Comments / Explanations

Jockey J Maskiell sustained a knee injury at the jump outs at Longford on Thursday 5 April 2018 and consequently was unable to fulfil his riding engagements today.

Trainer G McCulloch was fined the sum of \$50 under LR 13.3 for the late notification of rider for Sunset Party in Race 5.

Jockey M Ulucinar was fined the sum of \$50 under AR 175 (k) for negligence for accepting two rides in Race 5.

RACE 1 – MARJORIE FITZPATRICK CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Liffeybeau (T Baker) – Shifted inwards on jumping.

Jo Anconi (M Ulucinar) – Jockey M Ulucinar dropped his whip at the 300 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be shortin its action behind. Connections advised that consideration would now be given to retiring the mare.

Laddieandtherocket (C Graham) – Apprentice C Graham was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 137(a) for careless riding in that approaching the 800 metres he allowed his mount to shift inwards when not clear inconveniencing **Gee Gee Royal Miss** and **Osborne**.

Osborne (B McCoull) – Lay outwards shortly after the start. Inconvenienced passing the 800 metres.

Millmount (B Muhcu) – Tightened for room on jumping.

Scouting Around (C Newitt) – Restrained shortly after the start when **Liffeybeau** shifted out as **Osborne** lay inwards. Raced in restricted room approaching the 800 metres when **Liffeybeau** lay outwards. As a consequence the gelding was inconvenienced and restrained.

Gee Gee Royal Miss (A Darmanin) – Tightened for room and carried inwards passing the 800 metres.

RACE 2 – TASBRED BREEDING INCENTIVE SCHEME MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Archertein (H McCarthy) – Raced keenly in early and middle stages.

He's Rushin' (C Newitt) – Reared on jumping losing ground.

Hollywood Chief (Y Nishitani) – Restrained near the 1200 metres when **Zipponet** hung inwards.

Zipponet (B McCoull) – Hung in near the 1200 metres. Returned with superficial lacerations to both hind legs.

Perun (A Darmanin) – Raced wide throughout.

Westy (C Graham) – overraced in the early and middle stages.

Lucille (A Bryan) – Slow into stride.

RACE 3 – AUSTRALIAN TRAINERS ASSOCIATION MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

His Nibs (T Baker) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Lay inwards at the turn into the straight. When questioned Jockey T Baker explained that **His Nibs** had raced ungenerously throughout and had shifted ground both inwards and outwards.

Stinka (A Darmanin) – Raced wide throughout.

Kateland (D Schmitt) – Restrained at the 600 metres when **Gee Gees Luckygirl** shifted outwards.

Princess Of York (H McCarthy) – Steadied off the heels of **His Nibs** near the 1000 metres. Restrained approaching the 400 metres when **His Nibs** shifted ground inwards.

Gee Gees Luckygirl (C Newitt) – Shifted inwards making contact with the rail near the 600 metres and then shifted out.

RACE 4 – DELORAINE COMMUNITY CUP 13TH MAY BENCHMARK 64 – 1200 METRES

Cimarron's Hero (C Newitt) – After being placed in its barrier became extremely fractious, reared up throwing itself down. Following a veterinary examination the gelding was withdrawn at 2.10 pm. Trainer B Baker was advised that **Cimarron's Hero** would have to complete one satisfactory barrier trial before starting in a race again.

Genuine Art (M Ulucinar) – Despite repeated attempts the mare could not be placed in its barrier and was withdrawn by order of the Stewards at 2.09 pm. Trainer S Brunton was advised that **Genuine Art** would have to trial to the satisfaction of Stewards before starting in a race again.

Owens (A Darmanin) – Over raced in the middle stages and hung out at the 800 metre turn.

RACE 5 – THE AUSTRALIAN TRAINERS TRUST MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – 1600 METRES

Banca Boy (M Ulucinar) – Commenced awkwardly and lay outwards. Shortly after bumped heavily with **Country Way**. Lay inwards under pressure over the final 150 metres. Jockey M Ulucinar was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 137(a) for careless riding in that he failed to make sufficient effort to keep his mount straight.

