Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

RACE 1 – REXEL NORTH HOBART PACE – 2090 METRES

After being caught wide in the early stages UCARNTBEATAMINT (Paul Williams) was restrained to the rear before then pursuing a peg line run.

CARLAS HEAVEN (Robert Walters) was fractious in the pre-start circle. The filly then hung in in the score up and was out of position at the start. CARLAS HEAVEN has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

Driver Paul Ashwood (LYNNIEMACH) was reprimanded under AHHR156(2) for using his whip in a free hand manner on two occasions in the home straight.

KARALTA KRUISE (John Walters) which led the event then shifted out under pressure in the home straight and underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no apparent abnormalities.

RACE 2 – GREEN ELECTRICAL PACE – 2090 METRES

Trainer Ben Yole (TENFOUR) advised that with gate speed drawn to the inside TENFOUR would look to be restrained, and driven with a sit, circumstances permitting. Stewards approved the change of tactics and the gelding was driven accordingly. TENFOUR (Gareth Rattray) broke shortly before the start was effected and caused interference to runners on the second line and a false start was called. TENFOUR has now been placed out of the draw for future mobile start events. TENFOUR tired over the concluding stages.

ULTIMATE COURAGE (Todd Rattray) pulled hard whilst leading.

WILLIAMTELL (Paul Ashwood) after leading the three wide train up from the bell then commence to tire significantly from the 500 metres. Trainer/driver Paul Ashwood advised that the gelding hadn't felt comfortable in the run and had a tendency to both hang out and strike

its offside knee. After viewing the films of the race Stewards accepted Mr Ashwoods explanation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities. Mr Ashwood added that he would now have blood tests taken from the gelding and would advise of the results of those tests and that he may look to spell the gelding which has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

As WILLIAMTELL (Paul Ashwood) commenced to give ground rapidly from the 500 metres FLASH ANATAOMY (Robert Walters) was inconvenienced behind that runner and momentarily raced rough after contacting the outside sulky wheel of the tiring WILLIAMTELL.

REGAL MAJOR (Rohan Hillier) raced rough whilst being restrained at the winning post on the first occasion.

A post-race swab sample was taken from LOCKAWAY KACIE, the winner of the event.

RACE 3 – LUXBET.COM PACE – 2090 METRES

ONEMORELAUGH (Samantha Gangell) unsuccessfully contested the lead into the first turn. The gelding then commenced to pull hard before racing to the lead, racing off the back straight on the first occasion when KVITOVA LEIS (Todd Rattray) elected to surrender the lead at that point. The gelding then tired over the concluding stages of the event

After beginning well from its outside front row draw and then racing with a favourable trailing position WHENTHEGROUNDHOOK (Gareth Rattray) commenced to tire from the 300 metres and underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no apparent abnormalities. The mare has been placed on her last chance to race competitively. Subsequent to the race meeting trainer Ben Yole reported that the mare had pulled up flat after the race and would not be nominated next week.

ORIGIN BILLY (Paul Mascall) was caught wide in the early stages and then raced ungenerously as driver Paul Mascall restrained to the rear of the field. ORIGIN BILLY then tired and lost contact with the field from the 700metres and was beaten 117 metres. ORIGIN BILLY has been stood down from racing for 10 Days and until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

OLWEN JACCKA NZ (Rohan Hillier) which was fractious and had to be held in the pre-start circle was then out of position at the start and will continue to be placed out of the mobile draw.

BOLTNMACH (A Collins) had a tendency to pull hard.

OLWYN JACCKA NZ (Rohan Hillier) and LORD JONES NZ (Robert Walters), momentarily locked stays upon entering the home straight.

RACE 4 – GO RACING TASMANIA PACE – 1609 METRES

Trainer Christian Salter (THATSWHATSHE SAID) was fined the sum of \$50 under the provisions of AHRR210 for a late driver notification.

PUSHKIN NZ (Samantha Gangell) was held up for clear racing room rounding the home turn and in the early part of the home straight before then gaining clear running however did not run on over the final stages. Stewards queried driver S Gangell as to her reasons for conceding her position outside the leader at the 500 metres. Ms Gangell stated that her drive, which normally races keenly had dropped the bit at that point of the race and then again picked up the bit after being crossed. Ms Gangell was advised to use better judgement in similar circumstances in future.

