### Comments / Explanations

*Rider Daniel Schmitt's explanation was accepted in relation to being dually engaged in Race 5 however was advised that further action may be taken in future.*

### RACE 1 – TASMANIAN AXEMAN'S ASSOCIATION MAIDEN (DIV 1) – 1220 METRES

**Oceania Hope** – late scratching at 4:40pm due to a float brake down.

**Tara's Design** – late scratching at 4:40pm due to a float brake down.

**Charaden** – over raced in the middle stages. Passing the 800 metres when over racing shifted out to avoid the heels of **Caesar's Quest**.

**Medard** – shifted out on jumping away, carrying **Caesar's Quest** out onto **Charaden**.

**Festive Day** – underwent a veterinary examination after the mare had not raced since February 2016 and passed suitable to race.

**Miss Eleanor** – stood flat footed at the start and lost considerable ground. Co-trainer Miss I Miller was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare's barrier manners.

**Mystic Molly** – checked off the heels of **Charaden** shortly after jumping when that gelding was carried outwards by **Caesar's Quest**. Over-raced during the middle stages.

### RACE 2 – OLYMPUS FEEDS MAIDEN (DIV 2) – 1220 METRES

**King of Saigon** – raced three wide without cover throughout

**Pincent Van Gogh** – after being slightly fractious in the barriers commenced awkwardly. Then shortly after was inconvenience and restrained when tightened for room between **Race The Wind** and **April Baby**.

**Trades Man's Way** – commenced awkwardly.

Following the running of this race Rider D Ganderton (**Pincent Van Gogh**) was examined by the on course medical staff after striking his left knee in the barriers and subsequently passed fit to fulfil his remaining riding engagements.

### **RACE 3 – LEST WE FORGET MAIDEN – 1620 METRES**

**Seize Them All** – late scratching at 12:48pm on veterinary advice, after the gelding had injured an off fore hoof. A veterinary certificate of fitness is required prior to racing again.

**He's Tough Enough** – near the 400 metres was inconvenience and tightened for room between **Kent Street** and **Kateland** which shifted out slightly.

**Kent Street** – over raced in the early stages. Bumped heavily on jumping away. Near the 400 metres was restrained when tightened for room between **He's Tough Enough** which was carried out by **Kateland** (D Schmitt) and **Perun NZ** (A Darmanin) which shifted in under pressure. D Schmitt was advised to exercise care when allowing his mounts to shift ground. A Darmanin was advised to exercise care when allowing his mounts to shift ground.

**Perun NZ** – raced three wide without cover throughout. Shifted in under pressure passing the 400 metres before being straightened.

**Pinkeyes Pride** – stood flat footed and as a result was slow into stride. Rider S Carr reported that the mare over raced in the early and middle stages.

**Another French** – shifted out on jumping away and made heavy contact with **Kent Street**.

### **RACE 4 – R F FERGUSSON BM64 HCP – 1620 METRES**

**Welcome Invader** – dipped on jumping.

**Datuk Zadragon** – over raced in the middle stages. Approaching the 100 metres momentarily restrained when carried inwards by **Flying Geepee** and as a result was disappointed for a run and had difficulty obtaining clear running behind **Flying Geepee** and **Welcome Invader**.

**Flying Geepee** – shifted in approaching the 100 metres. Apprentice C Graham was reprimanded for careless riding and notified to stop and straighten his mounts when in similar circumstances.

**Geeges Gran Lodge** – over raced during the early and middle stages and was inclined to lay out throughout the run.

**Real Messi** – commenced awkwardly.

**Strathalbyn** – raced keenly during the middle stages.

**Reann's Diamond** – raced wide from the 800 metres

**Vivre Star** – raced wide without cover throughout. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

### **RACE 5 – E (TED) COX MEMORIAL CLASS 3 HCP – 1600 METRES**

**Little Pumba** – bumped on jumping away. Near the 600 metres bumped heavily by **No Money No Honey** and became unbalanced. Rider A Darmanin explained that after receiving interference mid race the gelding then failed to respond to his riding.

**The Financier** – bounded in the air on jumping away and as a result was slow into stride. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Rider H McCarthy reported that the gelding failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure in the straight.

**No Money No Honey** – near the 600 metres bumped heavily with **Little Pumba**. Rider D Schmitt explained at this stage in the race the mare was inclined to lay in, and his saddle had shifted slightly to the near side which resulted in the horse shifting in further.

### **RACE 6 – GOVERNOR’S PLATE BM58 HCP – 1220 METRES**

**Speed Illusion** – momentarily tightened approaching the finish when weakening.

**Purple Rider** – commenced awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear running between the 150 metres and 100 metres and again approaching the finish.

**Bedrock Dreams** – commenced awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

### **RACE 7 – HENRY’S RESTAURANT CLASS 1 HCP – 1420 METRES**

The start of this race was delayed when **Outdone** was required to be re-plated.

**Valerius** – shifted inwards near the 50 metres. Apprentice Graham was advised to ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground.

**George’s Gambol** – commenced awkwardly. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**Outdone** – underwent a veterinary examination at the barrier after being re-plated and passed suitable to race. Slow into stride and shortly after jumping restrained off the heels of **Ramaadi Bullet**. Inclined to lay in, in the home straight. Near the 50 metres was momentarily tightened for room by **Valerius** (C Graham) which shift in slightly.

**Sh’bourne Star** – laid out throughout the run.

**Country Way NZ** – Trainer E Batt advised that the gelding would be ridden further back tonight from the wide draw. Commenced awkwardly and raced at the tail of the field. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. Rider S Barr explained that in her opinion the gelding was not suited to being restrained and failed to respond to her riding.

**The Austrian Oak NZ** – Inconvenienced on jumping away by **Balestrand NZ** which shifted in.

### **RACE 8 – UNIQUE DOORS & WINDOWS BM70 HCP – 2130 METRES**

**Red Spyder** – over raced in the early stages.

**Toorak Affair** – shifted out abruptly near the 1000 metres momentarily inconveniencing **Taramaya**. Apprentice C Graham explained that near the 1000 meters the pace of the race had slowed and his mount commenced to race keenly at which point he shifted out to avoid the heels of **Red Spyder** however the mare then shifted further than he anticipated. Apprentice Graham was advised he must show far greater care when shifting ground in similar circumstances.

**One Way Ticket NZ** – made heavy contact with **Taramaya** on jumping.

**Taramaya** – shifted out on jumping and made heavy contact with **On Way Ticket NZ**. Over raced in the middle stages. Near the 1000 metres restrained away from **Tookak Affair** (C Graham) which shifted out abruptly. Rider D Ganderton explained that due to the slow mid race tempo the mare pulled hard and he had difficulty getting it to settle.

**Matiano** – raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Western Front** – over raced in the middle stages and raced wide from the 1000 metres.

### **RACE 9 – CRESSY CRICKET CLUB BM70 HCP – 1220 METRES**

**Nielson** – over raced in the early and middle stages.

**Kool Kash** – momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

## **RACE 10 – LAUNCESTON MITSUBISHI BM80 HCP – 1420 METRES**

**Beaufort Lad** – tightened for room on jumping away between **Harvey Bay** and **Zatacla**.

**Harvey Bay** – over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**Liffeybeau** - over-raced in the early and middle stages.
