Comments / Explanations:

A number of riders were subject to urine testing at today's meeting.

RACE 1 – TALES OF THE TURF MAIDEN– 1000 METRES

Gee Gees Saint Nik (B Muhcu) - Near the 800m momentarily steadied away from Flourishing Future which shifted out marginally. Rider B Muhcu explained that the gelding failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure in the home straight and in his opinion would benefit from the run as the gelding was first up from a spell. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Miss La Di Da (C Graham) - Made the turn at the 600m awkwardly.

Movido (B Smith) - Raced wide rounding the home turn.

Diesel Dan (T Baker) - Slow into stride and then shortly after restrained off the heels of Miss Smith. Raced wide without cover throughout. Raced greenly in the home straight. Rider T Baker explained that it was his intention to ride the gelding further forward today, however after being slowly away he was then caught wide for the majority of the run.

RACE 2 – RJ PRINT AND SIGNS MAIDEN – 1350 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when rider Troy Baker (Aquietword), (third place getter) wished to view the official patrol films over the concluding stages. After doing so he was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Aquietword (T Baker) - Near the 50m when attempting a tight run to the inside of Fontein Harry brushed with Race The Wind.

Barusti (H McCarthy) - Slow into stride.

Chikoy (S Amano) - Laid in in the home straight.

Race The Wind (A Darmanin) - Rounding the home turn steadied and momentarily held up for clear racing room when Aquietword shifted in slightly when racing tightly to the inside of Barusti.

Royal Strategy (B Muhcu) - Performed below market expectations. Rider B Muhcu stated that the gelding raced greenly and advised trainer Mr N Schuurin that it may benefit from the addition of blinkers.

In Bloom (B Smith) - Raced wide from the 600m.

Mystic Molly (T Voorham) - Near the 400m was momentarily held up and steadied when tightened for room to the inside of Race The Wind which shifted in slightly when placed awkwardly near the heels of Aquietword.

White Gazelle (C Graham) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 3 – BARRY DIPROSE TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 64HCP – 1880 METRES

Prior to correct weight Anthony Darmanin (Perun), third place getter viewed the official patrol films of the home straight. After doing so lodged an objection against Scouting Around (C Newitt) being declared second place getter alleging interference near the 100m. As Stewards were not satisfied that Perun had established a clear run to the inside of Scouting Around prior to that gelding shifting inwards which resulted in Perun being held up and having to shift wider on the track to obtain clear running the protest was dismissed.

Westwood (D Ganderton) - Rider D Ganderton explained that he got slightly further back in the run than anticipated and when the pace quickened from the 600m the gelding was left flat footed. D Ganderton further added that he was satisfied in the manner in which the gelding finished off the race.

Robbo The Bold (T Baker) - Rider T Baker stated that the gelding failed to run out today's 1880m distance.

Glory Blaze (C Graham) - Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

Perun (A Darmanin) - Approaching the 100m was held up and disappointed for a run to the inside of Scouting Around before switching to the outside of that gelding heels.

Real Messi (B Muhcu) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Western Front (B Smith) - Raced three wide without cover from the 900m.

RACE 4 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN FUNCTIONS MDN/CL1 – 1650 METRES

Purple Rider (H McCarthy) - Commenced awkwardly and was slow into stride.

Silver Reset (M Ulucinar) - Rider M Ulucinar explained that the gelding pulled hard during the event and failed to finish off. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer Wayne Curran advised that the gelding failed to handle today's synthetic track and will now be sent for a spell.

Westy (C Graham) - Hung in in the home straight and proved difficult to ride. Rider C Graham was advised that he must straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion

Foreeva (T Baker) - Raced three wide without cover from the 900m.

He's Tough Enough (C Newitt) - Fractious and reared in the barriers prior to the start. A warning has been placed on the geldings barrier manners. Commenced awkwardly

RACE 5 – GOODSTONE HOTEL GROUP BENCHMARK 76 HCP – 1650 METRES

Underplay (C Graham) - Momentarily steadied away from Secrets She Has entering the home straight when that mare laid out.

Secrets She Has (T Voorham) - Laid out in the home straight and shifted wider on the track. Rider T Voorham was advised that she must make straighten her mounts quicker than she did on this occasion. Rider T Voorham reported that the mare laid out throughout the run.

Don Reggio (B Muhcu) - Near the 150m was momentarily held up between Gone Girl and Underplay which was carried out slightly by Secrets She Has.

Gone Girl (C Newitt) - Over raced in the early and middle stages. Rider C Newitt stated that the filly may have come to the end of its preparation.

Big Pegg (H McCarthy) - Raced three wide without cover from the 900m.

RACE 6 – SKY RACING CLASS 1 HCP – 1350 METRES

Nordic Thunder (A Darmanin) - Rider A Darmanin reported that the gelding travelled well, however failed to respond to his riding from the 200m and on pulling up felt something may have been a miss with its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Belrock Boy (B McCoull) - Approaching the 600m momentarily steadied when tightened for room to the inside of Negreanu (A Patis). A Patis was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Akbar Jay (T Voorham) - Approaching the 200m momentarily held up for clear racing room between French Dandy and Ramaadi Bullet.

French Dandy (H McCarthy) - Slow into stride. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Mosh Opera (C Graham) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Woohoo (S Amano) - Laid out for the majority of the race. On pulling up rider S Amano was harmlessly dislodged.

RACE 7 – GREAT NORTHERN BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 1350 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to Sh'Bourne Star having to be backed out of the barriers and resaddled.

Prior to correct weight Connections of Tambro's Game and Khatun which dead heated for first viewed the official photo. After doing so connections were satisfied and as stewards were satisfied with the judge's decision correct weight was declared.

Khatun (C Graham) - Laid in in the home straight.

Paterangi (A Patis) - Approaching the 1200m restrained when momentarily tightened between Bedrock Dreams and Flying Geepee. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Miss Bluegrass (H McCarthy) - Slow in to stride. Steadied near the 600m when racing in restricted room.

Life's Quest (B Smith) - Laid in in the home straight.

RACE 8 – HAPPY BIRTHDAY TATE HUDSON BENCHMARK 76 HCP– 1150 METRES

Prior to correct weight trainer R Hamer of third place getter Date Night viewed the official photo and after doing so was satisfied and as stewards were satisfied also, correct weight was declared.

Happy Halloween (A Patis) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Lord Farquaad (D Ganderton) - Slow into stride. Performed below expectations. Rider D Ganderton explained that the gelding made an unusual respiratory noise during the running of this race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be making a respiratory noise and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.

Date Night (A Darmanin) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Farnor West (T Voorham) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 9 – SIMONS DESIGN CENTRE BENCHMARK 64 HCP– 1150 METRES

Mr America (T Voorham) - Over raced in the early and middle stages. Laid in passing the 200m.

Tycoon's Daughter (B McCoull) - On jumping away was inconvenienced when tightened for room between Gasnier and Enzian which shifted out. Performed below expectations. Rider B McCoull stated that after receiving interference shortly after the start the filly failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure from the 400m and he felt that there may have been something amiss with its action. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Enzian (C Newitt) - Passing the 100m had difficulty obtaining clear running before shifting wider on the track.

Lads Curfew (S Amano) - Commenced awkwardly making heavy contact with the side of the barriers unbalancing its rider and losing significant ground and tailed the field throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Subsequent to this race rider S Amano was examined by the on course medical staff which revealed some bruising to his hip, however S Amano was not stood down from riding.

GENERAL

Foreman Mr Nicholas Hay was reprimanded for allowing a person to undertake stable-hand duties when not licensed to do so on 7/5/18 after he had been placed in charge of Mr Ian Hay's stable's.
