly.

Houndstooth – When questioned, Rider Sigrid Carr explained that it was not her intention to lead, however, she jumped well and with little pace to her inside she elected to stride forward and take up the lead. Miss Carr further explained that the gelding then commenced to race keenly through the middle stages before failing to run on in the home straight.

Candlepins – Slow into stride (1L). Laid in in the home straight.

Jewels – Jumped awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride (1L)

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP – 2100 METRES

Accounted Four – Caught wide in the early stages before electing to stride forward. Performed below market expectations today. Rider S Carr explained that the gelding travelled well, however, failed to respond to her riding from the 700 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Centafloreal – Had to be resaddled behind the barriers.

RACE 5 – CROWN LAGER CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Love Magic – Slightly inconvenienced after the start when **Time Commands** shifted out. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Near the 150 metres, momentarily steadied between **Time Commands** and **Winston Wolfe** (D Pires) which shifted in under pressure. D Pires was advised to exercise care when allowing his mounts to shift ground.

You Didn't – Passing the 800 metres, had to be checked when tightened for room by **Time Commands** (Chris Graham) which shifted in. At a subsequent inquiry Stewards found Apprentice Chris Graham, the rider of **Time Commands**, guilty of a charge of careless riding under AR 137(a) in that when passing the 800 metres he allowed his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of **You Didn't** resulting in that gelding having to be checked when shifting in and as a result inconveniencing **Qui Samer**. The interference and carelessness were both deemed to be of a medium level. After taking into account submissions on penalty, Chris Graham's licence to ride in races was suspended for two (2) Tasmanian race meetings to be served cumulatively with any decision handed down by the Appeals Board.

Time Commands - Rider Chris Graham was issued with a severe reprimand under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip seven (7) times prior to the 100 metres

Giselle's Girl – Rider Troy Baker reported that the filly over-raced throughout.

RACE 6 – CARLTON DRAUGHT CLASS 5 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when Jockey S Amano, rider of the fifth placegetter **Col's Hero**, asked to view the official film. After doing so Jockey Amano was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Hugo – Shortly after jumping, had to be restrained off the heels of **True Lady's Man** which shifted out. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Caffeine Hit – Rider D Pires stated that the mare was inclined to lay out and in his opinion was disappointing in the home straight. D Pires was reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.

Col's Hero – Rider S Amano accidentally dropped his whip near the 150 metres.

Lazy Democracy – Soon after the start, restrained when tightened for room between **Count Montagu** which shifted in and **Col's Hero**.

True Lady's Man – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 7 – TRC MEMBERS SPRINT BENCHMARK 82 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Prior to correct weight it was established that Shuji Amano rider of 6th placegetter past the post Ollie's Gold had weighed in 600g under its allotted weight. Ollie's Gold was disqualified under the provisions of AR.143.(a).

A subsequent inquiry has been adjourned to consider evidence tendered from Shuji Amano, Clerk Of Scales Jill Doherty and Foreman David Moore.

Steel Moon – Rider Chris Graham pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on eleven occasions prior to the 100 metres which is six more than the permitted number under this Rule. After considering submissions on penalty and taking into account Chris Graham's record in relation to this Rule, he was subsequently fined \$300.

Ollie's Gold – Shortly after jumping, had to be restrained when tightened between **Naadam** and **Gee Gees Style**.

Gee Gees Style – Knuckled on jumping. Passing the 1000 metres restrained when momentarily tightened for room between Issawi which shifted out slightly and Steel Moon shifted in slightly.

RACE 8 – SKY / ATA TRAINERS' TRUST CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Sebring's Joy - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

O'Loughlin - Harmlessly dislodged Rider Troy Baker en-route to the barriers. Troy Baker was examined by the on-course ambulance and passed fit to take his ride. The gelding underwent a veterinary inspection and was passed fit to take its place in the race. Raced four wide without cover until obtaining cover near the 500 metres.

Sugar Free - Had to be resaddled behind the barriers. Jumped outwards carrying **Bandit Ruby** out onto **Pop A Lefty**

Poacher's Son – Slow into stride (1L).

The Desperate – Slow into stride (1L).

Our Queenie - Had to be resaddled behind the barriers.
