Comments / Explanations:

Due to G Cantania becoming indisposed and no available senior rider, stewards permitted apprentice A Patis to replace G Catania on Nordic Raider.

G Catania was advised she must submit a medical clearance prior to riding again.

RACE 1 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS BENCHMARK 76 HCP – 1400 METRES

Minute Repeater (A Patis) – dipped in the going passing the 400 metres.

Stella Etoile (C Graham) – commenced awkwardly.

Savs Finale (A Darmanin) – laid-in, in the home straight. Rider A Darmanin explained that the gelding travelled well in the early stages however raced flat in the home straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Don Reggio (T Baker) – near the 300 metres was momentarily restrained when shifting out as Stella Etoile (C Graham) shifted in slightly. C Graham was advised to exercise care when allowing his mounts to shift ground.

RACE 2 – GREAT NORTHERN SUPER CRISP BENCHMARK 70 HCP – 1100 METRES

Shot Of Irish (S Carr) – near the 900 metres, momentarily steadied when **Son Of A Fling** (G Catania) shifted in slightly. Laid-in, in the home straight.

Super Fun (A Darmanin) – underwent a veterinary examination behind the barriers, and was passed suitable to take its place in the field. In the early part of the home straight had to be restrained when tightened for room by **Angel Of The Abyss** which was taken outward by **Shot Of Irish** (S Carr) which shifted out to obtain clear running. S Carr was severely reprimanded under the provisions of AR137(a) for careless riding and notified she must be fully clear when shifting ground.

Nunivak (D Ganderton) – change of tactics, Trainer D Brunton advised would attempt to be ridden further back if circumstances permit, from the inside draw. Laid out between the 600 metres and 400 metres. Performance queried, rider D Ganderton explained that he had been instructed to ride the

gelding further back today from the inside draw. He added that it raced keenly in the early stages and was inclined to lay out. Mr Ganderton further added that approaching the home turn when held up for clear running he elected to switch back to the inside as he felt there would be no run available to the outside fence, however after straightening the gelding then failed to respond to his riding and didn't finish off the race as expected. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Trainer D Brunton could offer no explanation for today's disappointing performance other than recent interstate travel may have had some affect. Mr Brunton stated that the gelding had performed well in a jump-out when ridden in a similar fashion and with the addition of today's inside barrier, connections were of the view to ride the gelding further back. Mr Brunton added that he was disappointed with today's run and it would not be his intention to have the gelding ridden in this manner in future. Mr Brunton further added that the gelding has had a number of injury issues throughout its career and would contact stewards should anything arise from today's run that may have affected its performance.

Gee Gees Style (T Baker) – rider T Baker reported that on pulling up he felt that something may have been amiss with the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 3 – SALAMANCA INN MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

The Last Godfather (B McCoull) – slow into stride.

On Sunshine (A Patis) – Commenced awkwardly and lost ground. Rider A Patis advised that she felt something may be amiss with the mare. A Post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Green Arrow (H McCarthy) – Slow into stride. Rider H McCarthy reported that during the run her riding breeches had come undone which resulted in her having to take her hand off the rein on several occasions, and was unable to ride her mount out in her normal manner.

Following the running of this race G Catania was examined by the on course medical officers and deemed unfit to fulfil her riding engagements.

RACE 4 – TRCHOBARTCOM.AU MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when rider C Graham rider of 2nd placegetter **Gee Gee Caughtya** wished to view the official photo. After doing so C Graham was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Brundah Bob (S Amano) – slow into stride, shortly after was inconvenienced when **Gee Gee Caughtya** shifted out. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

His Nibs (H McCarthy) – passing the 1000 metres raced un-generously and threw its head in the air.

Gee Gee Caughtya (C Graham) – pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on 12 occasions prior to the 100 metres, which is 7 more than permitted under this rule. C Graham had is licence to ride in races suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight on the Sunday 15th July 2018 and to expire at midnight Sunday 22nd July 2019. In determining penalty stewards took into account C Graham's record and the totality of his whip use.

RACE 5 – HOBART CUP DAY FEB 10 CLASS1 HCP – 1400 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when D Parish rider of 4th place getter **Kandahar** wished to view the official photo. After doing so was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Shenanigator (I Toker) – held up for clear racing room between the 500 metres and 400 metres.

