Comments / Explanations:

Kanichiro Fujii was unable to attend today's race meeting due to a flight cancellation

RACE 1 – J G PEST CONTROL MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to a number of runners being slightly difficult to load.

Lesnar (D Ganderton) – Slightly fractious in the barriers prior to the start, commenced awkwardly and then restrained off the heels of Stinka. Momentarily tightened near the 800m. Held up for clear racing room rounding the home turn and in the early part of the home straight before shifting wider and obtaining clear running passing the 150m.

Nordic Raider (I Toker) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Stinka (A Darmanin) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Momentarily tightened near the 800m. Near the 100m carried wider on the track by Oceania Hope which was carried outwards.

Swinley Forest (D Thornton) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages before being allowed to stride forward and race outside the leader from the 800m.

Oceania Hope (C Graham) – Approaching the 800m steadied when momentarily tightened for room by Angora Princess (D Schmitt) which shifted in and as a result shifted out abruptly before shifting back in slightly and tightening Stinka in on to Lesnar. D Schmidt was advised to exercise care when allowing his mounts to shift ground. Passing the 100m carried slightly wider by Lesnar which shifted out to obtain clear running. Rider C Graham stated that the filly raced keenly in the early stages and when attempting to allow Angora Princess to cross near the 800m, he had difficulty restraining the filly.

Tara's Design (S Carr) – Rider Sigrid Carr stated the filly hung out for the majority of the race.

RACE 2 – DELORAINE HOTAL MDN/CL1 – 1600 METRES

Prior to correct weight Daniel Schmitt, rider of Kateland (4th place getter), lodged an objection against Monmouth (B Muhcu) (2nd place getter) alleging interference near the 200m and again near the 100m. As stewards were not satisfied that any interference suffered near the 200m outweighed the final margin and that near the 100m Westy was a contributing factor by carrying Kateland inwards the objection was dismissed.

Banca Boy (I Toker) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages. Raced wide without cover from the 600m. Performed below market expectations. Rider I Toker explained that he felt that something may have been amiss with the gelding behind. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any

abnormalities. Trainer Scott Brunton advised that connections would now assess the geldings racing future.

Glory Blaze (T Baker) – Shifted out rounding the home turn and made contact with Westy. Rider T Baker was advised to exercise care when permitting his mounts to shift ground.

The Grey Crusader (S Amano) – Held up rounding the home turn. On the latter part of the home turn restrained when tightened for room by Kateland (D Schmitt) which shifted in after being held up behind Glory Blaze which shifted out. Daniel Schmitt was reprimanded pursuant to AR137(a) for careless riding.

Aljazmic (D Ganderton) – Laid out for the majority of the race. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the home straight. Rider D Ganderton explained that he had difficulty riding the mare out due to its inclination to lay out.

His Nibs (S Carr) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

Miss Artorius (H McCarthy) – Near the 1000m momentarily steadied when tightened for room. Passing the 100m, restrained when tightened for room by Westy which shifted in.

Osos Amigos (C Newitt) – Rider Craig Newitt reported that he felt something amiss with the mare on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near fore leg and a veterinary certificate of soundness must be produced prior to racing again.

Westy (C Graham) – Bumped by Glory Blaze rounding the home turn Hung in, in the home straight. Rider C Graham reported that the gelding raced greenly and laid in.

Zipponet (B McCoull) – Rider B McCoull stated that the gelding failed to run on in the home straight and may have come to the end of its preparation. Trainer Tammy Mollross advised that the gelding will now be spelled.

Kateland (D Schmitt) – After being held up behind Westy and Glory Blaze which shifted out rounding the home turn, shifted in to avoid the heels of Glory Blaze. Near the 200m held up and disappointed for clear run to the inside of Monmouth before shifting wider. Near the 100m bumped and carried in by Westy which was laying in.

Chris Graham pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(a) for careless riding in that near the 100m he permitted his mount to shift in when riding out, tightening the running of Miss Artorius in onto The Grey Crusader and as a result Miss Artorius had to be restrained. Chris Graham's licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting commencing midnight 20th May 2018, expiring midnight 27th May 2018. In determining penalty Stewards took into account C Graham's guilty plea the racing manners of Westy and his record.

RACE 3 – MEANDER CALLEY COUNCIL TASMANIAN PRODUCE – 1400 METRES

Gee Gees Wild One (S Carr) – Over raced in the early stages.

Caesar's Quest (A Darmanin) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Bonduel Lily (T Baker) – Commenced awkwardly unbalancing its rider.

RACE 4 – AUSTRALIAN TRAINERS ASSOCIATION CLASS 2 HCP – 1400METRES

Braccenby (A Patis) – Rider A Patis reported that the gelding laid out throughout the race.

Sh'bourne Star (S Carr) – Rider S Carr reported the mare laid out throughout the race.

Outdone (D Ganderton) – Rider D Ganderton reported the gelding did not appreciate being challenged for the lead in the early and middle stages which may have affected its overall performance.

Pelagia (C Newitt) – Slow into stride. Held up rounding the home turn.

Hirvonen (S Amano) – Bumped on jumping away by Give Us A Winner which shifted out.

Silver Reset (B Smith) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Give Us A Winner (T Voorham) – Shifted out on jumping away and bumped

Life's Quest (A Darmanin) – Held up rounding the home turn.

Following the running of this race the track was upgraded to a soft 5.

RACE 5 – BLAIR & SONS SAWMILL 3YO CLASSIC – 1400 METRES

Pateena Arena (B McCoull) – Restrained shortly after jumping when tightened between Mandela Effect and April Baby.

Windrider (D Schmitt) – Pulled hard in the early and middle stages.

Gone Girl (C Newitt) – Slow into stride. Had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn.

Foreeva (S Amano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 6 – FIRST NATIONAL REAL ESTATE OPEN CLASSIC – 1400 METRES

Blaze Forth (B McCoull) – Rider B McCoull stated that the gelding raced keenly during the early and middle stages. Near the 700m when over racing shifted out to avoid the heels of Minute Repeater carrying Agree To wider on the track.

Zatacla (H McCarthy) – Commenced awkwardly and was slow into stride.

Agree To (S Carr) – Carried wider near the 700m.

Step The Pedal (B Muhcu) – Unable to obtain clear running between the 400m and 200m.

Stella Etoile (A Darmanin) – Commenced awkwardly and was slow into stride.

RACE 7 – DELORAINÉ COMMUNITY CUP BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 2100METRES

One Way Ticket NZ (A Darmanin) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Taramaya (S Carr) – Rider S Carr pleaded guilty to a charge pursuant to AR137A(5)(a)(i) in that she used her whip on three occasions in consecutive strides. S Carr was subsequently fined the sum of \$200. Miss Carr pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on 13 occasions prior to the 100m which is 8 more than permitted under this rule. Miss Carr's licence to ride in races was suspended for 2 Tasmanian race meetings commencing midnight 20th May 2018, expiring midnight 3rd June 2018. In determining penalty Stewards took into consideration Miss Carr's record, her guilty plea and that this was a staying race.

Olly's A Star (S Amano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Reann's Diamond (H McCarthy) – Slow into stride. Held up rounding the home turn.

RACE 8 – DELORAINÉ NEWSAGENCY BENCHMARK 76 HCP – 1100 METRES

Steel Moon (C Graham) – Rider C Graham reported the gelding was inclined to lay out in the home straight.

Apriano (T Voorham) – Slipped behind on jumping away.

Derasa (C Newitt) – Held up for clear racing room between the 400m until obtaining clear running near the 150m.

Super Fun (A Darmanin) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Trusted Warrior (D Thornton) – Commenced awkwardly.
