*\* Trainer John Blacker was fined \$50 under LR 13.3 for the late notification of a rider for Zatacla in Race 7*

### RACE 1 – RACEHORSE OWNERS ASSOCIATION TASMANIAN (ROAT) MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS - 1100 METRES

The start of this race was delayed slightly due to a number of horses being difficult to load.

**Hawthorn** (D Schmitt) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Silent Bid** (S Carr) – Commenced awkwardly contacting the outside of its barrier and as a result was slow into stride.

**Some Say That** (B McCoull) – Commenced awkwardly and lost ground.

**Angora Princess** (G Catania) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when leading.

**Miss Smith** (T Voorham (a)) – Carried wider on the track upon entering the home straight by **Angora Princess** (G Catania). G Catania was advised to exercise care when shifting ground in future.

### RACE 2 – goracingtasmania.com.au – 2YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS - 1400 METRES

**His Nibs** (D Ganderton) – Between the 300 metres and the 200 metres had difficulty obtaining clear running.

**Seize Them All** (I Toker) – The connections tendered a veterinary certificate declaring the gelding fit to take its place in the field.

**Trades Man's Way** (B Muhcu) – Trainer Stephen Lockhart advised that he will be instructing his jockey to attempt to ride the gelding more forward today if circumstances permit. Slow to begin and as a result raced at the tail of the field.

**Cunning Fox** (T Baker) – Laid in in the home straight.

**Stinka** (A Darmanin) – Over-raced in the early stages.

**The Auditor** (C Newitt) – Rider Craig Newitt explained that the gelding travelled well in the race and then quickened entering the straight. Rider Newitt further added that the gelding's action shortened over the final 100 metres and as he felt something may have been amiss, he elected not to ride the gelding out fully to the line. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**La Superba** (S Carr) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages before taking up a position outside the lead.

**Pinkeys Pride** (S Amano) – Slow into stride. Approaching the 600 metres, improved up onto the heels of **His Nibs** and had to be restrained.

### **RACE 3 – TASBRED BONUS SCHEME MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – SET WEIGHTS - 1600 METRES**

**Rusty Devil** (G Catania) – Performed below market expectations. Rider Georgie Catania explained that the gelding failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure in the home straight.

**Pelagia** (C Newitt) – Bumped and inconvenienced near the 1400 metres by **Frisco Dame** which shifted out abruptly.

**Zipponet** (B McCoull) – Near the 1400 metres, inconvenienced and had to be checked off the heels of **Pelagia** which was taken outwards by **Frisco Dame**. Rider McCoull reported that he felt there may have been something amiss with the gelding. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Foreeva** (T Baker) – Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages.

**Frisco Dame** (D Schmitt) – Slow into stride. Over-raced in the early stages. Passing the 1400 metres when over-racing, shifted out to avoid the heels of **Foreeva** and bumped with **Pelagia**. Rider Daniel Schmitt explained that after being slow away, the filly then commenced to pull hard and in his opinion he had no other option other than to shift out passing the 1400 metres to avoid the heels of **Foreeva**. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

### **RACE 4 – W L SHIELDS 2YO AUTUMN SPRINT – 2YO – SET WEIGHTS – NO CLAIMS - 1200 METRES**

**Tiesto** (B McCoull) – Slow into stride.

**Gee Gees Wild One** (A Darmanin) – Over-raced in the early stages. Inclined to lay in in the home straight.

**Gee Gee Born Free** (A Darmanin) – Commenced awkwardly before shifting out and brushing with **Gee Gees Wild One**.

**Our Long Sali** (C Newitt) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**Geegees First Lady** (T Voorham (a)) – Late scratching at 12 noon acting on veterinary advice after the filly slipped over in its race-day stall.

### **RACE 5 – EDYTH LANGHAM 3YO AUTUMN SPRINT – 3YO – SET WEIGHTS – NO CLAIMS - 1200 METRES**

**Mandela Effect** (I Toker) – Slow into stride.

**Shot of Irish** (C Newitt) – Commenced awkwardly and then shifted in shortly after jumping. Near the 200 metres, tightened for room by **Copperhead Road** (R Mangan) and had to be checked. A post-race veterinary inspection of **Shot of Irish** failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Copperhead Road** (R Mangan) – Jockey Rhonda Mangan was found guilty of a charge of careless riding under the provisions of AR 137(a) in that she permitted her mount to shift out near the 200 metres and made insufficient effort to straighten her mount and as a result tightened the running of **Shot of Irish** which had to be checked. The interference and carelessness were both deemed to be in the mid range. After taking into account her recent record, Rhonda Mangan's licence to ride in races was suspended for two (2) Tasmanian race meetings to commence at midnight tonight and to expire at midnight on 13 May 2018.

