Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

RACE 1 – CRUSTYS BAKER/CAFÉ PACE – 1892 METRES

HERBIE HAZE unsuccessfully contested the lead in the early stages with IDEAL FELLA before then racing outside the leader for the duration of the event.

BERTILS DELIGHT broke after the start and will continue out of the draw, that mare was then held up and unable to obtain clear running over the concluding stages.

FUTURE PROMISES and HOOPER ROAD have now been reinstated in the standing start draw.

Driver Conor Crook (FLASH ANATOMY) pleaded guilty to a charge pursuant to AR 170(1), for having his foot out of the sulky foot rest whilst using the whip after the start and was fined the sum of \$100.

LONG AGO raced rough after the start.

RACE 2 – BURNIE CITY COUNCIL PACE – 2180 METRES

SKETCH raced rough in the score-up and was out of position at the start and will now be placed out of the draw for future mobile start events.

BETTOR GO GO showed gate speed to then cross and lead AVALON AVA around the first turn, then tired over the concluding stages. The mare underwent a post veterinary examination which revealed no apparent abnormalities.

PREFERRED LIES which had not started a race since August 2013 underwent a pre-race veterinary examination which indicated the gelding was fit to race. That gelding then worked forward to the position to outside the leader. Driver Adrian Collins foot slipped from the sulky footrest entering the home straight.

SOPHIAS ANGEL was out of position when the start was effected and will continue out of the draw. The mare then broke free of interference racing in to the home straight on the first occasion and has been placed on her last chance to truly.

A post-race swab sample was taken from HOT SHOT BONNIE winner of the event.

RACE 3 – BETTA MILK PACE – 2180 METRES

LORRAINE GRANT galloped out and continued to gallop for an excessive distance and then trailed the field for the remainder of the event. The mare has been placed out of the draw from standing starts.

MISS SHARAPOVA swung sideways and the galloped out and has also placed out of the draw for standing start events.

FIERY TURBULENCE broke free of interference at the 400 metres mark and has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

BUTTERS was inconvenienced after the start

PARWILL was inconvenienced after the start and then raced rough throughout the race.

Acting on a confirmed telephone call from trainer Bill Dornauf who advised that CEMENTO RAPIDO was not able to be brought to the races, Stewards ordered that geldings scratching at 4.35 p.m. After receiving submissions from trainer and driver Duncan Dornauf the twenty eight day stand-down was reduced to ten days.

RACE 4 – NATONE PRIMARY SCHOOL PACE – 2180 METRES

DELLAS COMMAND which galloped out will now be placed out of the draw. Driver Adrian Collins was fined \$100 pursuant to AR 162(1)d for delaying the start in that he failed to come onto the track and face the tapes when directed to do so by the starter.

OUR MAXICAM was fractious in the pre start circle and then swung sideways at the start, severely checking DAYRAID which then tailed the field. OUR MAXICAM has been placed out of the draw and must complete one satisfactory standing start trial before competing again from that start type.

FROSTY UNION was fractious before the start, the gelding then pulled hard in the middle stages of the event before then tiring.

MISS RUTHLESS which galloped out has placed on its last chance in the draw.

Stewards inquired into the reasons for STRANGE CONDUCT breaking racing into the back straight on the final occasion. After taking evidence from drivers Heath Szczyпка and Adrian Collins (DELLAS COMMAND) , Mr Collins pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 163(1)(a) (iii), the particulars being that he shifted out at that point in the race off the back of the tiring FROSTY UNION and in the process of doing so contacted STANGE CONDUCT causing that gelding to then be contacted and break. Mr Collins licence to drive in races suspended for the three race dates, commencing at midnight on Sunday December 10 and expiring at midnight on Tuesday December 26.

HEZA RUMMAGE NZ which fell whilst circling prior to the start on the grass infield underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to run.

RACE 5 – GOWANS MOTOR GROUP PACE – 2500 METRES

ULTIMATE COURAGE which galloped out has been placed on its last chance in the draw

TIBYTOA which galloped out will continue out of the draw.

Driver Rohan Hillier (LORD JONES NZ) was fined the sum of \$100 pursuant to AR 170(1), the particulars being he used the whip whilst he drove his horse forwards after the start when his right foot was out the sulky footrest.

Driver Allister Woods LAUGHYAHEADOFF was reprimanded pursuant to AR 170(1) for having his foot free of the foot rest when driving forward with the reins after the start.

CHRISTIAN JAZ NZ had a tendency to pull hard at various stages, that gelding was also inconvenienced after the start by the galloping TIBYTOA.

RACE 6 – THE ADVOCATE NEWSPAPER PACE – 2180 METRES

CARLAS HEAVEN hung in the early part of the score-up.

SHADOW CONTROL was held up unable to obtain clear running.

LAIID BACK KENNY contacted the mobile barrier, despite the efforts of driver Conor Crook and the broke as the start was affected. The gelding now been placed out of the draw for future mobile start events.

ISUNDULA ARTIST was held up over the concluding stages.

A lease agreement was processed for ISUNDULA ARTIST prior to the race meeting registering Angela Castles as the lessee of that gelding.

RACE 7 – RELAY FOR LIFE CLAIMER – 2180 METRES

TISU TOOTA led the event.

JUKEBOX MUSIC which galloped out has now been placed out of the draw and must complete three satisfactory standing consecutive starts to be reinstated.

PUSHKIN NZ raced outside the leader throughout before tiring over the concluding stages.

MOTO KENNY NZ (Jack Laughter) stood flat footed at the start and has now been placed on its last chance in the draw.

REGAL STRIDE NZ was slowly away.

CYRILFROMTHE POCKET was inconvenienced after the start by the galloping JUKEBOX MUSIC.
