### ***Comments / Explanations:***

Jockey Jason Maskiell was advised that he must submit a medical clearance prior to riding trackwork, trials or races.

### **RACE 1 – INVERMAY NEWSAGENCY MAIDEN – 1220 METRES**

Correct weight was delayed when Daniel Ganderton, rider of Jurisdiction, second past the post, lodged a protest against Remigny (Craig Newitt) first past the post, alleging interference near the 50 metres. After taking evidence from all parties it was established that Remigny shifted out abruptly near the 50 metres and bumped with Jurisdiction however, due to the close proximity to the winning post, Stewards could not be comfortably satisfied that the interference was greater than the margin at the end of the race and the protest was dismissed.

**Jurisdiction** – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after not starting for more than two years and passed suitable to take its place in the event. Bumped by Remigny near the 50 metres. Trainer Mark Ganderton was fined \$50 for the late notification of gear.

**Al's Tycoon** – Held up for clear racing room on the latter part of the home turn.

**Sebring Star** – On jumping away was checked when tightened for room between Remigny which shifted out and J'nine's Delight. Over-raced in the early and middle stages and had to be restrained off heels on a number of occasions.

**Kateland** – Dipped near the 600 metres.

**The Greatness** – Slow into stride (1L).

**Clean Acheeva** – Slow into stride (1L). Shortly after jumping had to check off the heels of Sebring Star. Rider Sigrid Carr reported that the filly raced greenly in the home straight.

**Remigny** – Shifted out abruptly near the 50 metres and bumped with Jurisdiction before rider Craig Newitt straightened his mount.

**Knees Are Bung** – Performed below market expectations. Rider Jason Benbow stated that the gelding was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn and changed stride on a number of occasions in the home straight.

## **RACE 2 – PROSPECT MARKETPLACE NEWSAGENCY MAIDEN – 1620 METRES**

**Brundah Bob** – Connections submitted a veterinary clearance prior to racing today. Late scratching at 7.20pm when unable to be loaded. Connections were advised must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again.

**Teddy's Fault** – Slow into stride. Near the 500 metres shifted out to obtain clear running and bumped with Pinkeyes Pride.

**Ballistic Lass** – Slow into stride.

**Miss Brightside** – Underwent a veterinary examination behind the barriers after rearing over and passed suitable to take its place in the field. Connections were advised that a warning had been placed on the mare. Connections advised they would assess the mare's immediate racing future. Raced greenly. Rider Daniel Ganderton could offer no explanation for the disappointing performance.

**Malachite Quest** – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Performed below market expectations. Rider Chris Graham explained that the mare would be better suited to tracks with more give.

**Pinkeyes Pride** – Raced four wide without cover during the middle stages before obtaining cover passing the 800 metres. Bumped near the 500 metres when giving ground.

## **RACE 3 – BRISBANE ST NEWS & LOTTO BM62 HCP – 1620 METRES**

Correct weight was delayed when the connections of third past the post Olly's A Star wished to view the official photo. After doing so were satisfied and correct weight was given.

**Northern Soul** – Bumped near the 1500 metres. Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

**Tara's Gem** – Near the 1500 metres buffeted when tightened for room between Northern Soul and Real Messi which was taken in by Rougeau (Ismail Toker) which shifted in when not clear.

**Alexander Benjamin** – Slow into stride.

**Gwemrae** – Near the 1100 metres got its head up when being restrained.

**Speedonova** – Performed below market expectations. Rider Craig Newitt explained that the mare was not suited to the tempo of the race and in his opinion would be better ridden further back. He further added that the mare was inclined to lay in and may be better suited on tracks with more give.

**Rougeau** – Ismail Toker pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(a) (careless riding), the carelessness being that he permitted his mount to shift in near the 1500 metres while riding his mount along taking Real Messi in on to Tara's Gem which was buffeted between Real Messi and Northern Soul and had to be restrained. Ismail Toker's licence to ride in races was suspended for one (1) Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight 28 October 2017 and expire midnight 1 November 2017. In assessing penalty Stewards took into account Ismail Toker's guilty plea, good record and that the incident was in the mid-range.

## **RACE 4 – NORWOOD NEWS & POST OFFICE CLASS 2 HCP – 1420 METRES**

**Steel Dan** – Over-raced in the middle stages.

**Specialist** – Raced four wide without cover throughout.

**Striking Prospect** – Slow into stride.

**Hirvonen** – Held up for clear racing room from the 400 metres before obtaining clear running near the 150 metres.

**Sugar Free** – Fractious in the barriers. Connections were advised that a warning would continue on the mare. Rider Bulent Muhcu stated that the mare was inclined to lay out throughout.

**Dalehill** – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

#### **RACE 5 – NEWSXPRESS NEWSTEAD BM72 HCP – 1420 METRES**

**Streetwise Savoire** – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**Minute Repeater** – Rider Georgie Catania pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on eight occasions prior to the 100 metres which is three more than the permitted amount. After taking into consideration her guilty plea, good record, and the totality of her whip use, Georgie Catania was subsequently fined the sum of \$100. Georgie Catania was severely reprimanded under AR137A(5)(a)(i) for using her whip in consecutive strides on one occasion.

**Fragment** – Had difficulty in obtaining clear running between the 500 metres and 200 metres.

**Orange River** – Performed below expectations. Rider Sigrid Carr stated that the mare made an unusual respiratory noise on pulling up and may have got its tongue over the bit. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have an elevated heart rate.

#### **RACE 6 – BURNIE NEWSAGENCY BM68 HCP – 1220 METRES**

**Nunivak** – Rider David Pires reported that the gelding hung out throughout the race.

**Tammany Hall** – Rider Troy Baker explained that it was not his intention to be positioned as far forward as he was tonight however, after beginning well, the gelding was further forward than anticipated.

**Vengeance of Fury** – Jumped away awkwardly. Rounding the home turn had to be steadied when disappointed for a run between Greensborough, which laid out slightly, and Time Commands. Rider Jason Benbow was advised to exercise care and to ensure that there is sufficient room when attempting to take runs.

**Greensborough** – Rider Sigrid Carr reported that the gelding was inclined to hang out for the majority of the race.

#### **RACE 7 – NEXTRA KINGS MEADOWS NEWS & LOTTO CLASS 2 HCP – 1220 METRES**

**Innocent Hero** – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had not started for more than twelve months and passed suitable to race.

**Mister Songman** – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Manna Trust** – Rider Sigrid Carr reported that the gelding was inclined to lay in for the majority of the race.

**Canam** – Slow into stride.
