RACE 1 – Dolly's Dream Foundation Benchmark 62 HCP – 1200 METRES

Apriano – Raced wide in the early stages.

Steel Dan – Bumped on jumping.

Gee Gee Spitfire – Bumped on jumping.

Mon Londo – Shifted outwards shortly after the start

Owens – Made contact on jumping and then carried wide. Momentarily held up leaving the 100 metres and then lay inwards.

Sebring's Joy – Tightened on jumping and buffered shortly after and then carried wide.

Bedrock Dreams – Proved difficult to load, trainer R Hamer was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare. Bumped on jumping.

Mariah's Magic – Raced wide from the 700 metres.

Lonhwan – Inconvenienced shortly after the start. Trainer R Hamer was fined the sum of \$50 for presenting the gelding late into Parade Ring.

RACE 2 – Robyn Whishaw Luncheon @ The Mercure Class 1 HCP – 1400 METRES

Go For It – Momentarily held up entering straight. Cast off hind plate during running.

Tale Of The Fox – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Somerset – Momentarily held up on the home turn.

Westwood – Rider John Maskiell reported that the gelding could not muster speed early. Shifted out to obtain a clear run at the 200 metres.

Dubbo – Lay in the in home straight.

Fought For – Raced wide throughout.

Modern Dane – Reared on jumping. Bumped near the 400 metres and then steadied approaching the 200 metres when disappointed for a run.

Egalitarian – Raced wide from the 700 metres.

Pelagia – Commenced awkwardly and shortly after inconvenienced

RACE 3 – Sky Racing Launceston Cup In February Class 3 HCP - 1400 METRES

Liffeybeau – Raced wide throughout.

Amaword – Commenced awkwardly

Biscay Barb – Bumped on jumping and again near the 400 metres.

Catalyst Fire – Inconvenienced shortly after start. When questioned Rider D Pires advised that after receiving tightening at the start the mare had got further back than anticipated and when the tempo increased from the 600 metres the mare failed to quicken and consequently got out of its ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Speedonova – Apprentice A Ismadi was fined the sum of \$200 under AR 137A (5) (a) (ii) for using the whip on more than five occasions before the 100 metres.

Westerly Haze – Raced tightly over concluding stages.

Mulley's Idol – Held tight over concluding stages.

Gasnier – Bumped heavily on jumping. Over-raced in the early stages.

Jupiter's Moon – Over-raced in the early stages and made contact with another runner near the 400 metres.

Acronym – Shifted outwards shortly after start.

RACE 4 – Fashions For Fillies Benchmark 64 HCP – 1600 METRES

Zatacla – Knuckled on jumping and held up for a clear run in the straight.

Olly's A Star – Buffered on jumping. Buffeted between runners on jumping and cast an off hind plate during running.

Welcome Invader – Raced greenly and lay inwards in the straight.

It's A Battle – Held up in the early stages of the straight.

Volcan De Fuego – Commenced awkwardly.

White Hawk – Rider C Newitt reported that the gelding did not respond when being ridden out.

Boltoutoftheblue – Bumped at the start. Held up approaching 100 metres.

Cranny Flyer – Shifted out on jumping.

Reann's Diamond – Checked shortly after the start when Cranny Flyer shifted outwards on jumping carrying **Time Commands** out. At the same time **White Hawk** veered inwards carrying **Olly's A Star** in onto **Kryptonian** crowding **Reann's Diamond**

Time Commands – Bumped and taken outwards at the start.

Kryptonian – Carried inwards and inconvenienced on jumping.

RACE 5 – Purchase Your Launceston Cup Tickets Online 2YO Maiden – 1200 METRES

Gee Gees Magic Man – Bumped on jumping and then steadied. Held up approaching home turn, rider S Carr reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout.

Gee Gees Wild One – Raced wide throughout and raced greenly in the straight.

Blackberry Rose – Bumped on jumping.

Buzzered – Raced keenly and then placed in restricted racing room in the early stages. Lay inwards throughout.

Moonlight Escapade – Bumped on jumping.

Oh So Needy – Shifted in abruptly shortly after the start. Held up passing the 150 metre and was taken outwards and raced tightly over the concluding stages.

RACE 6 – Dolly's Dream Benchmark 68 HCP – 2100 METRES

Bidirectional – Raced tightly passing the the winning post the first time. Held up approaching the turn into the straight and steadied.

Smoke 'N' Whisky – Had to be resaddled at the barrier. Shortly after the start the gelding attempted to buck on several occasions and consequently lost ground.

King Manu – Steadied near the 800 metres.

Savrajette – Commenced awkwardly and then balked losing significant ground.

Global Princess – Raced wide throughout. Rider Troy Baker reported that the mare felt short in its action and consequently eased it down in the straight. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed that the mare returned with an elevated heart rate and was slow to recover.

RACE 7 – Launceston Cup Calcutta @ The Riverview Maiden/Class 1 – 2100 METRES

Balestrand – On arriving at the barriers underwent a veterinary examination and passed fit to take its place in the field.

Striking Prospect – Pulled hard in the early and middle stages.

Chief Navigator- Lay inwards and brushed near the 900 metres.

Miss Artorius – Commenced awkwardly and shortly after was tightened. Inconvenienced approaching the turn into the straight and bumped with Boss Cat on its outside.

Shivida – Passing the 900 metres was brushed and became unbalanced when Chief Navigator which was racing to its outside lay inwards.

Boss Cat – Raced wide in the early stages. Bumped at turn into straight.

Centafloral – Held up in the home turn and bumped with Miss Artorius.

RACE 8 – Ritchie's Racing Club Luncheon @ Henry's F&M Maiden - 1100 METRES

Beenagem – Raced greenly throughout.

Black Jaguar – Underwent a routine veterinary examination prior to the start of this race as it had not started for a period of 12 months.

Miss Smith – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Trixie Dixie – Apprentice C Graham was fined \$100 under AR137A (4) (c) for using the whip when out of contention.

RACE 9 – Millinery Parade & Cup Barrier Draw @ The Mercure C & G Maiden - 1100 METRES

Deemarina – Underwent a routine veterinary examination prior to the start of this race as it had not started in a race in excess of 12 months.

Some Quest – Bumped on jumping. Over raced in the middle stages, commenced to give ground from the 500 metres. Trainer G Mcculloch advised that he would apply to race the gelding in blinkers and reassess its future after its next race start.

Speedy Illusion – Was a late withdrawal at 5:20pm when it was reported to be lame in the near hind. Trainer Mr Mark Ganderton was advised that a veterinary certificate of soundness would be required before that horse starts again.

Emmceeoh – Held up at the turn into the straight.

Thewordsout – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Treconi – Momentarily steadied near the 1000 metres. Raced wide in the early stages.
