Comments / Explanations:

Jockey J Robertson advised Stewards that he was unable to complete his riding engagements due to influenza. Jockey Robertson was advised that he will be required to present a medical certificate before riding again.

RACE 1 – ROTARY CLUB OF CENTRAL LAUNCESTON MAIDEN– 1620 METRES

Archertein (H McCarthy) - Over raced in the early and middle stages, raced ungenerously throwing its head and placing its rider in difficulty.

Saalim (A Darmanin)- Inconvenienced approaching the 1500m.

San You (T Voorham)- Tightened and restrained near the 1500m.

Fearless Filou (S Carr) - Tightened and carried inwards approaching the 1500m.

Gwenville (D Ganderton) - Checked near the 1500m and lost ground. Rider D Ganderton reported that after receiving early interference the filly did not stretch out fully. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer K McCarthy advised the Stewards that **Gwenville** would now be retired.

Miss Buzz (I Toker) - Slow to begin.

Rodessa (M Ulucinar) - Inconvenienced and restrained approaching the 1500m. Raced wide throughout.

General:

Stewards inquired into interference suffered by a numbers of runners near the 1500m. On enquiry it was established that **Archertein (H McCarthy)** which was over racing and racing ungenerously had shifted in near the 1500m despite the efforts of Rider H McCarthy to keep that gelding straight, tightening **Fearless Filou**, which shifted in onto **Rodessa**, which in turn was carried on to **San You**, which shifted in tightening **Gwenville** which checked and lost ground. **He's Rushin'** which was racing to the inside of **Gwenville** was inconvenienced. Stewards accepted that Jockey H McCarthy was making every effort to keep her mount straight. Under these circumstances, Stewards advised trainer Mr Dylan Clark that **Archertein** would be required to trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards before starting in a race again.

RACE 2 – KEVIN SHARKIE MAIDEN– 1220 METRES

Synapse (T Voorham) - Brushed the running rail becoming unbalanced near the 400m.

Stinka (A Darmanin) - Commenced awkwardly and shifted out cannoning into **Look At This** which became unbalanced. Over raced in the early and middle stages and steadied near the 800m.

Gold Phoenix (S Carr) - Rider S Carr reported that the mare raced greenly throughout.

Mystic Molly (C Newitt) - Raced wide throughout.

lowna (I Toker) - Was slow into stride. When questioned, Rider I Toker reported that the filly had raced well in the early and middle stages and in his opinion would benefit from the experience of its first start.

Look At This (T Baker) - Bumped heavily on jumping and over raced in the early and middle stages. Steadied near the 800m away from the heels of **lowna**. Passing the 400m momentarily steadied.

RACE 3 – TASBRED BREEDING INCENTIVE SCHEME OPEN HCP – 1220 METRES

Chillout (C Newitt) - Restrained near the 100m when **Lord Farquaad** lay outwards under pressure.

Geegees Soprano (T Baker) - Slow into stride.

Blaze Forth (B McCoull) - Made the turn into the straight wide. Had a tendency to lay inwards in the home straight.

Teriki (T Voorham) - Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

Super Fun (A Darmanin) - Slow into stride.

The Captain (M Ulucinar) - Shifted outwards under pressure over the concluding 100m.

Lord Farquaad (D Ganderton) - Held up on straightening and then angled outwards to obtain clear running and over the concluding stages was carried outwards by **The Captain** which shifted out under pressure.

RACE 4 – SKY RACING TASMANIAN ST LEGER– 2650 METRES

Up Cups (B McCoull) - Tightened and steadied passing the 400m

Eastender (C Newitt) - Slow into stride.

Bidirectional (A Darmanin) - Slow into stride.

Kanji (I Toker) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Volcan De Fuego (D Ganderton) When questioned regarding the disappointing performance Rider D Ganderton explained that he placed the gelding under pressure from the 600m, however **Volcan De Fuego** then hung outwards and did not feel comfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the gelding was short in its action. Trainer S Brunton advised the Stewards that **Volcan De Fuego** will now be spelled.

White Hawk (T Voorham) - Connections advised Stewards prior to the running of this race that **White Hawk** would be ridden further back if possible. Raced wide from the 800m. Carried inwards passing the 400m.

General:

Jockey **C Newitt (Eastender)** was reprimanded for careless riding under AR137(a) for allowing his mount to shift inwards passing the 400m tightening **White Hawk (T Voorham)** which shifted in onto **Up Cups (B McCoull)** which steadied and was inconvenienced.

RACE 5 – AUSTRALIAN TRAINERS ASSOCIATION F&M HCP – 1620 METRES

Step The Pedal (C Newitt)- Bumped and became unbalanced passing the 800m.

Stella Etoile (A Darmanin) - Over raced in the middle stages and passing the 200m had difficulty obtaining a clear run eventually getting clear shortly after.

Gone Girl (I Toker) - Passing the 800m steadied when improving on to the heels of **Secret She Has** then shifted out making contact with **Step The Pedal** on its outside. Rider I Toker was warned and advised that he is to take more care when improving into the field.

Catalyst Fire (T Voorham) - Slow into stride.

RACE 6 – WEEDING HIRE BENCHMARK 72 HCP – 1620 METRES

Zatacla (B McCoull) - Bumped on jumping and shifted outwards. Raced ungenerously near the 1200m.

Barjeel (A Darmanin) - Lay in over the final 200m.

Son Of Faith (H McCarthy) - Shifted out and bumped at the start. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Olly's A Star (T Voorham) - Raced wide from the 800m.

RACE 7 – LIBERTY ONESTEEL BENCHMARK 62 HCP – 1220 METRES

Jo Anconi (T Voorham) - Raced wide throughout.

Son Of A Fling (D Ganderton) – Shifted outwards on jumping and bumped.

Cimarron's Hero (C Newitt)- Shifted in at the start making contact with Genuine Art

Genuine Art (M Ulucinar) - Checked shortly after the start when **Son Of A Fling** shifted outwards as **Cimarron's Hero** moved inwards.

Gee Gee Spitfire (S Carr) - Over raced in the early stages.

Top Draw (A Darmanin) - When questioned regarding the disappointing performance Rider A Darmanin explained that the mare has constantly changed stride throughout and may not have appreciated racing on the rail. Trainer Mr J Blacker also expressed disappointment with the performance and advised that **Top Draw** would now have its next start on the synthetic surface in Devonport.
