Stewards accepted Trainer John Luttrell's explanation for the late notification of his riders today

**Trainer Graeme McCulloch was fined the sum of \$50 under LR13.3 for the late notification of his rider in Race 2*

RACE 1 – CROWN LAGER MAIDEN 3YO & UPWARDS HANDICAP – SET WEIGHTS - 1600 METRES

General Sussex – Over-raced in the early stages. Rider Craig Newitt reported that the gelding race greenly in the home straight. Shifted out slightly under pressure in the home straight.

Race the Wind – Became unbalanced after bumping with **Zipponet** on jumping away. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Teddy's Fault – Slow into stride. Held up for clear racing room rounding the home turn.

Zipponet – Jumped inwards bumping with **Race the Wind**. Rider Troy Baker reported that the gelding, which was first up from a spell, raced one-paced.

Copper Alley Bay - Near the 1200 metres whilst over-racing, shifted out and bumped with **Kandahar**.

Hell Baby – Rider David Pires stated that the mare travelled well in the run, however it failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres and in his opinion it may be better suited to tracks with more give.

Plenty of Bling - Rider Sigrid Carr reported that the mare raced erratically. Trainer John Luttrell advised Stewards that the mare will now be retired. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed **Plenty of Bling** to have a small cut on its near hind pastern.

RACE 2 – CLAUDE NEON MAIDEN 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS - 1100 METRES

Boss Striker - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after not racing for more than 12 months and was subsequently passed fit to take its place in the field. Slow into stride (1L). Raced wide without cover.

Stinka - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Chase And Status – Raced three wide without cover. Rider Teagan Voorham was reminded of her obligations in relation to whip use when out of contention.

Mistress of Design – Jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride. Over-raced in the early stages.

Pompon – Slow into stride (1L). Approaching the 200 metres, shifted out when attempting to obtain clear running and bumped with **Gee Gees Liberty**. Jockey Craig Newitt was advised to exercise care when allowing his mounts to shift ground.

RACE 3 – DOWNTON PROPERTY BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1000 METRES

Solomon's Song – Passing the 100 metres, disappointed for a run between **Lady Jane** and **Fascinating Lady** before having to be restrained. When questioned, Rider Mehmet Ulucinar explained that when passing the 200 metre he momentarily considered taking a run to the inside of **Fascinating Lady**. However after that mare commenced to shift ground inwards he then attempted to take a run to the outside of that mare's heels. However that run did not eventuate due to **Lady Jane** racing tightly to the outside. Mehmet Ulucinar was reminded of his obligations to ensure that there is a full run available when attempting to improve his position.

Galeocerdo – Bumped on jumping away

Innocent Hero – Slipped behind on jumping away and lost ground. Lost a near-fore plate during running.

Boart – Late scratching at 10.45 am acting on veterinary advice after the gelding was found to have a laceration under its tongue. Trainer John Luttrell was advised that he must tender a veterinary certificate prior to Boart's next race start.

Fascinating Lady – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Gasnier - Unable to obtain clear running from the 300 metres until approaching the 100 metres.

Pontypaul – Bumped on jumping away. Rider Rhonda Mangan reported that the filly raced greenly throughout.

Gee Gees Queenie – Near the 300 metres, laid in towards the heels of **Galeocerdo**.

Auro – Jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride.

Kirribilli Kid – Jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 4 – JET COURIERS OPEN HANDICAP – NO CLAIMS – 3200 METRES

Bidirectional - Slow into stride.

Geeges Lillybet – Rider Troy Baker was reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.

Hot Chisel – Near the 2200 metre mark, was restrained when over-racing and improved up on to the heels of **Bidirectional**. Had a tendency to over-race during the middle stages.

RACE 5 - TASMANET BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Hyperbole – Rider Chris Graham pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) and was fined the sum of \$200 for using his whip nine (9) times prior to the 100 metres which is four more than the permitted amount.

The Captain – Jumped awkwardly.

Geegie Trendsetter – Rider Georgie Catania stated that the filly travelled well, however failed to respond to her riding from the 600 metres. Trainer Stuart Gandy stated that he was disappointed with the filly's performance and would advise Stewards of any matter that may arise with the filly in the coming days.

Swinging Ali – Approaching the 400 metres, restrained off the heels of **Hyperbole**. Near the 200 metres, accidentally struck over the nose with the whip of Jockey T Baker (**Gee Gees Style**).

RACE 6 - AWM ELECTRICAL BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

The announcement of correct weight was delayed when Jockey S Amano the rider of the second placegetter **Turtles Nest** and the gelding's connections asked to view the official photo of the finish. After viewing the photo, both parties were satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Geeges Gran Lodge - Rider Sigrid Carr pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) and was fined \$300 for using her whip six (6) times prior to the 100 metres. In determining penalty Steward's took into account Miss Carr's record, guilty plea and the totality of her whip use. In view of Miss Carr's poor record in relation to this rule she was advised that serious consideration would be given to a suspension if she were to re-offend in future.

Katy Kat – Rider David Pires reported that the mare over-raced. Shifted out slightly in the home straight. David Pires was advised to exercise care when allowing his mounts to shift ground.

Qui Samer – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Kepta – Near the 1200 metres, momentarily steadied when tightened for room between **Katy Kat** and **Tillation** when both these horses shifted. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Tillation – Slow into stride. Approaching the 100 metres, was momentarily restrained when disappointed for a run between **Katy Kat** (David Pires) which shifted out and **Cheers Chappy** which shifted in slightly.

Sunset Party – Rider Craig Newitt reported that the mare was inclined to hang out and in his opinion would be better suited to tracks with more give.

RACE 7 – SAUNDERS SIGNS BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

King Manu (NZ) – Slow into stride (1L).

Player One – Over-raced in the early stages. Passing the 1400 metres, galloped on by **Taramaya** which was over-racing and was subsequently retired from the event. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Taramaya – Over-raced in the early stages. Near the 1400 metres, shifted in when over-racing and contacted the heels of **Player One** and was severely checked. After taking evidence from David Pires (**Taramaya**) and Shuji Amano (**Player One**), it was established that **Taramaya** had shifted in when over-racing before being corrected by David Pires, the mare then shifted in again and contacted the heels of **Player One**. David Pires was advised to exercise care when attempting to obtain cover. In not taking any further action Stewards took into consideration the racing manners of **Taramaya** and **Player One**.
