Comments / Explanations:

Stewards accepted the explanation of trainers Mr S Davis and Miss N Luttrell for the late notification of their riders.

Rider Troy Baker was advised that he must submit a medical clearance prior to riding again after being unable to fulfil his engagements due to illness.

After arriving on course rider John Robertson was examined by the club's medical officer and passed fit to fulfil his riding engagements. Stewards accepted the explanation of John Robertson for failing to submit a medical clearance prior to riding, however advised Mr Robertson that further action will be taken if in similar circumstances.

RACE 1 – SOUTHERN CROSS AUSTEREO 0-62 HCP– 1400 METRES

Go For It - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

One Way Ticket (NZ) - Trainer Adam Trinder was fined the sum of \$50 for presenting the gelding to the mounting yard with blinkers instead of visors.

Bayview Emperor - Slow into stride. Held up and disappointed for a run approaching the 100m before shifting out over the heels of **Kryptonian** to obtain clear running near the 50m.

Jupiter's Moon - Held up in the early part of the home straight until passing the 200m. Rider Daniel Ganderton stated that the gelding raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

Turtles Nest - Late scratching at 2:06pm due to no available rider.

Mulley's Idol - Late scratching at 2:21pm due to no available rider.

Dubbo - Shifted out shortly after the start. Brushed with **Sentimental Dream** passing the 200m and was then inclined to lay in, in the home straight. When questioned in relation to the disappointing performance rider Sigrid Carr could offer no explanation other than that the mare travelled well but failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure.

Kryptonian - Commenced awkwardly.

Little Elsa - Late scratching at 2:06pm due to no available rider.

Kelly's Diva - Checked shortly after the start when Dubbo (S Carr) shifted out. S Carr was advised to exercise more care when allowing her mounts to shift ground.

RACE 2 – KEVIN SHARKIE MAIDEN– 1400 METRES

Medard - Passing the 400m when laying out brushed with **La Superba**. Rider Sigrid Carr reported the gelding hung out throughout and proved difficult to ride in the home straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Zipponet - Rider Brendon McCoull stated the gelding was inclined to lay in, in the home straight.

Kent Street - Over raced in the early and middle stages. Brushed passing the 400m.

Westy - Raced greenly in the home straight.

Pinkeyes Pride - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Sorturo - Required to be resaddled behind the barriers.

Southern Belle - Slow into stride and had to be restrained when tightened for room.

RACE 3 – TAS HOTEL & CLUB SUPPLIES MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Shackley's Hill - Rider Jason Maskiell stated that the gelding over raced in the early and middle stages which was detrimental to the way the gelding finished off the race.

Miss Eleanor - Slow into stride and then shifted out abruptly. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider Brendon McCoull stated after racing wide the mare then raced keenly and failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure in the home straight.

Nahla - On jumping away shifted out and bumped with **Gee Gees Luckygirl**.

Sh'Bourne Star - Checked on jumping away when **Carmina** shifted in abruptly. Over raced in the early and middle stages. Near the 800m had to be restrained when improving up onto the heels of **Gee Gees Luckygirl**. Rider T Voorham was advised to exercise more care when allowing her mounts to improve and ensure she leaves sufficient room.

Beenagem - Reared in the barriers prior to jumping.

Carmina - Shifted in abruptly on jumping.

Gee Gees Luckygirl - Bumped on jumping. Laid in, in the home straight.

Track upgraded to GOOD 4 following the running of this race

RACE 4 – BROOKLYN PARK BENCHMARK 58HCP – 1200 METRES

Prior to correct weight rider Jason Maskiell (**Owens**) viewed the official patrol films in the home straight and after doing so J Maskiell was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Boart - Passing the 50m was disappointed for a run to the inside of **Owens** before shifting out to obtain clear running.

Osborne – After becoming fractious was removed from its barrier and underwent a veterinary examination which passed the gelding fit to take its place in the field. Passing the 100 metres mis-strode and became slightly unbalanced, laid in over the final 50m. Rider Brendon McCoull was advised that he must stop and straighten his mounts quicker than he did on this occasion.

Life's Quest - Commenced awkwardly. Raced wide throughout.

RACE 5 – MUD RESTAURANT CLASS 1 HCP – 1200 METRES

Airlie Magic - Change of tactics to be ridden further back with cover. Restrained at the start and raced towards the tail of the field with cover. Trainer Cameron Thompson was reminded of his obligations under AR135(A) in that he must notify any change of tactics no later than 30 minutes prior to the race.

Breathtaking - Laid out rounding the home turn.

George's Gambol - Over raced in the early and middle stages. Laid in, in the home straight. Rider H McCarthy was reminded of her obligations when using the whip in consecutive strides.

Miss Scandalous - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 6 – HESKETH MCCRIMMON INSURANCE BENCHMARK 62HCP – 2100 METRES

Biscay Barb - Shifted in on jumping away. Rider Brendon McCoull explained that on pulling up he felt that something was amiss with the gelding's action and as such dismounted. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off fore leg and a Veterinary clearance will be required prior to racing. Trainer J Blacker advised the gelding would now be spelled.

Wyuna - Checked when tightened for room on jumping away between **Biscay Barb** which shifted in and **Oilly's A Star**. Performed below market expectations. When questioned rider M Ulucinar explained the mare was not suited by the slow tempo of the race and was left flat footed when the pace quickened from the 600m.

White Hawk - Shifted out abruptly on jumping away. Raced keenly in the early stages.

GeeGees Lillybet - Late scratching at 11:48am due to no available rider.

Sudden Shock - Raced three wide without covering the early and middle stages. When questioned rider Teagan Voorham stated that with the slow tempo she may have been better suited to allow her mount to stride forward and sit outside the leader earlier than she did rather than racing three wide.

Mag Wheels - Trainer A Duggan was fined the sum of \$50 for the late removal of winkers from the mare.

Miss Artorius - Slow into stride. Shortly after the start was checked when **White Hawk** shifted out.

RACE 7 – BALMORAL ON YORK BENCHMARK 72 HCP – 1200 METRES

Love Magic - Slow into stride. Rider Craig Newitt stated the gelding failed to quicken at the 400m due to the heavy impost.
