Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – LUXBET C&G MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

He's Rushin' - Was slow into stride.

His Nibs - Jumped awkwardly. Jockey B Muhcu accidentally dropped his whip at approximately the 200 metres.

Double You Tee – Difficult to load, warning will be continued on the colts loading manners. Raced three wide without cover.

Gee Gees Bulldog – Warning placed on the geldings loading manners. Rider D Ganderton stated the gelding travelled well, however it failed to quicken from the 300 metres.

Phar Word - Rider C Graham stated the gelding didn't appreciate racing to the inside of other runners and in his opinion maybe suited over a further distance.

Silent Savings - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Sirkadir - Tightened on jumping between **Gee Gee Countryboy** and **Gee Gees Bulldog**, which shifted in.

Sebring Star - Was slow into stride 2 lengths. Slow to muster early speed. Also raced wide without cover from the 800.

RACE 2 – STEVES LIQUOR F&M MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Amber in Paris - Bumped on jumping. Rider reported the mare hung in and raced greenly throughout. Shifted in at appro

At a subsequent inquiry Apprentice Chris Graham, the rider of **Amber In Paris** was found guilty to a charge under AR 137(a) careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift in at approximately the 900 metres when insufficiently clear of **Gee Gees Liberty** (S Carr), resulting in that filly restraining off heels and consequently losing its position. After taking into account his plea, recent record and that the incident to be in the mid-range, Chris Graham's licence to ride in races was suspended for one (1) Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight on Wednesday, 29 November 2017 and to expire at midnight on 6 December 2017.

At a subsequent inquiry Apprentice Chris Graham, the rider of **Amber In Paris** was found guilty to a charge under AR 137(a) careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift in on the home turn when insufficiently clear. Resulting in **Nahla** (A Ismadi)(a) being crowded for room between **Amber In Paris** and **Dubbo** (D Ganderton) as a result was checked and lost his racing position. After taking into account his plea, recent record and that the incident to be in the mid-range, Apprentice Chris Graham's licence to ride in races was suspended for two (2) Tasmanian race meetings to commence at midnight on Wednesday, 29 November 2017 and to expire at midnight on 8 December 2017. Both penalties are to be served concurrently.

Dubbo – Passing the 1000m was restrained off heels of **Chase And Status**, which shifted in. Inconvenienced on the home turn when **Amber In Paris** shifted in onto **Nahla**.

Lovely Lady – Restrained off heels of **Chase And Status** near the 1100m.

Nahla - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Approaching the home turn was crowded, checked and lost its position.

Gee Gees Liberty - Restrained off heels of **Amber In Paris** and lost its position at the 900m. Held up between the 400 and 200m.

Gone Girl - Held up home turn.

I'm A Lucky Girl - Approaching the 400m was disappointed for a run between **Dubbo** and **Nahla**.

Luvahussy - Bumped on jumping.

Miss Tylly - On jumping was buffeted for room between **Amber in Paris** and **Luvahussy**. Over raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

Chase and Status - Jockey (J Maskiell) was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground inwards when insufficiently clear of **Lovely Lady** at the 1100m and **Dubbo** at the 1000m.

RACE 3 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP 1ST JANUARY – BENCHMARK 83 HCP – 1400 METRES

Silver Bolt - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Gladstone - Rider D Pires stated that the gelding had not raced for 4 weeks and that the horse travelled well however failed to respond from the 500 metres. He also said that the gelding may prefer a softer surface.

Beaufort Lad - At a subsequent inquiry Jockey Bulent Muhcu, the rider of **Beaufort Lad** was found guilty to a charge under AR 137(a) careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift out at approximately the 400m when insufficiently clear of **Smoke And Whisky** which was carried out and contacted the hindquarters of **Geegees Brightstar**. After taking into account his plea, his good record and that the incident to be in the mid-range, Bulent Muhcu's licence to ride in races was suspended for one (1) Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight on Wednesday, 29 November 2017 and to expire at midnight on 6 December 2017.

Geegees Brightstar – Hampered at the 400m.

Hugo – Slow into stride and slow to muster early speed.

Vandermeer - Raced wide from the 700m.

Gee Gees Top Notch - Held up home turn

Magnasa - Held up home turn and held up passing the 200m

Spirit of Nia - Raced 3 wide without cover.

Smoke 'N' Whisky - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination behind the barriers and was passed fit to race. Carried out and contacted the hindquarters of **Geegees Brightstar** on the home turn.

Kanji - Knuckled on jumping.

RACE 4 – KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES

Weekend Whisky – Jumped in at the start and carried **Paterangi** in onto **Quiet Wonder**

Pistol Jack - Inconvenienced at the 1200m when Sunset Party rolled out.

The Greatness – Checked on the home turn

Paterangi - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination behind the barriers and was passed fit to race. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Quiet Wonder – Stewards inquired into an incident approaching the home turn into the reasons for **Quiet Wonder** being severely tightened and subsequently checked, when attempting to take a run to the inside of **Ruthless Lover**. As a result **Aljazmic** clipped heels of **Ruthless Lover** and blundered, resulting in (N Punch)(a) becoming unbalanced and losing his near side iron. The Greatness which was following **Aljazmic** had to be severely checked to avoid the heels of that mare. In taking no further action stewards were unable to fully attribute the blame to any one rider. As they believed the racing manners of Quiet Wonder contributed to this incident. However stewards advised C Luttrell that he must ensure that he allows sufficient room at all times.

Aljazmic – clipped heels and blundered on the home turn. . A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Sunset Party - Raced three wide without cover.

Lady Wynette – Carried wider on the track at the 1200m.

Ruthless Lover - . Hind quarters contacted and galloped on at the home turn. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Grand Faith – Permission granted for H McCarthy to ride 1kg over the allotted weight.

RACE 5 – GRAB A PICNIC CARE SPACE @ THE LONGFORD CUP - BENCHMARK 62 HCP – 1600 METRES

Biscay Barb - Over raced early and middle stages. Also raced wide from the 800 metres.

Littlerayof – Adjourned inquiry in to an incident in the early part of the back straight.

Real Messi – Held up for a clear run approaching the home turn. Steadied when disappointed for a run to the outside of Littlerayof approaching the 100m.

Hirovonen - Re-saddled behind the barriers.

Lyndspur - Permission granted for Jockey H McCarthy to ride 1kg over the allotted weight. Raced three wide without cover from the 1200m. Adjourned inquiry in to an incident in the early part of the back straight.

RACE 6 – KEITH HENDLEY 90TH BIRTHDAY CLASS 2 HCP – 1200 METRES

It's a Battle – jumped out at the start

Millmount - T Baker stated that after being slightly slow to begin he was unable to take up a forward position which in his opinion was detrimental to the geldings performance.

Private Baldrick- Hampered at the start between **It's A Battle** and **Gemini**.

Silver Road - Raced three wide without cover. Rider reported something amiss with action in front. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities. Shifted and bumped with **Gemini** at the 400m.

Gemini – Jumped in at the start. Shifted and bumped with **Silver Road** at the 400m.

RACE 7 – GREAT NORTHERN BEER BENCHMARK 72 HCP – 1200 METRES

Trusted Warrior - Slow to muster early speed. Jockey B McCoull stated the gelding which was first up from a spell would derive a benefit from the run and would be better suited to a track with more give.

Apriano - Contacted the running rail at approximately 800 metres on a number of occasions.
