On the first turn Red Orange Green and Georgie bumped, checking Red Orange Green, Georgie, Fishing Ducks and Lashing Stan. Approaching the home turn Stylish Russell and Top Thunder bumped. On the home turn Stylish Russell and Top Thunder bumped.

Suspect Nargles underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after it was discovered to have chewed its bedding while being kennelled and was subsequently passed fit to start. Soon after the start Almani Inferno and Magic Lizzie bumped. Approaching the first turn Suspect Nargles and Magic Lizzie bumped, checking Suspect Nargles. Almani Inferno, Stylish April and Matter Wit' Chew raced wide in the back straight. Approaching the first turn Almani Inferno, Stylish April and Matter Wit' Chew bumped. On the first turn Almani Inferno, Stylish April and Matter Wit' Chew bumped, checking all three greyhounds. On the home turn Suspect Nargles and Almani Inferno bumped, checking Suspect Nargles. Approaching the winning post Suspect Nargles faltered. Suspect Nargles underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected. Almani Inferno underwent a post-race veterinary examination was found to have split webbing to its left hind foot. Almani Inferno has been stood down from racing for a period of 7 days. Stewards spoke to Trainer D Critchley in relation to Suspect Nargles racing manners over the concluding stages. Acting on their own observations and viewing the official replays, Stewards were of the opinion that Suspect Nargles had eased in the home straight and again approaching the winning post and by doing so had failed to pursue the lure with due commitment throughout the event pursuant to GAR 69A(1). Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(2)(b), Suspect Nargles was stood down from racing for three months all tracks as this was the greyhounds second offence under this rule and until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

General:

Stewards concluded an inquiry into the reasons why Dolly Dyer was serviced whilst not being currently registered as a breeding female. After taking evidence off Trainer/Breeder Mrs R Johnson and Owner Mr M Mace, Stewards issued two charges to Mr Mace. The first charge being pursuant to LR13.3 "Unregistered breeder" and the second charged being pursuant to GAR 127(6) "Unregistered breeding female". Mr Mace pleaded guilty to both charges and was subsequently fined the sum of \$200 (\$100 suspended on the condition that he does not breach this rule again within a 12-month period) on both charges. Stewards subsequently issued a charge to Mrs R Johnson, who pleaded guilty, pursuant to GAR 86(o) for negligence in that she allowed Dolly Dyer to be served without having the appropriate "pink card" for this greyhound prior to the service.
