Comments / Explanations:

Anthony Darmanin was advised he must submit a medical certificate prior to riding again.

Stewards accepted the explanation for co-trainers, Chris Crook and Imogen Miller for the late notification of their riders.

RACE 1 – COCA-COLA AMATIL MAIDEN/CLASS 1– 1600 METRES

The Austrian Oak NZ – Held up for clear racing room rounding the home turn.

Lady Wynette – Checked near the 800 metres. Between the 600 meters and 400 metres brushed with Heaven's Delight on a number of occasions when attempting to obtain clear running. Near the 200 metres momentarily restrained when Sh'bourne Star (B Muchu) shifted in. Bulent Muchu was advised to exercise care when allowing his mounts to shift ground.

Lovely Lady – Raced 3 wide without cover in the middle stages. Inconvenienced near the 1200 metres. Approaching the finish, momentarily tightened for room by Global Princess which shifted in and Balestrand (NZ).

Wyuna – Held up for clear racing room rounding the home turn and the early part of the home straight.

Boss Cat – Jumped away awkwardly and bumped with The Grey Crusader.

Heaven's Delight - Carried inwards and had to be checked away from Global Princess.

Snippety Cat – Fractious in the barriers. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the gelding. Near the 1200 metres when over racing clipped the heels of Sh'bourne Star when the pace eased. Shifted out inconveniencing Lovely Lady. Rider Chris Graham pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(A)(5)(a)(i), in that he used his whip in consecutive strides on 3 occasions prior to the 100 metres. Chris Graham was subsequently fined the sum of \$200.00

The Grey Crusader – Fractious in the barriers. Connections were advised that the gelding must trial to Stewards satisfaction prior to racing. Bumped on jumping away.

Sh'bourne Star – Near the 800 metres, when the pace slackened improved up onto the heels of Rodessa and shifted out checking Lady Wynette. Cast a near hind plate in running. Rider Bulent Muchu stated that the mare was inclined to lay out throughout the event. Inconvenienced near the 150 metres.

Miss Merikan – Slow into stride.

Jockey Troy Baker (Global Princess), pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(a) careless riding, the carelessness being that he permitted his mount to shift in near the 150 metres and made insufficient effort to straighten his mount, whilst not clear of Heaven's Delight, (Craig Newitt), resulting in that filly being taken inwards and having to be checked. Troy Baker's licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight 20th of December 2017 and expire at midnight 26th December 2017. In determining penalty steward's took into account Troy Baker's guilty plea, good record and the abrupt shift of Global Princess.

RACE 2 – TREASURY WINES MAIDEN 3YO & UP– 1200 METRES

Boltoutoftheblue – Near the 700 metres had to be restrained off the heels of Silent Savings when the pace slackened.

Silent Savings – Near the 200 metres, was momentarily inconvenienced by Gee Gees Liberty (S Carr), which shifted in. Sigrid Carr was advised to exercise care when allowing her mounts to shift ground.

Sirkadir – Near the 800 metres whilst over racing had to steady off the heels of Boltoutoftheblue.

Amber In Paris – Passing the 100 metres had difficulty in obtaining clear running.

Lyonesse – Jumped away awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

French Dandy – Near the 700 metres had to be restrained off the heels of Boltoutoftheblue when the pace slackened. Near the 200 metres momentarily tightened for room by Lyonesse and Silent Savings, which shifted out slightly after being inconvenienced.

Gee Gees Liberty – Rider Sigrid Carr stated the filly over raced in the middle stages.

Miss Tyly - Slow into stride.

RACE 3 – OLDE TUDOR UBET OUTLET 0-58– 1200 METRES

Kryptonian – Rider Bulent Muchu stated that in his opinion the gelding would be better suited over a further distance.

Christopher Mac – Slow into stride. Rider Craig Newitt stated that the gelding layed out throughout the race and felt awkward in its action. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to have a short action in front in particular the near foreleg. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate of soundness must be produced prior to racing again.

Ponzi – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Gee Gee Rich Ruby – Connections submitted a veterinary clearance prior to racing tonight.

RACE 4 – CUB BENCHMARK 72 HCP – 1600 METRES

Geeges Brightstar – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have sustained a laceration to the inside of the right nostril.

Smoke 'n' Whiskey – Tightened on jumping away by Minute Repeater and King Manu. Rider Jason Benbow stated that the gelding failed to stretch out in the early stages and was inclined to change legs on a number of occasions. Jason Benbow further added that the gelding may be better suited to a track with more give. A veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have jarred up.

Son Of Faith – Approaching the 1200 metres when over racing was momentarily tightened and had to restrain off the heels of Miss Hissy (T Voorham) when the pace slackened. Teagan Voorham was advised to exercise care and allow sufficient room when crossing. Held up for clear racing room rounding the home turn.

Earl Da Vinci – Raced wide in the early stages. Rider David Pires stated that the gelding had to work hard early to take up a forward position which may have been detrimental to finishing off the race.

RACE 5 – TAS HOSPITALITY ASSOCIATION F&M CLASS 1 HCP– 1400 METRES

Anastasia – Rounding the home turn had difficulty obtaining clear running.

Schillie Billie – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Clean Acheeva – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Rounding the home turn, had difficulty obtaining clear running.

Sunset Party – Raced 3 wide without cover throughout.

RACE 6 – TASSIE INSTANT MARQUEES CLASS 1 HCP C&G– 1400 METRES

Beautiful Boy – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Our Artie – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn.

The Greatness – Rider Troy Baker explained that after beginning well he was left further forward than at its most recent starts.

Pennstock – Rider Craig Newitt explained that after not beginning cleanly and due to the pace of runners to his inside he elected to restrain the gelding which left him further back than anticipated.

Quiet Wonder – Raced awkwardly rounding the home turn. Near the 150 metre mark had difficulty obtaining clear running.

RACE 7 – TASSAL TASMANIAN SALMON BENCHMARK 68 HP– 1100 METRES

Due to the upgrade in the track conditions subsequent to final scratching's and acting under the provisions of LR.14.10, Stewards acceded to the request of trainer John Blacker to withdraw Sebring's Joy, Welcome Invader, Jupiter's Moon and Seajamm.

Seabring's Joy - Late scratching at 9.15PM due to the upgrade in the track conditions.

Jacques - Late scratching at 9.34AM when it was reported the gelding was suffering from colic. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness must be submitted prior to racing again.

Welcome Invader - Late scratching at 9.15PM due to the upgrade in the track conditions

Jupiter's Moon - Late scratching at 9.15PM due to the upgrade in the track conditions.

Seajamm - Late scratching at 9.15PM due to the upgrade in the track conditions.

Fascinating Lady – Slow into stride (2L). Inclined to lay out throughout. Trainer Teagan Keys advised that the mare had pulled up lame and would now be retired.

GENERAL

Tasmanian Turf Club meeting 22nd November 2017, Race 5 – Grab a picnic car space at the Longford Cup benchmark 62 HCP, 1600 Metres. Stewards inquired into the reasons for Lydnspur, (Hayley McCarthy) being carried wider on the track near the 1400 metres by Littlerayov, (Sherry Barr).

It was established that Littlerayov which commenced to race in the 3 wide position shifted out slightly near the 1400 metres and brushed with Lyndspur. After the initial contact Littlerayov then shifted slightly wider and carried Lyndspur wider on the track. Stewards were not satisfied that any one rider was at fault, however advised Miss Barr to exercise care when allowing her mounts to shift ground.
