Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

RACE 1 – SOMERSET HOTEL THORATE INCENTIVE – 2180 METRES

The start of this event was delayed due to a Pinjarra gallops race running behind schedule.

TOUCHWOOD LEVISTA was fractious before the start.

LEOTHEGREAT and BERTY MACK raced rough at the start

KRAFTY BOY which galloped out has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

Stewards inquired into an incident that occurred racing around the home turn and after taking evidence from drivers C Woods(TOUCHWOOD LEVISTA), G Rattray (SMALLESTOFTHESMALL) and Todd Rattray (IDEAL FELLA) Mr Woods pleaded guilty to a charge under AHRR 163 (1)(a)(iii) for causing interference. The particulars of the charge being that he shifted out when insufficiently clear resulting in SMALLESTOFTHESMALL being taken out onto the sulky of IDEAL FELLA and breaking. Mr Woods licence to drive in races was suspended for 3 race dates commencing midnight tonight and expiring at midnight on the 28th January. MOLLY MALONES was also checked and broke as was KRAFTY BOY as a consequence of SMALLESTOFTHESMALL being checked and breaking.

RACE 2 – CABLES PLUS PACE – 2180 METRES

A transfer of ownership was processed prior to the race meeting indicating Wade Rattray to be the new owner of ARK FURY. That gelding had a tendency to hang out which caused SKETCH(C Castles) to be tightened on the home turn. ARK FURY was unable to obtain clear running in the home straight. Driver J Walters was advised to make every effort to keep his drive straight in similar circumstances.

CHARLIE PANTS hung out in the score up, inconveniencing both DEECEE GLENWOOD and SKETCH, and has now been placed out of the draw. CHARLIE PANTS then continued

to hang out throughout and was retired from the event by driver Craig Hayes with a lap to travel. CHARLIE PANTS has been stood down from racing for 10 days and until the completion of a satisfactory trial. Trainer Geoff Smith reported that the bit had partially slipped through the gelding's mouth.

CLASS TELLS underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed signs of irritation to both eyes which was treated by the on course veterinarian. The filly has been stood down from racing pending a veterinary certificate of fitness to race.

Stewards held the all clear to in order to view films of the home turn and after doing so whilst being satisfied AVALON AVA had contacted and raced with its inside sulky wheel inside the pegs were not comfortably satisfied that the result was affected and All clear was given on the judges numbers. Driver Ben Parker pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 163(1)(c) and was suspended for two race dates commencing midnight tonight and expiring midnight on the 24th January.

RACE 3 – HELLYERS ROAD DISTILLERY PACE – 2180 METRES

Post-race swab samples were taken from BLISSTAR, winner of the event.

BLACK OPS (M Yole), commenced to move three wide in the early stages, however then was restrained in the middle stages as BLISSTAR(J Walters) elected to not surrender the position outside the leader.

RACE 4 – BURNIE HARNESS RACING CLUB CUP – 2789 METRES

LIV LAVISH NZ galloped out and was placed out of the draw.

CHILLA BREEZE galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

FULL SPEED AHEAD which broke free of interference has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

Stewards held the all clear at the request of driver A Woods (LAUGHYAHEADOFF) in order to view the films of the concluding stages. Mr Woods then lodged a protest against the winner alleging interference over the concluding stages. After hearing submissions from both parties Stewards were not comfortably satisfied the required standard that LAUGHYAHEADOFF had been impeded and the protest was dismissed with all clear being declared on the judges numbers.

Post-race swab samples were taken from HEZ THE ONE, winner of the event.

RACE 5 – KELLY'S WASTE MANAGEMENT PACE – 2500 METRES

LONG AGO shifted out at the start inconveniencing DELLAS COMMAND .

DELLAS COMMAND pulled hard for the duration of the race whilst racing outside the leader.

PUSHKIN raced rough in the early stages before then working forward to the lead.

DAYRAID was held up in the latter part of the event.

HEZA RUMMAGE NZ was held up for clear racing room in the home straight.

RACE 6 – THE FLOWER GALLERY NORTH WEST PLATE HEAT ONE – 2180 METRES

PENSTOCK BOY broke shortly after the start and has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

YODELLIN COWGIRL was slowly away then raced rough at the start and was checked after the start as PENSTOCK BOY galloped. HERBIE HAZE was also inconvenienced and broke and shifted out towards HOT SHOT BONNIE which also tended to shift in and then also broke.

REGAL MAJOR raced rough at the start and was slowly away. The gelding which tired over the last lap underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no apparent normalities.

MISS RUTHLESS was checked after the start by the galloping SHADOW STORM. SHADOW STORM has been placed in last chance in the draw and was also held up over the concluding stages.

CEMENTO RAPIDO which trailed the leader after beginning well from its 30m handicap was then held up and unable to obtain clear running.

RACE 7 – BURNIE CITY COUNCIL NORTH WEST PLATE HEAT TWO – 2180 METRES

HAMNA SHIDA which galloped out has been placed on its last chance of the draw. The mare then broke free of interference on the first turn has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

GUYS DELIGHT also galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

UNION FORCE which galloped out which will continue out of the draw.

DIDDLEY BOW which galloped out has been placed out of the draw.

ARTARAMA was inconvenienced on the first turn by the galloping SEVENTH LEGEND and had to race wider as did KARALTA KRUISE.

ARTARAMA pulled hard whilst racing outside the leader.

RACE 8 – ENVOGUE MODELLING ACADEMY PACE – 2180 METRES

AS HIMSELF worked forward to race outside the leader.

Acting on a confirmed telephone call from trainer Samantha Freeman who advised that ITSNOTALWAYSBOUYOU suffered from a leg injury and was unfit to start, Stewards ordered that gelding to be a late scratching at 11.30am. ITSNOTALWAYSBOUYOU has been stood down from racing for 28 days which may be varied upon production of a veterinary certificate stating the reasons for the scratching.

BUCKINGHAM BOY which broke on the first turn has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

OSCAR BLAKEDON broke under pressure approaching the finish.