Kandahar (D Parish) – rider D Parish reported the gelding laid in throughout the run.

Purple Rider (H McCarthy) – near the 900 metres momentarily restrained when tightened for room by **Odessa Lad** which shifted out slightly. Rider H McCarthy pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using her whip on 9 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 4 more than

permitted under this rule. H McCarthy was subsequently fined the sum of \$200. In determining penalty stewards took into consideration Miss McCarthy's record in relation to this rule.

Angora Princess (D Schmitt) – held up for clear racing room rounding the home turn. Rider D Schmitt reported that the mare made an unusual respiratory noise in running. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Jack's Choice (T Voorham) – laid in, in the home straight.

Kalakhani (A Darmanin) – Laid in, approaching the 600 metres. Shortly after restrained when tightened for room between **Foreeva** and **Angora Princess**.

RACE 6 – AWM ELECTRICAL BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 1400 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when stewards wished to view the start of this race and in particular **West On Broadway** and **Hirvonen** after they were extremely slow to begin. After taking evidence from Jockeys A Patis (**West On Broadway**) and B Smith (**Hirvonen**), starter D Evans and barrier attendant J Hall, stewards were satisfied that no horse had been denied a fair start and correct weight was declared.

Trusted Warrior (B McCoull) – laid in, in the home straight. Near the 200 metres laid in and clipped the heels of **Balestrand NZ** which had shifted out marginally, **Trusted Warrior** then commenced to lay in for the remainder of the home straight.

West On Broadway (A Patis) – Lent on the side of the barrier as the start was effected, A Patis then lost contact with the near side rein and had difficulty in getting her mount to leave the barrier, as a result commenced extremely awkwardly losing considerable ground. This incident will be referred to apprentice school for tutoring. Rider Miss Patis was fined the sum of \$100 under AR137A(4)(c) for using her whip when out of contention.

Hirvonen (B Smith) – As the start was effected got its head up and as result B Smith sat back in the saddle and the gelding commenced extremely awkwardly losing considerable ground. This incident will be referred to apprentice school for tutoring.

RACE 7 – ROSEVEARS HOTEL MAIDEN/CLASS 1 HCP – 2100 METRES

Akbar Jay (B Muhcu) – slow into stride.

Country Way NZ (D Parish) – rider D Parish pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR137A(5)(a)(i) in that she used her whip in consecutive strides on 15 occasion prior to the 100 metres. D Parish's licence to ride in races has been suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight on Sunday 15th July 2018 and to expire at midnight on Sunday 22nd July 2018. D Parish pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in the she used her whip on 17 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 12 more than permitted under this rule. D Parish's licence to ride in races has been suspended races has been suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to be served concurrently with the previous charge to commence at midnight on Sunday 15th July 2018 and expire at midnight on Sunday 22nd July 2018. In determining penalty in relation to both charges stewards took into account D Parish's guilty pleas.

Saalim (A Darmanin) – slow into stride.

The Grey Crusader (S Amano) – laid in, in the home straight.

Pinkeyes Pride (A Patis) – slow into stride. Raced four-wide in the early stages before being allowed to stride forward and take up the lead passing the 1600 metres. Rider A Patis stated that she was instructed to allow the mare to stride forward. Miss Patis further added that after beginning only average the mare then commenced to race keenly in the early stages. Near the 400 metres restrained when momentarily tightened for room by **Country Way** (D Parish) which shifted out. D Parish was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

RACE 8 – TRC PUNTERS CLUB BENCHMARK 70 HCP – 2100 METRES

Taramaya (S Carr) – preformed below expectations. Rider S Carr could offer no explanation for the performance other than the mare may have not been suited by the heavy impost on the heavy track conditions. Trainer S Brunton advised that the mare would have a short freshen up with a few of racing at Devonport in the near future.

Matiano (C Graham) – laid in, in the home straight. Rider C Graham pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 7 occasion prior to the 100 metres which is 2 more than permitted under this rule C Graham was subsequently fined the sum of \$500. In determining penalty stewards took into account Mr Graham's record and totality of his whip use.

Slalom (S Amano) - rider S Amano reported that the gelding laid out throughout the run.
