RACE 1 – CASCADE DRAUGHT MAIDEN 3YO & UPWARDS - SET WEIGHTS – 1200 METRES

His Nibs – Threw its head in the air on jumping and was slow to begin.

Shorty Knox – Rider T Baker was reprimanded under AR 137(a) for careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift in near the 700 metres when not clear of **Lion Speed** with that mare having to steady. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to have bled from both nostrils. Trainer Mr John Hill was advised of the provision of AR 53A(4) in that **Shorty Knox** may not be trained, exercised or galloped on any racecourse for a period of two (2) months and it may not start in any race for a period of three (3) months and completed a satisfactorily gallop over at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward.

Lion Speed – Steadied near the 700 metres.

Geeges Cash Cow – Lay in over the concluding stages.

RACE 2 – HAZELL BROTHERS MAIDEN 3YO & UPWARDS– SET WEIGHTS – 1400 METRES

Bad Luck – Commenced awkwardly and was then bumped by **Zipponet**.

Berbent – Bumped near the 1200 metres.

Zipponet – Shifted in on jumping, tightening **Bad Luck**. Raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

Blackburn – Slow into stride.

The Decider – Bumped near the 1200 metres.

I'm a Lucky Girl – Withdrawn at 10.00 am when the filly was found to have sustained multiple lacerations sustained in the horse transporter en route to the race-course. Trainer John Luttrell was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness will be required before the filly will be permitted to race again.

Onnanoko – Lay inwards in the straight. Rider A Ismadi dismounted from the filly on the track following the running of this race as the filly was becoming agitated.

Rogue One – Bumped near the 1200 metres.

RACE 3 – HOBART CUP FASHIONS ON THE FIELD BM58 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

Strathalbyn – Over-raced in the early stages.

The Grey Crusader – Lay out making the home turn.

Powerful Prospect – Slow into stride. Raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

RACE 4 – trchobart.com.au CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

The announcement of correct weight was delayed when the rider of the second placegetter **Son of a Fling**, G Catania requested to view the official Stewards' patrol video of the home straight.

By the Pound – Reared on jumping and consequently was slow to begin. Shortly after, steadied off heels getting its head up. Had a tendency to lay inwards in the home straight.

West On Broadway – Raced wide throughout.

The Financier – Slow to begin.

No Money No Honey – Blocked for a clear run for majority of straight.

Shining Star – Over-raced in the early stages. Had difficulty obtaining a clear passage in the home straight.

RACE 5 – WOLF BLASS LADY LYNETTE – FILLIES & MARES – SET WEIGHTS - NO CLAIMS – 1100 METRES

Gee Gee Double Dee – Momentarily steadied at the 800 metres.

Angel of the Abyss – Shifted inwards quickly on straightening

Teriki – Slow to begin.

Tambro's Game – Shifted out near the 800 metres and carried **Step the Pedal** wider on the track.

RACE 6 – KEVIN SHARKIE HOBART GUINEAS - 3YO – SET WEIGHTS – NO CLAIMS - LISTED – 2100 METRES

Cavalero – Raced wide in the early and middle stages. Bumped near the 1900 metres. Rider N Beriman reported that in her opinion the gelding had not travelled well to Tasmania and had raced in a “flat” manner.

Overplay – Passing the 200 metres, was carried outwards and inconvenienced by **Wolfendale** which shifted outwards quickly.

Wolfendale – Shifted outwards quickly near the 200 metres inconveniencing **Overplay**. Whilst the Stewards accepted that the gelding had shifted quickly, Rider Dean Yendall was advised to make every effort to keep his mounts straight.

Double You Tee – Bumped near the 1900 metres. Lay inwards over the final 200 metres.

Bosporus – Passing the 1900 metres when being steadied, over-raced and got its head up and again near the 1400 metres.

Kandahar – Fractious in the barriers. Near the 1600 metres, when racing keenly, restrained off the heels of **Wolfendale** and shifted out, bumping with **Cavalero** on several occasions.

Beautiful Boy – Shifted in on jumping and hampered **Cavalero**.

RACE 7 – SCHWEPPE'S SUMMER CUP – WEIGHT FOR AGE – NO CLAIMS – 2200 METRES

Fastnet Dragon – Raced wide from approaching the 500 metres.

Up Cups – Held up approaching the turn into the home straight.

Hugo – Over-raced in the early stages.

Geegees Baritone – When questioned, Rider Daniel Ganderton explained that the gelding had “sweated up” prior to the race and after racing forward and being put under pressure approaching the turn into the straight, the gelding failed to respond. Rider Ganderton was of the opinion that **Geegees Baritone** may have been affected by the heat conditions today and under those circumstances, he did not ride the gelding out in the straight. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Vandermeer – Raced three wide throughout.

Speed Force – Over-raced in the early stages.

Wyuna – Withdrawn at 12.00 midday when the mare was found to be lame in the off-hind leg as it was being loaded onto the float to travel to the race-course. Trainer S. Brunton was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness will be required before racing again.

RACE 8 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS BM80 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Geegees Brightstar – Slow into stride. Steadied off heels approaching the 1200 metres.

Chillout – When questioned, Rider Craig Newitt explained that the gelding had been well placed throughout but failed to run on and may have been affected by today's hot conditions.

Secrets She Has – Raced wide throughout.

Hyperbole – Raced wide throughout.

Sentry Duty – When questioned regarding the gelding's disappointing performance today, Rider Troy Baker explained that the gelding was up in class and he was of the opinion that today's hot conditions may have affected the gelding. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

GENERAL

Licensed Stablehand Mrs Yasmin Maskiell pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 178A (i) for having in her possession at Mowbray on 15 November 2017, syringes and a needles in her race day gear. Mrs Maskiell stated that it had been an oversight on her behalf that the sealed and unused syringes and needles had been left in the raceday bag. In all the circumstances, Stewards accepted Mrs Maskiell's explanation however, Mrs Maskiell was fined the sum of \$200.
