Comments / Explanations:

Jason Maskiell was advised he must submit a medical clearance prior to riding again.

RACE 1 – SIMONS DESIGN CENTRE CLASS 3 HCP – 1150 METRES

Silzoar (C Newitt) – rider C Newitt stated that the gelding failed to quicken when placed under pressure from the 200 metres and on pulling up felt something may have been amiss. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

It's A Battle (B Smith) – laid in under pressure in the home straight.

Meteor Strike (A Darmanin) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed minor abrasions to the geldings near hind fetlock and hock however no treatment was required.

RACE 2 – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN – 1150 METRES

Prior to correct weight rider T Baker (Evil In Me) viewed the official films of the home straight, after doing so was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Golden State (R Clark) – near the 100 metres carried wider on the track by Smack Talk

Renford (C Newitt) – slow into stride

Evil In Me (T Baker) – near the 200 metres momentarily tightened by Border Protection (A Darmanin) which lay in. A Darmanin was advised to exercise care.

Jayemara (H McCarthy) – commenced awkwardly. Near the 100 metres restrained when momentarily tightened between Renford and Golden State which was carried wider by Smack Talk (I Toker). Ismail Toker was reprimanded under AR137(a) careless riding and advised to ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground. Raced wide for the majority of the race.

Border Protection (A Darmanin) – inclined to lay in in the home straight.

Cape Cardinal (B Smith) – when questioned rider B Smith stated that she had been instructed to be positive from the barrier and attempt to lead. B Smith added that after obtaining the lead passing the 600 metres the gelding commenced to race keenly and lay out. B Smith further added that she was reluctant to restrain the gelding through the middle stages as she was comfortable with the tempo and mindful that the gelding was over-racing.

Bonduel Lily (C Willis) – raced wide for the majority of the race.

Oh So Needy (T Voorham) – inconvenienced shortly after the start by Golden State which shifted in. Restrained over the concluding stages when improving behind the tiring Cape Cardinal.

Smack Talk (I Toker) – rider I Toker reported that his saddle slipped backward passing the 200 metres placing him at a disadvantage. I Toker further added that the filly raced greenly.

RACE 3 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN MAIDEN – 1350 METRES

Emmceeoh (C Newitt) – approaching the 1200 metres when being restrained rider C Newitt accidentally dropped his near side rein momentarily.

Swinley Forest (B McCoull) – passing the 1200 metres restrained when tightened by Emsgem (A Patis) which shifted in when not fully clear. A Patis was reprimanded under AR137(a) careless riding and advised she must be fully clear when shifting ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have acute myositis in the gluteals and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing.

Words In Motion (I Toker) – near the 1200 metres restrained when momentarily tightened by Emsgem which shifted in.

Emsgem (A Patis) – required to be resaddled behind the barrier.

RACE 4 – THOROUGHBRED AWARD DINNER 7TH SEPT CLASS 2 HCP – 1350 METRES

The start of this race delayed due to Dothraki Princess becoming fractious in its barrier and undergoing 2 veterinary examinations.

Somerset (S Carr) – slow into stride. Performed below expectations. Rider S Carr stated that the mare raced flat and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Jack's Choice (T Voorham) – brushed with Glistening Star passing the 50 metres. Accidentally struck over the nose by the whip of I Toker (Glistening Star) near the 50 metres.

Super Leane (T Baker) – near the 500 metres when inclined to lay out restrained when racing tightly to the inside of Glistening Star which lay in slightly.

Dothraki Princess (A Darmanin) – fractious in the barrier on 2 separate occasions and underwent veterinary examinations which passed it suitable to race. The mare must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again. Over-raced in the middle stages. Trainer A Trinder advised the mare will now be spelled.

Gee Gee Royal Miss (C Newitt) – lay in in the home straight.

Glistening Star (I Toker) – brushed with Jack's Choice passing the 50 metres.

Life's Quest (D Schmitt) – raced wide without cover throughout.

RACE 5 – SKY RACING OPEN HCP – 1150 METRES

Geegees Doublejay (S Carr) – lay in in the home straight. Performed below expectations, rider S Carr stated that the gelding which was first up since 28 February 2018 should derive benefit from the run. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

O'Lonh Star (T Voorham) – raced keenly through the middle stages.

Concentrate (A Darmanin) – knuckled at the start.

RACE 6 – THAI IMPERIAL LATROBE CLASS 1 HCP – 1150 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to Lord Derby undergoing a veterinary examination at the barrier.

Meetony (H McCarthy) – lay in in the home straight.

Kenfromthebar (C Willis) – tailed the field throughout and was uncompetitive. Rider C Willis stated that the gelding failed to respond to her riding at any stage through the early and middle stages and as the gelding continued to lose ground despite her urgings she elected to ease down in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. The gelding must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

Lord Derby (T Voorham) – after getting its off hind leg up in the barrier was then removed and underwent a veterinary examination which passed the gelding suitable to race.

Isere – late scratching at 8am due to no suitable available rider

Ex Words (B Smith) – raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

RACE 7 – CARLTON DRAUGHT MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – 1650 METRES

Kingsclere (H McCarthy) – raced three wide without cover from the 600 metres.

Master Onslow (D Schmitt) – stood flat footed and slow into stride (3L). Commenced to give ground from the 600 metres. Rider D Schmitt stated that the gelding failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. Trainer G White advised that he would be adding blinkers to the gelding and that in his opinion Master Onslow may not suited to the synthetic surface and would now look for a suitable race in Hobart. A warning has been placed on the gelding for being uncompetitive and further action may be taken if it races in a similar manner.

RACE 8 – DANNEBROG BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 1650 METRES

Aventador (H McCarthy) – raced keenly in the early stages

Scouting Around (R Clark) – raced keenly in the early stages and leaving the front straight had to be restrained when improving up on the heels of Sir Marmaduke. Rider R Clark explained that after racing tightly to the inside of Greenmount Lass leaving the front straight the gelding then commenced to pull hard and when the pace eased slightly she had difficulty avoiding the heels of Sir Marmaduke.

Rougeau (B Smith) – raced three wide without cover throughout.

Trusted Warrior (B McCoull) – after arriving on course underwent a veterinary examination which revealed a minor abrasion to the off hind fetlock however was passed suitable to race.

Sir Marmaduke (S Carr) – after crossing to the lead leaving the front straight appeared to have its hind legs galloped on by Scouting Around which improved when over racing. As the gelding had left the course, trainer Mr S Brunton will be contacted in the coming days to see if any matter has arisen which may have affected the gelding's performance.
