RACE 1 – SIMONS DESIGN CENTRE MAIDEN – 1000 METRES

Chloe's King (A Darmanin) – shifted out at the start and bumped with Indian Silk

My Luck Is Manny (T Voorham) – fractious in the mounting yard resulting in rider A Darmanin (Chloe's King) providing assistance. A Darmanin was reminded of his obligations as a rider who had a riding engagement in this race. Trainer V Poke will be spoken to regarding this incident. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Near the 800 metres restrained when momentarily tightened by Chloe's King (A Darmanin) which shifted in when not quite clear. A Darmanin was advised to exercise care when shifting ground. Rounding the turn at the 600 metres carried wider on the track by Wharfie's Boy which lay out.

Pincent Van Gogh NZ (C Newitt) – lay in in the home straight.

Gee Gee Mightymiss (G Catania) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed suitable to race as the mare had not started in a race since February 2017.

Huff'n'toff (B Smith) – weakened from the 100 metres after leading. Rider B Smith explained that the mare travelled well however failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. Co trainer T Wells advised that they would be assessing the mare's racing future with their stable.

Indian Silk (B Muhcu) – bumped at the start by Chloe's King

Orphanali (S Thornton) – fractious in the barrier and a warning was issued. Bounded in the air at the start. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

The Rockbank Flash (A Patis) – fractious in the barrier and a warning was issued. Raced three wide without cover from the 600 metres. Near the 300 metres tightened between Pincent Van Gogh which lay in and My Luck Is Manny.

Wharfie's Boy (D Ganderton) – lay out rounding the turn at the 600 metres.

RACE 2 – DRC TRAINER ADAM TRINDER BENCHMARK 58 HCP – 1350 METRES

It's A Battle (B Smith) – passing the 300 metres steadied and carried wider by Ponzi (I Toker) which shifted out under pressure. I Toker was severely reprimanded under AR137(a) careless riding and advised to ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground.

Khatun (A Patis) – slow into stride.

Gee Gee Royal Miss (C Graham) – performed below expectations. Rider C Graham explained that the mare got slightly further back in the run than intended however failed to run on as expected in the home straight when placed under pressure.

Ponzi (I Toker) – passing the 300 metres shifted out under pressure.

RACE 3 – DRC H.O.Y WILLBY RULES CLASS 1 HCP – 1350 METRES

Balearic (C Newitt) – momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

Sudden Shock (T Voorham) – re-saddled at the barrier which delayed the start. Rounding the home turn carried slightly wider by Balearic which shifted out to obtain clear running. Rider T Voorham stated that the gelding travelled well however failed to respond to her riding from the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to have a slow recovery and slightly elevated heart rate. Trainer P Hill advised that he was disappointed with the performance and would be having blood tests undertaken. P Hill added that he would advise Stewards of any matter that may have affected the gelding's performance.

Ramaadi Bullet (B Smith) – Rider B Smith explained that after being slow to muster early speed the gelding settled further back than intended.

Jaws Of Life (B Muhcu) – raced three wide without cover throughout. Near the 400 metres restrained when tightened between Voices and Sudden Shock which was taken outward by Balearic (C Newitt) which shifted out when not fully clear. C Newitt was reprimanded under AR137(a) careless riding and advised to ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground.

Following the running of this race, rider Breana Smith was examined by the on course Medical Officer and stood down from her remaining riding engagement. B Smith must submit a medical certificate prior to riding again.

RACE 4 – DRC APPRENTICE CHRIS GRAHAM BENCHMARK 66 HCP – 1650 METRES

Into The Night (C Graham) – late scratching at 8:40am due to the gelding sustaining a laceration to the off fore leg and a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again.

Beautiful Boy (A Patis) – raced three wide without cover in the early stages.

He Swims Well (B McCoull) – performed below expectations. Rider B McCoull stated that gelding didn't travel comfortably in the run and elected to ease down over the final 200 metres as felt something may have been amiss. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a boil over the wither and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.

RACE 5 – DRC JOCKEY ANTHONY DARMANIN CLASS 2 HCP – 1150 METRES

Al Cosmic Gift (C Newitt) – over-raced in the early stages. Lay in in the home straight.

City Of Dreams (A Patis) – passing the 200 metres brushed the running rail.

Jurisdiction (D Ganderton) – performed below expectations. Rider D Ganderton stated that the gelding failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a poor recovery and elevated heart rate and a cracked hoof. The gelding will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.

Gee Gee Rich Ruby (G Catania) – near the 600 metres restrained when tightened for room by Jurisdiction (D Ganderton) which shifted in.

Berry Wise Fox (T Baker) – slow into stride. Rider T Baker stated that he felt something may have been amiss with the mare in front and elected to ease down over the concluding stages. A veterinary examination revealed the mare to be coughing post-race however no treatment was required.

D Ganderton (Jurisdiction) was found guilty of a charge under AR137(a) careless riding, the carelessness being that approaching the 600 metres he shifted ground inward tightening the running of Gee Gee Rich Ruby (G Catania) placing that mare in restricted room and as a result G Catania had to restrain her mount and lose her rightful position. D Ganderton had his licence to ride in races suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to commence midnight 25 September 2018 and expire midnight 30 September 2018. In determining penalty Stewards took into account D Ganderton's record and the incident to be in the mid-low range.

RACE 6 – BRIAN MARTIN BENCHMARK 70 HCP – 1880 METRES

Taramaya (T Baker) – raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

Flash Missile (C Graham) – slow into stride

Mississippi Grind (C Newitt) – steadied near the 1600 metres when Life Of Waldo shifted in. Performed below expectations, rider C Newitt explained that the mare raced flat and may have come to the end of its preparation. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to have a slightly elevated heart rate. Trainer M Trinder advised that the mare will now be spelled.

RACE 7 – DRC H.O.Y WILLBY RILES BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 1150 METRES

Gee Gees Queenie (T Baker) – raced three wide without cover throughout. Stewards will inquire into the manner in which rider T Baker rode the mare out of the concluding stages.

Vengeance Of Fury (C Newitt) – Rider C Newitt stated that the gelding travelled well however failed to respond when placed under pressure in the home straight and was disappointing. Stewards will inquire into the manner in which rider C Newitt rode the gelding out of the concluding stages.

Effortless Opera (S Thornton) – commenced awkwardly.
