Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

RACE 1 – REXEL NORTH HOBART PACE – 1609 METRES

BETTERTHANLIFE (Todd Rattray) broke in the early part of the score up and was consequently out of position as the start was effected and then tailed the field throughout. The filly has been placed out of the draw for future mobile start events.

Connections of IDEAL KARALTA advised that from a favourable inside draw they would look to go forward. Stewards approved the change of tactics and the gelding was driven accordingly.

KEEP PLAYING (Rohan Hillier) was restrained after the start.

ALAPHILIPPE (Christian Salter) was unable to obtain clear running in the home straight. That colt has now been reinstated in the mobile barrier draw.

RACE 2 – GREEN ELECTRICAL PACE – 2090 METRES

Drivers John Walters (TRIPLE AITCH FELLA) and Adrian Collins (MI JU DAN), were both reprimanded pursuant to AHRR 162(1)(j) for failing to maintain their position prior to the start.

STRYKER (Todd Rattray) had a tendency to race greenly whilst being restrained to a rearward trailing position racing into the back straight on the first occasion. STRYKER also had a tendency to hang in under pressure rounding the home turn.

Driver Christian Salter (ROLL WEST), was reprimanded under AHRR 156(3) for his unapproved whip use particulars being that his whip hand was raised above shoulder level.

After racing outside the leader, SHADY LOU (Rohan Hillier) then tired from the back straight. The gelding, which also displayed a tendency to hang in underwent a post-race veterinary

examination which revealed no apparent abnormalities. Trainer Paul Hill advised that the gelding would now be spelled.

SHADOW CONTROL (Mark Yole), pulled hard whilst racing in a trailing peg line position.

KARALTA KRUISE (W Rattray) was held up for clear racing room towards the finish.

A post-race swab sample was taken from SWAP ME, winner of the event.

RACE 3 – SUTTER HANOVER PACE – 2090 METRES

After showing gate speed to race outside the leader CLASSY GUY (Mark Yole) then commenced to tire from the 700 metres to be beaten 117.9 metres.. The gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no apparent abnormalities. The gelding has been stood down from racing for a period of 10 days and 1 trial.

JIVIN CULLEN NZ (Rohan Hadley) gave ground from the 700 metres to be beaten 120 metres. The gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no apparent abnormalities and has been stood down from racing for a period of 14 days and until the completion of 2 satisfactory trials.

DAMITSAM (Justin Campbell) was held up between the 400 and 300 metres.

PHILTRA PHELLA (Conor Crook) which gave ground over the concluding stages has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

RACE 4 – TPC MINI TROTTERS PACE – 1609 METRES

Acting on a confirmed telephone call from trainer Ben Yole, who advised that MARTYS FOR REAL was suffering from an elevated temperature and was unfit to start, Stewards ordered that geldings scratching at 11.30am. A 28 day stand down period has been applied which may be varied upon production of a veterinary certificate of fitness to race.

MAKING MY MARK (Conor Crook), after showing gate speed to the lead then shifted out under pressure despite the efforts of its driver nearing the finish, resulting in SMILIN GEOFF (Ricky Duggan), obtaining an inside run close to the finish.

IM FULLTILT NZ (Rohan Hadley) and SIGNIFICANCE (Allister Woods) were both held up and unable to obtain clear running in the home straight.

EBONYALLSTARZZZ (Mark Yole) broke in the early stages of the score up, however was then satisfactorily in position as the start was effected.

BONES JONES (Dylan Ford), had a tendency to hang out and race greenly near the 500 metres, losing ground in the process. BONES JONES was then held up and unable to obtain clear running over the concluding stages. A warning has been placed on the geldings racing manners.

After being caught wide in the early stages BOLTNMACH (Justin Campbell) was then restrained to a trailing position, before then taking a trail in the three wide line from the 800 metres.

After being caught wide early DODGERMEMATE (Samantha Freeman) then worked forward to race outside the leader.

RACE 5 – AUSTRALIAN DRIVERS CHAMPIONSHIP OCTOBER 28TH PACE – 2090 METRES

The start of this race was delayed when GOD SAKE took fright whilst hopple shortener pins were being put in and broke free of a track attendant who was knocked to the ground in the incident. Despite the sulky being overturned driver Todd Rattray was able to keep hold of the reins and restrain the gelding. GOD SAKE underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to run. Mr Rattray was assessed by ambulance officers and passed fit to drive and sustained abrasions whilst being dragged behind the gelding. Due to drag marks on the racing line the track was dragged prior to the race causing further delay. Subsequent to the race Clerk of the Course, Richard Housego, was counselled by Stewards in relation to his obligations in similar circumstances.