**Pateena Arena** (A Darmanin) – Disappointed for a run entering the home straight between **Copperhead Road** which had shifted out and **Shot of Irish** before switching back to the inside of **Copperhead Road**. Rider Anthony Darmanin stated that the filly failed to quicken in the home straight and its performance was disappointing.

**Banca Bet** (B Muhcu) - On jumping away, became unbalanced when tightened for room between **Shot of Irish** which shifted in and **Pateena Arena**. Approaching the 600 metres, restrained when tightened for room between **Pateena Arena** (A Darmanin) which laid in and **Mandela Effect**. Anthony Darmanin was advised to exercise care when allowing his mounts to shift ground. Held up for clear racing room rounding the home turn.

#### **RACE 6 – AUSTRALIAN TRAINERS ASSOCIATION AUTUMN QUALITY HANDICAP – NO CLAIMS - 1200 METRES**

**Blaze Forth** (B McCoull) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

**Step the Pedal** (B Muhcu) – Between the 200 metres and the 100 metres, was disappointed and held up for clear racing room between **Underplay** and **Happy Halloween**.

#### **RACE 7 – CORAL SEA OPEN HANDICAP – 1600 METRES**

**Beaufort Lad** (C Newitt) – Over-raced in the early stages. Laid in over the final 100 metres.

#### **RACE 8 – RENAULT HOBART BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES**

**Amaword** (C Graham) – Laid in in the home straight.

**D’Inzeo** (T Voorham (a)) – Raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

**Banca Boy** (B Muhcu) – Shifted out on jumping away. Passing the 100 metres, momentarily restrained when tightened for room by **Amaword** which was taken out slightly by **Turtles Nest** (T Baker) which was laying out. Troy Baker was advised that he must stop and straighten his mounts quicker than he did on this occasion.

**Turtles Nest** (T Baker) – Passing the 200 metres, laid out and brushed with **Amaword** which was laying in. Laid out over the final 100 metres.

**Ruthless Lover** (S Amano) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Passing the 600 metres, restrained when improving up on to the heels of **Life’s Quest**.

**Sir Marmaduke** (G Catania) – Got its head up when being restrained in the early stages. Rider Georgie Catania reported that the gelding over-raced in the early stages.

**Hushama** (C Newitt) – Inconvenienced on jumping away by **Banca Boy** which shifted out.

#### **RACE 9 – trchobart.com.au CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES**

The start of this race was delayed due to the late scratching of Gee Gee Cats

**Island Pirate** (C Newitt) – Commenced awkwardly.

**Gee Gees Cricket** (D Ganderton) – In the early part of the home straight, disappointed for a run to the outside of **Glory Blaze** which was taken out slightly by **Island Pirate**.

**Glory Blaze** (D Schmitt) – Rider Daniel Schmitt was reminded of his obligations when using his whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

**My Biddy** (B McCoull) – Raced wide in the back straight.

**Flikpix** (A Darmanin) – Near the 600 metres, commenced to lay out and race ungenerously and as a result had to be restrained of the heels of **Weight In Gold**. Rider Anthony Darmanin explained that the mare hung out rounding the 600 metre turn and then failed to respond to his riding over the final 200 metres.

**Gee Gee Cats** (T Baker) – Late scratching by order of Stewards at 4.48 pm after the gelding reared and dislodged its rider behind the barriers before galloping freely for some distance. Prior to the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered all monies invested on **Gee Gee Cats** to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 4.48 pm were to be paid less nine cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less ten cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket.

**Kepta** (T Voorham (a)) – Stood flat-footed and was slow to begin. Held up approaching the home turn.

**O'Loughlin** (B Muhcu) – Commenced awkwardly.

**Jane of Steel** (S Amano) – late scratching at 3.43 pm acting on veterinary advice.

#### **GENERAL:**

Stewards inquired into an incident which occurred in the mounting yard following the running of race 5. After taking evidence from Trainer Scott Brunton and Jockey Rhonda Mangan, Mr Brunton was reminded of his obligations to ensure he conducts himself in a professional manner at all times or further action may be taken.