Glory Blaze (S Carr) – Rolled outwards entering the turn into the straight.

One Way Ticket (A Darmanin) – Carried outwards at the turn into the straight.

Totally Wicked (B McCoull) – Raced wide throughout and lay outwards at the turn into the straight. Approaching the 100 metres momentarily steadied.

Rusty Devil (B Muhcu) – Steadied from the heels of **Another French** near the 1200 metres. Inconvenienced and held up approaching the 100 metres.

Boss Cat (G Catania) – Raced wide from the 600 metres.

Foreeva (T Baker) – Bumped and inconvenienced shortly after the start.

San You (C Newitt) – Reared as the start was effected losing ground.

Rodessa (D Schmitt) – Bumped and inconvenienced shortly after the start.

RACE 6 – ANZAC EVE RACES 24TH APRIL BENCHMARK 70 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

Welcome Invader (C Newitt) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Held up and unable to obtain a clear passage from the 150 metres.

Toorak Affair (H McCarthy) – Squeezed shortly after the start when **Red Spyder** shifted out as **Savrajette** moved in.

Leconte (T Voorham) – Underwent a veterinary examination on arriving at the barrier and was subsequently passed fit to take its place in the field. Resaddled behind the barriers. Raced wide throughout.

RACE 7 – FISH ‘N’ CHIPS @ SEAPORT CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Bless Me Father (I Toker) – Commenced awkwardly. Jockey I Toker when questioned regarding the disappointing performance of the gelding explained that he had been caught wide and had raced greenly but had failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the gelding returned with an elevated respiratory and heart rate and was slow to recover. Trainer W McShane expressed disappointment at the performance and advised that the gelding would now be sent for a spell.

Geegie Rock’n’run (G Catania) – On jumping struck the outside of its barrier and was inconvenienced.

Belrock Boy (T Voorham) – Held up at the turn into the straight.

Berbent (D Schmitt) – Raced wide throughout.

George’s Gambol (H McCarthy) – Commenced awkwardly and raced wide in the early and middle stages.

Asyoudo (A Bryan) – Slow to begin. Held up approaching the turn into the straight.

RACE 8 – KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

The Financier (S Barr) – Commenced awkwardly losing ground.

West On Broadway (B Muhcu) – Lay outwards approaching the 100 metres.

Lads Curfew (C Graham) – Commenced awkwardly slipping behind.

Mansplaining (M Ulucinar) – Commenced awkwardly.

Acronym (T Baker) – Stumbled badly at the start unbalancing its rider and thereafter raced wide. When questioned Jockey T Baker advised that the horse had failed to run on. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no anomalies with the mare.

General

Trainer S Brunton was fined \$200 under AR 175(k) for negligence in that he failed to present a veterinary certificate of soundness for **Negreanu**. As a consequence **Negreanu** was inspected and cleared by the Club's Veterinary Officer.

Trainer S Brunton was reprimanded for failing to withdraw **Solomon Song and Shot of Irish** from the TRC meeting of 25 March 2018 in the prescribed time however, this activated a suspended fine of \$200 imposed on Mr Brunton in August 2017 in relation to withdrawing runners in the prescribed time.

Devonport 20 March 2018

Stewards inquired into the incorrect horse being brought to Devonport racecourse to compete in Trial 3 on 20 March 2018. On inquiry it was established that **Sh'bourne Rebel** had been nominated and bought to Devonport racecourse to compete in Trial 3 however, following a routine Stewards identification of all runners, it was discovered that the incorrect horse (**Buttons Undone**) had inadvertently been bought to the racecourse. Trainer Mr S Nichols pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 59(1) in that he was responsible for the incorrect being presented as **Sh'bourne Rebel** for Trial 3 at Devonport on 20 March 2018. In arriving at a penalty, Stewards after considering the circumstances of the matter, accepted that it had been an honest mistake with no intent to breach the Rules. Mr S Nichols was fined the sum of \$200.
