Comments / Explanations:

A number of riders were subject to urine testing today.

RACE 1 – SIMONS DESIGN CENTRE MAIDEN– 1150 METRES

Harriman (C Graham) – Proved difficult to load. Connections were advised that a warning was issued. Bounded on jumping away.

Push Pause (H McCarthy) – Near the 300 metres restrained off the heels of Caesar's Quest (A Darmanin), which attempted a run to the inside of Leicester Rocket where there was barely sufficient room. This incident was aggravated when Caesar's Quest was taken inwards by Leicester Rocket (D Ganderton) which layed inwards despite the efforts of its rider. Anthony Darmanin was reprimanded under AR 137(a) careless riding.

Shivida (B Muhcu) – Tightened on jumping when Tara's Design shifted ground outwards. Held up for clear racing room passing the 200 metres.

Jayemara (I Toker) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Leicester Rocket (D Ganderton) – Layed in passing the 300 metres and had to be straightened by its rider. Rider Daniel Ganderton reported that the filly travelled well early however from the 600 metres failed to respond to his riding and raced greenly in the home straight. He further added that the filly may benefit from the addition of a tongue tie. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Mississippi Grind (B McCoull) – Shortly after the start restrained when tightened for room between Bigable and Leicester Rocket, which shifted out. Held up for clear racing room passing the 200 metres.

Tara's Design (S Carr) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Caesar's Quest (A Darmanin) – Near the 200 metres restrained when held up and tightened for room by Leicester Rocket which layed in.

Bigable (S Amano) – Rider Shuji Amano reported that the filly layed out throughout.

Oh So Needy (S Barr) – After being loaded into the barriers, reared and was slightly fractious. Slow to begin (2L).

Miss La Di Da (A Patis) – Approaching the 800 metres restrained when momentarily tightened for room by Nova Vista (T Voorham) which shifted in. Teagan Voorham was advised to exercise care when allowing her mounts to shift ground. Held up for clear racing room passing the 200 metres.

RACE 2 – TASRACING.COM.AU BENCHMARK 76 HANDICAP – 1350 METRES

Willby Rules – Late scratching at 8:58am on veterinary advice due to colic. A veterinary clearance will be required prior to racing again.

Spihro (C Graham) – Passing the 400 metres shifted out to obtain clear running and made contact with Khatun. Layed in under pressure passing the 150 metres.

Mr America (I Toker) – Raced three wide in the early stages.

Khatun (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride (1L). Bumped near the 400 metres.

RACE 3 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN FUNCTION ROOM CLASS 4 HANDICAP – 1000 METRES

Jacques (B McCoull) – Rider B McCoull reported that he felt there may have been something amiss with the gelding over the final 200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Westerly Haze (B Muhcu) – Slow to begin and then steadied off the heels of Secretan. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Carried wider on the track approaching the 50 metres when Rougeau shifted ground outwards. Attempted to jump a shadow on the track near the 50 metres unbalancing the rider.

RACE 4 – WEEDING'S HIRE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1150 METRES

Cuban Missile (S Carr) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed small skin tag cuts on the near hind fetlock and a small heel/hoof tag.

Christopher Mac (I Toker) – Stood flat-footed and missed the start by approximately 5L. Trainer G White was advised the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

Into The Night (D Ganderton) – Rider Daniel Ganderton was reminded of his obligations to ride his mount out fully to the finishing line.

Enzian (C Newitt) – Raced greenly in the home straight.

Vengeance Of Fury (H McCarthy) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Farnor West (T Voorham) – Fractious in the barriers, a warning was issued. Commenced awkwardly throwing its head and lost ground.

Gee Gee Royal Miss (B Muhcu) – Prior to the start reared slightly and got its head into the adjacent stall. A warning will continue on the mare's barrier manners. Held up for clear racing room between the 300 and 200 metres.

Platinum Magic (S Amano) – Near the 800 metres restrained when tightened for room by Millmount (C Graham) which shifted in when not fully clear. Chris Graham was reprimanded under AR 137(a) careless riding.

RACE 5 – GRENVILLE STUD OPEN DAY CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1350 METRES

Fontein Harry (C Newitt) – Performed below expectations. Rider Craig Newitt explained that the gelding travelled well however was one paced and was disappointing. Subsequent to the race meeting trainer J Blacker advised that the gelding had pulled up well however it will now go for a spell.

Island Pirate (T Baker) – Raced three wide throughout. Layed in over the final 100 metres.

Purple Rider (H McCarthy) – Slow to begin (2L).

Knitting (S Carr) – When questioned rider Sigrid Carr stated that the mare pulled hard when leading which may have affected the overall performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Mosh Opera (A Darmanin) – Slow to begin (2L).

Akbar Jay (T Voorham) – Slow to begin (2L).

RACE 6 – GOODSTONE GROUP BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1650 METRES

One WayTicket (C Graham) – Fractious in the barriers prior to the start. Layed in in the home straight.

Windrider (S Carr) – Proved difficult to load, a warning was issued. Reared on jumping and was slow to begin (1L).

Scouting Around (C Newitt) – Fractious in the barriers prior to the start. Near the 200 meters brushed with Greenmount Lass.

Greenmount Lass (B Smith) – Slow into stride (1L). Layed in near the 200 metres and brushed with Scouting Around.

Miss Bluegrass (I Toker) – Rider I Toker reported that the mare layed out rounding the home turn and failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 7 – CARLTON DRAUGHT MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – 1880 METRES

He's Tough Enough (C Newitt) – Crowded shortly after the start and shifted outwards. Layed in approaching the winning post and had to be straightened by its rider. Rider C Newitt explained that the gelding layed in in the home straight and over the concluding stages he had to straighten his mount as he was receiving calls from B Muhcu (Westy) which was racing to his inside and did not want to cause interference to that gelding which led to him not being able to ride the gelding out in his normal manner.

The Grey Crusader (S Amano) – Slow to begin (2L). Had difficulty obtaining a clear run entering the home straight.

Westy (B Muhcu) – Reared in the barriers prior to the start, a warning was issued. Bumped shortly after the start. Approaching the finish, restrained when tightened between Kingsclere and He's Tough Enough which layed in despite the efforts of its rider.

Hell Baby (S Carr) – Commenced awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of Westy and lost ground.

Nordic Raider (M Ulucinar) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Rider Mehmet Ulucinar stated that the gelding pulled hard during the run and failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure from the 500 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Woohoo (S Barr) – After being loaded in the barriers, became fractious and reared causing the saddle to slip sideways. The mare had to be removed from the barrier and re-saddled. Hung out throughout and proved very difficult to ride. Tired from the 500 metres. Connections were advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again. Trainer M Doherty was advised that the mare will now be retired.
