Comments / Explanations:

Brendon McCoull was issued with a severe reprimand under AR 120(b) in that he accepted rides for which he was subsequently unable to make the weight. In determining penalty

Chantal Willis was advised that she must submit a medical certificate and undergo an After Injury concussion test prior to riding trackwork, trials or races again.

RACE 1 – HAZELL BROS MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – 1650 METRES

Pistol Jack – Momentarily steadied near the 50 metres when Vivre Star layed in.

Vivre Star – Layed in in the home straight.

Bastetani – Performed poorly. Rider Jason Maskiell explained that in his opinion the mare may have resented the kick back and made a respiratory noise near the 1150 metres. However, when placed under pressure near the 600 metres failed to respond to his riding and commenced to give ground. He then elected not to ride the mare out. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Sunset Party – Rider Sigrid Carr reported that the mare was inclined to lay out throughout.

RACE 2 – LUXBET MAIDEN – 1350 METRES

Hell Baby – Underwent a veterinary examination as it had not raced for over 12 months and was passed fit to race.

Little Suzie – Performed below expectations. Rider Troy Baker stated that the mare failed to handle the track conditions today.

Pinkeyes Pride – Approaching the 100 metres was restrained when tightened for room by Mookcat which was taken in by Voices (A Darmanin) which was inclined to lay in. Anthony Darmanin was advised to exercise more care when allowing his mounts to shift ground in future. When questioned, rider Wanderson D'Avila stated that he was instructed to be positive from the barrier however the mare jumped well and he was able to take up a more forward position due to little pace from runners to the

outside. Trainer J Luttrell explained that it was not his intention to have the mare placed as far forward as it was. Mr Luttrell added that he did instruct his rider to hold a position if the mare began well due to the inside barrier draw and 1350 metre start. He further added that the mare did jump quicker than he had anticipated. Mr Luttrell was reminded of his obligations under AR 135A in that he must notify any alteration in the intended running position of his horses.

Gee Gees Roughie – Connections advised that the gelding would be ridden further back from the wide barrier. Settled last. Rider Shuji Amano was reminded of his obligations when using the whip when out of contention.

Oceania Hope – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Rider C Graham reported that the filly hung out through and proved difficult to ride, in particular, between the 600 and 400 metres. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the filly. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer G McCulloch advised that the filly will now be spelled.

Voices – Raced greenly.

RACE 3 – CLAREMONT CHAINSAWS & MOWERS MAIDEN – 1150 METRES

I Am The Dude – Jumped awkwardly. Over raced in the early stages.

Sebring Star – Passing the 800 metres improved up onto the heels of Plenty Of Bling and had to be restrained.

Bloomin' Late – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Flikpix – Rider Georgie Catania reported that the mare was inclined to lay out during the run.

Levissi – Rider Chantal Willis reported that the mare raced greenly.

Plenty Of Bling – Rider Grant Challenger reported that the mare raced greenly.

Mr West - Rider Troy Baker reported that his saddle slipped back shortly after jumping placing him at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.

Gee Gee Musicmaker – Slow into stride.

Miss Smith – Over raced in the early stages. Had difficulty obtaining a clear run from the 500 metres until the 150 metres.

RACE 4 – CARLTON DRAUGHT BM82 HANDICAP – 1650 METRES

Vandermeer – Rider Jason Maskiell was reminded of his obligations with regard to his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Gee Gees Top Notch – Rider Sigrid Carr was reminded of her obligations with regard to her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Bidirectional – Slow into stride (1L). Rider B Muhcu stated that after being slow away the gelding was not suited to the tempo of the race.

Ultimate Doom – Rider Anthony Darmanin was issued with a severe reprimand under AR 137(b) for failing to ride his mount out fully to the finish of the race.

Reann's Diamond – Bled from both nostrils. Connections were advised of the requirement of AR 53A(4) in that the mare cannot be trained, exercised or galloped for a period of two (2) months or start in a race for a period of 3 months and only after completing a satisfactory 1000 metre gallop in the presence of Stewards.

RACE 5 – WOLF BLASS CLASS 1 HANDICAP– 1350 METRES

Sudden Shock – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Ruthless Lover – Underwent a veterinary examination prior to racing today as it had not raced for over 12 months and was passed fit to take its place in the field. Performed below expectations. Rider Wanderson D’Avila explained the gelding was inclined to lay out in the home straight and in his opinion failed to handle the synthetic surface. He further stated that the gelding would derive benefit from the run as it had not raced for over 12 months.

The Austrian Oak – Held up for clear racing room on the home turn.

Global Squire – Performed below expectations. Rider Chris Graham stated that the gelding failed to muster early pace and did not respond to his riding from the 600 metres.

The Desperate – Slow into stride (1L). Layed in in the home straight. Had difficulty obtaining clear running between the 200 and 100 metres.

RACE 6 – CROWN LAGER CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1150 METRES

Agree To – Layed out throughout. Shifted out severely when under pressure in the home straight. Connections were advised a warning has been placed on the gelding’s race manners.

Specialist – Inconvenience near the 800 metres. Rider Jason Maskiell accidentally dropped his whip near the 100 metres.

Dragonbite – Underwent a veterinary examination after becoming fractious in the barriers. Subsequently declared a late scratching at 3.18 pm acting on veterinary advice. The veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind. Connections were advised that the gelding must complete a trial to the satisfaction of Stewards and a veterinary certificate must be submitted prior to racing again.

Gee Gee Cats – Approaching the 800 metres was momentarily restrained when tightened for room by Laddieandtherocket (G Catania). As a result Agree To which was following had to be steadied and Specialist then had to be restrained off that gelding’s heels. Georgie Catania was reminded to exercise more care when permitting her mounts to shift ground in future.

RACE 7 – TRCHOBART.COM.AU BM68 HANDICAP – 1150 METRES

The Captain – Slow into stride (1L).

Winston Wolfe – When questioned in relation to manner in which he rode out his mount over the concluding stages, rider Daniel Ganderton explained that approaching the finish he had improved up towards the heels of Kuusela and in his opinion there was insufficient room to take a run to the inside of that mare. Daniel Ganderton conceded that shortly after easing the gelding the run then briefly opened however due to the fact that he had restrained he was unable to take up the position. His comments were noted and he was advised to ensure that he rides his mounts out fully to the finish.

Gee Gee Sun Valley – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Bedrock Dreams - Declared a late scratching at 10.20 am when it was reported that the mare was in season and appeared short in its action.

Shockwave Miss – Commenced to lose ground from the 600 metres. Collapsed near the 200 metres. The veterinarian reported the mare to be deceased due to a severe internal bleed. Rider Chantal Willis who was dislodged was examined by the on-course medical officers and transported to hospital for further examination with a suspected broken collarbone.

RACE 8 – SCHWEPES CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1350 METRES

Amaword – Rider Jason Maskiell was reminded of his obligations with respect to the whip rule prior to the 100 metres.

Our Shanakee – On jumping away had to be checked when tightened for room between Hirvonen and You Didn't which shifted out. Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

You Didn't – Briefly held up rounding the home turn and again approaching the 100 metres.

Hirvonen – Bumped on jumping and had to be checked.

GENERAL

Trainer Scott Brunton was fined \$200 (wholly suspended for 12 months) under LR 14.1 for failing to scratch Little Suzie by the prescribed time from Race 3 at the Devonport Racing Club on 20 August 2017.

Trainer Andrew Roach advised that following a scope subsequent to racing at DRC on 3 September 2017, In A Perfect World would now be retired.
