RACE 1 – MIXED 4/5 (1) – 461M

Metanoia Franko was slow out. Approaching the first turn Dame Kirra eased, soon after Dan Road crossed to the rail. At the same time Isala Bale checked off the heels of Dame Kirra. Dame Kirra raced wide in the home straight. Dame Kirra underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the greyhound to have muscle soreness to its right hind triangle muscle. Dame Kirra has been stood down from racing for a period of 10 days. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr S Stennings in relation to the racing manners of Dame Kirra approaching the first turn where the greyhound visibly eased. Acting on their own observations, viewing the official replays and taking evidence from Mr Stennings as well as taking into consideration the Vet report, Stewards were of the opinion that Dame Kirra had visibly eased and in doing so had failed to pursue the lure with due commitment throughout the event, by reason of injury. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69B(2)(a) Dame Kirra has been stood down from racing until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

Miss Lily was a late scratching at 6.30PM due to non-arrival. The trainer advised that he had fed and left the greyhound at home prior to tonight's engagement after it had not gained a start in the race meeting. Acting under the provisions of GAR 31(4), Miss Lily has been stood down from racing for a period of 28 days at all tracks. Acting under the provisions of GAR 86(o) Trainer Mr K Mcconnon was fined the sum of \$100 for a negligent act.

In the back straight Mewstone Rocket and Superior Jethro bumped. Approaching the first turn Superior Jethro checked off the heels of Mewstone Rocket. Soon after Superior Jethro and Dark Drifter bumped, checking Pepper Rock, Superior Jethro and Dark Drifter.
