

## **STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT**

### **RACE 1 – ROTARY CLUB OF CENTRAL LAUNCESTON MAIDEN– 1220 METRES**

Prior to the running of this race a bank of lights malfunctioned near the 1000 metres and consequently had diminished light for that section of track. All riders were advised accordingly and agreed to ride.

**Flikpix** - Raced wide throughout and was taken to the extreme outside of the track on straightening.

**Kasuku** - Shifted inwardly shortly after the start.

**Woohoo** - Over raced in the early and middle stages and made the turn into the straight wide.

**Snippety Cat** - Slow into stride.

**French Connection** - Commenced awkwardly. When questioned, Jockey S Carr explained that the mare did not handle the track conditions.

**Mookcat** - Shortly after the start for approximately 200 metres raced in restricted room on the inside of **Need A Margarita**.

### **RACE 2 – FIELD FAMILY CLASS 2 HCP– 1220 METRES**

**Meteor Strike** was withdrawn by order of the Stewards at 6.42 pm at the request of trainer M Ganderton due to the downgrading of the track.

**Millmount** - Lay inwards in the straight

**Life on the Wire**- Held up approaching the turn into the straight.

**Radioactive**- Raced wide throughout.

**Cosmic Angel** - Slow into stride and raced wide for a major part of the race.

**Turtles Nest**- Shortly after the start raced tightly for a short distance.

**Auro** - Shortly after the start raced tightly for a short distance.

**The track downgraded to a heavy 10 at 7.22 pm.**

### **RACE 3 – KEVIN SHARKIE BM66 HCP– 1220 METRES**

Routine samples were ordered to be taken from the winner **Gee Gees Style**.

**Kyogle Son** - Raced wide throughout

**Vengeance of Fury** – At the request of trainer Mr P. Hill and as the track had been downgraded to a heavy 10, permission was granted to remove the pacifiers.

**Gee Gee Sun Valley**- Was taken to the extreme outside of the track in the straight.

**Toorak Affair** - Slow to begin.

**Calavera** - Slow into stride.

### **RACE 4 – TRADIES & LADIES 18<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER MAIDEN– 1420 METRES**

Routine samples were ordered to be taken from the winner **Speedonova**

**Monty Zuma** - Was difficult to load, fractious in the barrier and commenced awkwardly. Trainer M Trinder was advised that the gelding would have to trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards before starting in a race again.

**Toricain** - Raced greenly throughout and approaching the 1200 metres restrained and over-reacted when tightened for room, becoming unbalanced.

**Speedonova**- Slow to begin.

Trainer D Quin (**Riptorn**) was fined the sum of \$50 under AR140B(3) for a gear change (Winkers off).

#### **General:**

Stewards inquired into the reason for **Toricain** (S. Carr) restraining near the 1200 metres. On inquiry, it was established that at that stage of the race, Malachite **Quest** (B. Muhcu) had shifted outwards slightly from **Monty Zuma** (J. Benbow) as at the same time **He's Tough Enough** (D. Ganderton) shifted inwards marginally. In the opinion of the Stewards, no blame could be contributed to any one rider, but all riders were advised to exercise more care in future and make every effort to keep their mounts straight.

### **RACE 5 – NEIL BUCKBY MOTORS BM62 HCP– 1420 METRES**

Permission was granted for **Sentry Duty** to be withdrawn at 7.15 pm due to the downgrade of the track. Permission was granted for **Ain't The Whisky** to be withdrawn due to the downgrade of the track at 6.42 pm

**Time Commands**-On jumping shifted out bumping another runner.

**Kelly's Diva** – Bumped on jumping.

**Rearview** – Inconvenienced on jumping. Overraced in early and middle stages.

**Axion** raced wide throughout.

**Gallow Gate** over raced in the early and middle stages.

## **RACE 6 – BOOK YOUR CHRISTMAS FUNCTION CLASS 1 HCP– 1420 METRES**

**Earl Da Vinci (NZ)** - Lay outwards in the straight.

**Mansplaining** -Slow to begin. When question regarding the disappointing performance Jockey J Maskiell advised that, the horse had missed the start slightly but had been disappointing and had not run on.

**The Austrian Oak (NZ)** -Slow into stride.

**Sh'Bourne Dylaca** - Made the turn into the straight wide.

**The Desperate** – Approaching the 1000 metres steadied when racing in restricted room.

**Sunset Party** - Raced wide throughout.

## **RACE 7 – EMIRATES MELBOURNE CUP TOUR BM72 HCP– 1620 METRES**

**Tammany Hall** – Held tight and inconvenienced near the 800 metres. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**Gwemrae** - Slow into stride, restrained and brushed the running rail passing the 800 metres.

### **GENERAL**

Stewards inquired into the reason for **Gwemrae** restraining near the 800 metres. On inquiry, it was established at that stage of the race **Kool Kash** (C Graham) had shifted inwards holding **Tammany Hall** (S Carr) tight, which in turn shifted inwards tightening **Gwemrae** (B Muhcu), which restrained and brushed the running rail. Stewards issued Apprentice C Graham with a reprimand for careless riding under the provisions of 137(a) and advised that he is to make a greater effort in future to keep his mount straight.

## **RACE 8 – LUXBET MDN/CL1 HCP– 2150 METRES**

Routine swab samples were ordered to be taken from the winner **Another Brother**.

**Super Leane** - Commenced awkwardly bumping **Another Brother**.
