Comments / Explanation

**Jockey Daniel Ganderton was advised that he must submit a medical clearance prior to riding again after being unable to fulfil his engagements today due to illness.*

A number of riders were subject to urine testing at today's race meeting.

RACE 1 – SCHWEPPE'S BENCHMARK 84 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

Up Cups (A Patis (a)) – Near the 1100 metres, restrained when momentarily tightened for room by **Step the Pedal** (Ismail Toker). Ismail Toker was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Step The Pedal (I Toker) – Approaching the 1100 metres taken outward by Beaufort Lad (C Newitt). C Newitt was advised to ensure his fully clear when shifting ground. Rider Ismail Toker was reprimanded under AR 137(b) for failing to ride his mount out to the finish.

RACE 2 – GREAT NORTHERN SUPER CRISP – 2YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN - 1400 METRES

Nordic Raider (M Ulucinar) – Steadied off heels shortly after the start.

Riptorn (NZ) (S Amano) – Shifted in shortly after the start bumping with **Nordic Raider**.

Angora Princess (B Muhcu) – Near the 1100 metres commenced to over-race, throwing its head and having to be restrained.

Pinkeyes Pride (S Carr) – Trainer John Luttrell advised that the mare would be ridden further forward today if circumstances permit. On request by its rider underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection at the barriers and was passed fit to take its place in the field. Slow into stride and then ridden forward to take up a handy position.

RACE 3 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS – 2YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Cascade City (S Carr) – Rider Sigrid Carr stated that the filly raced ungenerously throughout. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Epidexios (M Ulucinar) – Underwent a veterinary inspection and passed suitable to race as the gelding had not raced for more than 12 months.

Horino (A Darmanin) – Underwent a veterinary inspection behind the barriers after being kicked by another runner and was subsequently passed suitable to race.

Kunanyi (R Mangan) – Trainer Rhonda Mangan was fined \$50 under AR 140A(1) for presenting the gelding in the mounting yard with blinkers which were not part of its gear.

Silent Savings (B Muhcu) – Had to be re-saddled behind the barriers.

Gee Gees Liberty (C Newitt) – Cast a near hind plate en-route to the barrier. As the filly was unable to be re-plated, which delayed the start, permission was granted to race without the near hind plate. Rider Craig Newitt stated that the filly failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure upon entering the home straight. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Gee Gee Runaway (T Baker) – Broke free from its attendant at the barrier and galloped a short distance before being re-captured. The gelding underwent a veterinary inspection and was subsequently passed fit to race, which delayed the start.

RACE 4 – trchobart.com.au BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP – 2100 METRES

Matiano (C Graham (a)) – Laid in under pressure over the concluding stages.

Geegees Lillybet (C Newitt) – Slow into stride (2L).

The Grey Crusader (S Amano) - When questioned in relation to his tactics over the final 100 metres, Rider Shuji Amano explained that passing the 150 metres he was unable to obtain clear running to the outside of **Matiano** and elected to switch back to the inside of **Taramaya**. He then attempted a run between that gelding and **Geegees Lillybet** when a run then opened to the outside of **Matiano** which had commenced to lay in. S Amano added that when attempting the run to the inside of **Taramaya** he was of the opinion that this was not going to eventuate and elected to switch back to the outside however at the same time a gap did present between **Taramaya** and **Geegees Lillybet**.

Country Way (NZ) (B Smith (a)) – Near the 400 metres, tightened for room between **Another Brother** and **The Grey Crusader** which shifted out.

Sir Marmaduke (G Catania) – Fractious in the barriers. Tightened on jumping away and restrained. Rider Georgie Catania explained that the gelding laid in for the majority of the race and in her opinion there may have been something amiss with its action. Subsequent to the race meeting trainer A Duggan advised that the gelding had pulled up satisfactory and would continue on with its preparation.

Slalom (A Patis (a)) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 5 – CROWN LAGER BENCHMARK 84 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Love Magic (A Darmanin) – Passing the 100 metres, carried inwards by **Scrutineer** which was laying inwards.

Scrutineer (C Graham (a)) – Passing the 100 metres, laid in under pressure and had to be straightened by its rider.

RACE 6 – HOBART LIMO SERVICE 2YO HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Gee Gee Fiorente (S Carr) – Laid in in the home straight and shifted in under pressure near the 150 metres.

Hatrick Hero (M Ulucinar) – Difficult to load delaying the start. A warning has been placed on the colt. Momentarily held up rounding the home turn. Near the 200 metres shifted in under pressure.

RACE 7 – ROSEVEARS HOTEL BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP – DIVISION 1 – 1100 METRES

By the Pound (A Patis (a)) – Commenced awkwardly, throwing its head in the air and lost ground.

West on Broadway (C Graham (a)) – Commenced awkwardly.

Boart (S Amano) – Momentarily held up passing the 200 metres.

Qui Samer (B Muhcu) – Held up rounding the home turn and in the early part of the home straight.

Arving (H McCarthy) – Raced wide without cover from the 600 metres.

Kepta (R Mangan) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running between the 300 metres and the 100 metres.

RACE 8 – tasracing.com.au BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP – DIVISION 2 – 1100 METRES

Copperhead Road (C Newitt) – Difficult to load. Connections were advised that the gelding must trial to Stewards' satisfaction before racing again.

Radioactive (G Catania) – Slow into stride. Checked shortly after the start when **O'Loughlin** shifted ground outwards.

Top Draw (H McCarthy) – Became fractious in the barriers and reared up on a number of occasions. Withdrawn from the barrier and underwent a veterinary inspection and passed suitable to race which delayed the start. Connections were advised that the mare must trial to Stewards' satisfaction before racing again. Near the 400 metres, was checked to avoid the heels of **Lady Wynette**.

Isere (T Baker) – Made the home turn awkward shifting in slightly and made contact with **Lady Wynette**.

Lady Wynette (S Amano) – Near the 400 metres brushed the running rail becoming unbalanced shifted out contacting **Isere** and restrained

RACE 9 – CARLTON DRAUGHT BENCHMARK 70 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Mandela Effect (I Toker) – Held up rounding the home turn.

Cranbrook (C Newitt) – Rider Craig Newitt reported that in his opinion the gelding had come to the end of its preparation. Trainer Barry Campbell confirmed that the gelding will be spelled.

Trusted Warrior (B McCoull) – Slow to muster early speed.

Little Pumba (S Barr) – Slow into stride. Shortly after the start steadied off the heels of **Mandela Effect** which had shifted in.