CHRISTIAN JAZ NZ (Jack Laugher) was held up and unable to obtain a clear run over the concluding stages.

THATSWHATSHESAID (Taylor Ford) was reluctant to score up and was out of position at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

Stewards inquired into the reasons for KWIATKOWSKI (Christian Salter) being checked and breaking in the home straight. After taking evidence from drivers Christian Salter (KWIATKOWSKI), Robert Walters (IM FULL TILT NZ), Todd Rattray (LA EBONY KITA) and Ricky Duggan (OUR PERCIUS NZ) Mr Duggan pleaded not guilty to a charge under AHRR163(1)(a)(iii) for causing interference. The particulars of the charge were that as a result of his shift LA EBONY KITA was taken out towards IM FULL TILT NZ which was in turn taken outwards and as a consequence it's sulky wheel was then contacted by KWIATKOWSKI. Mr Duggan pleaded not guilty to the charge however after giving due consideration to all of the evidence and the films, Stewards sustained the charge against Mr Duggan. In determining penalty Stewards considered the nature of the shift and the subsequent interference and that contact had occurred to KWIATKOWSKI resulting in it breaking. Stewards also considered Mr Duggan's good record and his licence to drive in races was suspended for 2 race dates commencing midnight 16th July 2017 and expiring midnight 23rd July 2017.

A post-race swab sample was taken from OUR PERCIUS NZ, the winner of the event.

RACE 5 – CROWN LAGER PACE – 2090 METRES

There were no claims in this race.

REGAL STRIDE NZ (Robert Walters) galloped away and has been placed out of the draw in future standing start events.

YAHOLYTERROR NZ (Ricky Duggan), galloped out and will continue out of the draw in future standing start events.

A post-race swab sample was taken from JUKEBOX MUSIC, the winner of the event.

RACE 6 – HOBART BELMONT 2YO PACE – 1609 METRES

BETTERTHANLIFE (Todd Rattray) hung in and raced rough near the 700 metre mark. The filly then raced rough before breaking racing off the back straight on the final occasion and then sustained two broken hopple loops whilst galloping. BETTERTHANLIFE was then retired from the event by driver Todd Rattray. Stewards inspected the filly's gear and found it to be of good quality. BETTERTHANLIFE has been placed on its last chance to race truly. As a consequence of BETTERTHANLIFE (Todd Rattray) breaking in the back straight BEATRIX LYN (Matthew Howlett) was inconvenienced and was then taken back to the peg line by its driver.

Driver Adrian Collins (CLASS TELLS) was reprimanded under AHRR163(3) for half carting for a short distance racing towards the 1200 metres.

TWENTY TWO KARAT (Gareth Rattray) had a tendency to hang out at the winning post with a lap to travel.

A post-race swab sample was taken from BOUQUET OF ROSES, the winner of the event.

RACE 7 – TAS PACING CLUB ON FACEBOOK PACE – 2090 METRES

SUTTER MAN (Robert Walters) pulled hard in the score up and whilst leading the race and then tired to finish beaten 53 metres. Mr Walters explained that he had been unable to settle the gelding after obtaining the lead. With the gelding being unable to settle during moderate early sectionals he then allowed it to stride forward in the second quarter in an attempt to allow the gelding to find some rhythm, however SUTTER MAN then tired. SUTTER MAN has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

BAYRIDGE BILL (C Salter) hung in noticeably in the score up.

JIVIN CULLEN NZ (Rohan Hillier) was under pressure from the 650 metres and gave ground rapidly from the 400 metres to finish distanced. The gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no apparent abnormalities. JIVIN CULLEN has been stood down from racing for 10 days and until the completion of a satisfactory trial. Subsequent to the race meeting trainer Ben Yole reported that an ECG test carried out on Monday 17/7 had shown no abnormalities and that possible signs of a minor respiratory condition were detected upon endoscopic examination. He further advised that blood samples had been taken and that he would advise Stewards of the results of those tests.

A post-race swab sample was taken from BAYRIDGE BILL, the winner of the event.
