Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

Drivers competing at today's meeting were subject to breathalyser analysis.

RACE 1 – PAGE TRANSPORT STAKES HEAT TWO – 2150 METRES

RUBY MAYS SHADOW broke free of interference on two occasions at the 900 metres and 250 metres and has now been stood down from racing for 10 days and a trial.

BETTOR GO GO led before then surrendering the lead in the early stages as TRIPLE AITCH FELLA worked forward to the lead.

Prior to the all clear being given, driver Dylan Ford (MARNU THE BEAST) asked to view the patrol films of the concluding stages and after doing so then lodged a protest against TRIPLE AITCH FELLA being declared winner of the event alleging interference in the home straight. After hearing submissions from both drivers, viewing the films and acting on their own observations it was established that TRIPLE AITCH FELLA had shifted out in the home straight causing MARNU THE BEAST then to be shifted out towards JIMMY DE PANDA and were comfortably satisfied that the extent of interference exceeded the official margin of 0.2 metres and upheld the protest. Driver John Walters pleaded guilty to a charge under 162(1)(www) and after taking into consideration his guilty plea and no previous offences under the rule for 5 years he was fined the sum of \$100.

Driver Peter Dornauf (JIMMY DE PANDA) was placed at a disadvantage over the concluding stages when his near side rein became undone from the bit in the home straight. Stewards inspected the reins which were found to be near new quality and observed that one of the rein buckle pins had bent. No action was taken in relation to the incident.

RACE 2 – T.M. FOLEY FUNERAL DIRECTORS PACE – 1670 METRES

HAZEL GRANT led in the early stages before surrendering the lead from the middle stages as LEAD SINGER worked forward to lead. HAZEL GRANT then tired over the concluding stages.

EL JAYS MYSTERY which broke after start has now been placed out of the draw.

BUSTER BRUV pulled hard during the run and was unsuccessful in shifting ITSNOTALWAYSABOUTU(Christian Salter) wider on the track in the back straight on the final occasion.

RACE 3 – MAXFIELD DRILLING STAKES – 2150 METRES

BIG MISCHIEF which had not started in a race since the 13th of May 2016 underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to run.

LORRAINE GRANT crossed to lead then surrendered the lead in the early stages as JOHNS LEGACY worked forward to the lead. JOHNS LEGACY pulled hard in the score up contacting the barrier arm and then shifted down the track towards LORRAINE GRANT briefly inconveniencing that runner. JOHNS LEGACY has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

Driver Jack Laugher JOHNS LEGACY was reprimanded for permitting his driver to contact marker pegs entering home straight on the final occasion.

VINNIE TORETTO hung out in the score up and then raced outside the leader from the middle stages.

RACE 4 – REBECCA WHITE STAKES DIVISION ONE – 1670 METRES

GUNA ROCKTILLYOUDROP NZ Allister Woods was caught wide in the early stages before then being restrained to a rearward trailing position and then giving ground over the concluding stages. The gelding was tired to be finished beaten 42.5 meters and underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Connections of JACKMICHAELS advised their intention to restrain the gelding at the start and drive with a sit. Stewards approved the change of tactics and the gelding was driven accordingly.

FLASH ANATOMY was held up and not able to obtain a clear running over the concluding stages. Jack Laugher was reprimanded pursuant to AHHR 238 for failing to attend the all clear.

SHADOW STORM was detained on course to allow post race swab samples to be taken at 5.15 p.m

RACE 5 – NORTHERN TAS LIGHT HARNESS CUP HEAT ONE – 2150 METRES

DELLAS COMMAND, SOLID AS A ROCK, MODERN CHIC and ITZ GEMMAS DELIGHT all galloped out and have been placed on their last chance in the draw.

DRIFTING AWAY raced rough at the start and was slowly away.

Driver John Walters(CEMENTO RAPIDO) was reprimanded pursuant to AHHR 238 for failing to return to the all-clear.

Stewards queried driver Gareth Rattray ITZ GEMMAS DELIGHT as to the reasons for him not persisting in his efforts to get to the outside of the track in the home straight. Mr Rattray explained that the mare had galloped away at the start and lost in his view 30 metres and that

he then obtained the back of SOLID AS A ROCK rounding the home however with runners in front of him continuing to fan wider and with the mare under driving at that stage he then elected to save ground and pursue an inside run. Stewards accepted the explanation put forward.

A post-race swab sample was taken from RUSTY RED COMENT winner of the event.

RACE 6 – NORTHERN TAS LIGHT HARNESS CUP HEAT TWO – 2150 METRES

SWAP ME(R Duggan) galloped out. MERSEY DELIGHT(P Ashwood) swung sideways as the start was effected and then galloped out and was then checked by the galloping SWAP ME which had shifted abruptly up the track despite the efforts of its driver. MERSEY DELIGHT and LIKE IT IS(C Viney) then locked wheels, dislodging both drivers. Mr Viney was able to maintain the reins of his gelding and the driverless MERSEY DELIGHT was captured by the Clerk of the Course. LIKE IT IS underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no apparent abnormalities. Drivers Paul Ashwood and Chris Viney were examined by oncourse Ambulance Officers and were found to be suffering from minor abrasions only.

Stewards held the all-clear in order to view the film at the start and after doing so were satisfied that JAKKA LEN NZ had commenced a sideways shift momentarily prior to the start being affected and was not facing forward, and was then declared a non-runner with all monies ordered to be returned. Winning bets were ordered to be paid less 8cents in the dollar with place bets to be paid less 9cents in the dollar. SWAP ME and MERSEY DELIGHT have both been placed out of the draw for future standing start events. JACCKA LEN has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

RACE 7 – LAUNCESTON BOBCAT HIRE STAKES DIVISION TWO – 1670 METRES

CRAFTY OLD FOX surrendered the lead in the early stages to TIBYTOA, CRAFTY OLD FOX was then held up rounding the home turn before then obtaining an inside run close to the finish.

A post-race swab sample was taken from TIBYTOA winner of the event.

KEN TWO STARS (Mark Yole) which raced three pegs in the run was unable to obtain clear running.

SAYWHAT was fractious in the score up.

RACE 8 – VANDERNBERG TRANSPORT PACE DIVISION THREE – 1670 METRES

PRINCE OF DAWN after showing gate speed to lead then withstood a brief challenge for the lead from DEVIL OF TYNE which then raced outside the leader for the remainder of the race.

FROSTY UNION has been placed back in the mobile draw.

OSCAR BLAKEDON which was out of position at the start will continue right out of the draw.

RACE 9 – CRESSY TRANSPORT CLAIMER – 2150 METRES

REGAL STRIDE NZ and TISU TOOTA both galloped out and have been placed on their last chance in the draw.

WILLIAMLEE which galloped out and then continued to gallop for some distance losing considerable ground has been placed out of the draw for standing start events and must now complete 3 consecutive satisfactory performances to be reinstated.

CYRILFROMTHEPOCKET has been placed back in the standing start draw.

PADABING STRIDE which galloped out has now been placed out of the draw.
