RACE 1 –LD HAMER MEMORIAL PACE 1680 – METRES MOBILE

Princess Of Troy broke gait in the score up and has been placed out of the draw in future mobile start events.

Yankee Avenue was out of position at the start. Driver I Johnson was reprimanded under the provisions of AHRR 162(1) (h) for failing to come up into position.

J Jalowenko (Just Jiggy Jogging) was reminded of his obligations under AHRR 156(4) (d) for loose reining over the concluding stages.

Jamayan Bella hung in and broke gait approaching the finish line. Stewards delayed all clear to review the patrol films to ascertain whether the mare had gained an advantage to the detriment of another runner. After reviewing the films the Stewards were satisfied that no advantage had been gained and all clear was declared.

RACE 2 –SHINE RETAIL THERAPY– 2079 METRES STANDING START

Regmondo was fractious prior to the start and will continue to be placed out of the draw in standing start races.

No Issue broke gait briefly entering the home straight before being restrained. Stewards were satisfied that no advantage had been gained pursuant to AHRR 155(1). The gelding has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

Driver Tim Yole was issued with a reprimand under AHRR 156(4) (d) for loose reining over the concluding stages.

P Jakowenko the driver of Lildudewifattitude lodged a protest against Optimus Bart (G Rattray) being declared the winner for alleged interference approaching the home turn. Upon inquiry it was established that Lildudewifattitude had attempted a run to the inside of Optimus Bart where there was doubtful racing room and was hampered and lost its position. As the interference could not be fully attributable to Optimus Bart the protest was dismissed.