LAKE EYRE NZ (Mark Yole), shifted out as the start was effected before breaking and then shifting abruptly outwards inconveniencing JUKEBOX MUSIC (Gareth Rattray). LAKE EYRE NZ has been placed out of the draw and will be required to complete three consecutive satisfactory stand start races to be reinstated.

CROMAC JAMIE NZ (Justin Howlett) raced three wide in the early stages to the position outside the leader and then surrendered that position as WRONGLY ACCUSED (Conor Crook), progressed forward.

WRONGLY ACCUSED has been placed back in the standing start draw.

TIZYALATOR (Adrian Duggan) was fractious before the start.

ANOTHER DEREK NZ (Dylan Ford) raced rough after the start.

After taking evidence from drivers Matthew Cooper (CALL HER JULIE), Natalee Emery (PUSHKIN NZ) and Mark Yole (LAKE EYRE NZ) in relation to an incident which occurred on the finish line in which LAKE EYRE NZ was severely checked Stewards adjourned the inquiry to seek further evidence from driver Paul Hill (IVE GOT OOMPH).

Stewards also inquired into the reasons for JUKEBOX MUSIC racing four wide with 1100 metres to travel, after taking evidence from drivers Gareth Rattray (JUKEBOX MUSIC) and Matthew Cooper (CALL HER JULIE) and viewing the films it was established that several runners had shifted to the three wide line simultaneously contributing to JUKEBOX MUSIC then racing wider and no action was taken.

A post-race swab sample was taken from GOD SAKE, the winner of the event.

RACE 6 – LUXBET PACE DIVISION ONE – 2090 METRES

TIBYTOA (Samantha Freeman) hung out after the start.

SPARKLING NZ (Taylor Ford) broke free of interference shortly after the start and has been placed out of the mobile barrier draw and will need to complete three consecutive satisfactory starts to be reinstated.

RACE 7 – JOIN AS A TPC MEMBER PACE – 2090 METRES

POKER STORM (Adrian Duggan) galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

Stewards inquired into the reasons for JEANS MATTJESTY NZ (Rohan Hadley) breaking racing upon entering the back straight on the final occasion. After taking evidence from drivers Mark Yole (KARALTA DAZZLER) and Rohan Hadley (JEANS MATTJESTY NZ) acting on their own observations and viewing the race replays Mr Yole was charged pursuant to AHRR

163(1)(a)(iii), causing interference, the particulars being that when shifting to a position one off he has done so in a manner which has then led to his offside sulky wheel contacting the near hind leg of JEANS MATTJESTY NZ, causing that runner to then break. Mr Yoles licence to drive in races was suspended for 3 race dates. Mr Yole sought and was granted a deferment and his suspension will commence midnight 27 August and expire midnight September 15 2017.

Trainer B Yole was fined the sum of \$100 for presenting WASHIES CHANCE and JEANS MATTJESTY with the incorrect numbers.

RACE 8 – CASCADE DRAUGHT PACE DIVISION TWO – 2090 METRES

A transfer of ownership was affected on Friday the 18th August, indicating B Yole to be the owner of MIDAIR MELTDOWN.

SUN CLASSIQUE (Dylan Ford), had a tendency to race rough at various stages of the event and underwent a post-race veterinary examination. Sun Classique has now been stood down from racing for 10 days, 1 satisfactory trial and pending a veterinary certificate of fitness to race. Connections advised of their intention to now retire the mare from racing.

OUR MAXICAM (Samantha Freeman) raced four wide into the first turn and then progressed three wide to the position outside the leader before then tiring over the concluding stages.

A post-race swab sample was taken from OUT TO STRIKE, the winner of the event.

RACE 9 – TALBOT HOTEL PACE DIVISION THREE – 2090 METRES

JAKALIJA (Dylan Ford) after showing gate speed and racing outside the leader had a tendency to pull hard.

SHADOW STORM (Gareth Rattray) raced three wide around the first turn, before then working forward to the lead.

STYLISH TREND NZ (Conor Crook) was briefly held up rounding the home turn before then obtaining clear running for the length of the home straight.

Stewards inquired into the reasons for JODIS CHOICE (Mark Yole) briefly racing four wide subsequent to getting the bell. After taking evidence from drivers Mark Yole (JODIS CHOICE) and Matthew Cooper (ONEMORELAUGH) Mr Cooper was reprimanded under AHRR 168(1), careless driving, for allowing his drive to shift ground. ONEMORELAUGH was also placed on its last chance to race truly. Stewards noted his tendency to both hang in and out at various stages, which contributed to the incident.

RACE 10 – ROBERTS PACE – 1609 METRES

There were no racing incidents during the running of this event.
