RACE 1 – RJ PUBLISHING & DESIGNS MAIDEN– 1150 METRES

Miss Che Che - Trainer Ms A Watling, advised that it would be her intentions to instruct rider Sigrid Carr to use the whip sparingly as in her opinion the mare had resented the whip use at its most recent starts.

Boltoutoftheblue – Slow into stride (1L). Travelled wide without cover from the 600 metres.

The Golden Jet – Rider Rhonda Mangan reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout.

Voices – Slow into stride (1L).

RACE 2 – SIMONS DESIGN CENTRE CLASS 1 HCP– 1150 METRES

Gee Gee Royal Miss – Inconvenienced at start when Great Expectation jumped inwards. The mare hung out rounding 600 metre turn.

Island Pirate – Prior to correct weight rider Daniel Ganderton wished to view the official patrol films of the start in relation to his mount being denied a fair start. It was established that Island Pirate was slightly fractious however when the start was affected a barrier attendant still had hold of the geldings head denying it a fair start and as such the gelding was declared a non-runner. A warning was placed on its barrier manners.

Greenmount Lass – A warning was placed on the mares barrier manners after being difficult to load and difficult to ride on the way to the barriers.

Gee Gee Cats – At approximately the 800 metres jumped a shadow, shifted in, inconveniencing Gee Gees Cricket. Raced wide without cover from the 700m to the 300m. The gelding had a tendency to hang in, in the home straight.

Gee Gee Cricket - was inconvenienced at approximately the 800 metres.

Kenfromthebar – Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event, when being restrained by its rider.

RACE 3 – TASRACING.COM.AU MAIDEN– 1350 METRES

Irish Jeff – A veterinary certificate of fitness was submitted for Irish Jeff. Layed in at approximately the 300 metres, as a result Om Nom was carried in onto Bailee's Words which was inconvenienced. Jockey Anthony Darmanin accidentally dropped his whip at approximately the 50 metres.

Moorcroft – Held up for clear racing room from the 600 to 300 metres.

One Before You Go – Lost its front near side shoe in running. Warning placed on the geldings barrier manners for being fractious in the barriers.

Victory Medal – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

Lucky I'm Here – Slow into stride (1L)

Om Nom – Held up rounding the home turn.

Bailee's Words – Jockey I Toker reported the filly was short in its action. The filly underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have muscle soreness in the gluteals.

RACE 4 – DANNEBROG BENCHMARK 72 HCP– 1350 METRES

Vandermeer – Raced further back than anticipated in the early stages of the event, when being restrained from a wide barrier.

Tambro's Game – Rider Sigrid Carr was of the opinion that the mare may have come to the end of its preparation. Rider S Carr was advised of her obligations in ensuring that she rides the mounts out to the line.

Gallow Gate – Trainer J Blacker advised Stewards that Gallow Gate would be ridden further back in today's event, circumstances permitting. The gelding was ridden accordingly. Layed in in the home straight and the rider had to stop and straighten their mount.

RACE 5 – PEDRO'S RESTAURANT BENCHMARK 62 HCP– 1650 METRES

Sugar Free – Warning was placed on barrier manners after fractious in the barriers. Rider Troy Baker reported the mare didn't appreciate racing inside other runners.

Storm Gust – Stood flat-footed in the barriers and was slow into stride (8L). Connections were advised that Storm Gust must complete one trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing. Trainer P Luttrell advised that the gelding would be retired.

Toakio Tower – Apprentice Hayley McCarthy reported that the mare failed to respond from the 400 metres and that she was disappointed on how the mare finished the race off.

Dale Hill – Rider Ismail Toker was reminded of his obligations on his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Barrier staff member Mr Lane O'Shannessy was spoken to by Stewards in relation to his loading manners of horses at the barriers. He was advised and reminded of his obligations as a barrier attendant that he is to follow the correct loading and handling procedures in future.

RACE 6 – WINTER WARMERS FEAST BENCHMARK 68 HCP– 1000 METRES

The start of this race was delayed when Vengeance Of Fury broke through the front of the barriers. The gelding was declared a late scratching at 3.17pm on veterinary advice.

Vengeance Of Fury – Connections were advised that the gelding must complete a trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

Gee Gees Blondie – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Seajamm - Trainer J Blacker advised Stewards that Seajamm would be ridden further back in today's event, circumstances permitting. The mare was ridden accordingly.

Rearview – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to take its place in the field. Jumped awkwardly and was restrained off heels of Kyogle Son and lost ground.

RACE 7 – LUXBET ALL WEATHER DISTANCE FINAL HANDICAP– 1880 METRES

Sound Bar – At approximately the 1400 metres got its head up and raced ungenerously.

Siorca – Slow into stride (1L). Pulled up near the 800 metres and retired from the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off fore leg. Requires a veterinary certificate prior to its next race start.

Banca Dream – Passing the 1100 metres was retired from the race after breaking down. As a result The Master Speed checked to avoid the easing Banca Dream, inconveniencing Siorca which was carried wider on the track. A veterinary examination revealed a fractured cannon bone and fetlock, which resulted in Banca Dream being subsequently euthanised on course.

RACE 8 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN CLASS 1 HCP– 1350 METRES

Sudden Shock – Re-saddled behind the barriers prior to the start of this event.

Snowing Sun – Slow into stride (1L).

Hint Of Moonlight – Travelled without cover in the early and middle stages of the event.

Grand Faith – Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.
