RACE 1 – UNIQUE DOORS AND WINDOWS CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to the on-course paramedics having to attend to a patron.

Ella (A Darmanin) – Performed below expectations, rider A Darmanin stated that the mare travelled well, however, failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Rubinic (C Willis (a)) – Shortly after the start, got its head up when being restrained after being carried up towards the heels of **Gee Gees Can Tell**. Raced three wide without cover from the 700 metres. Performed below expectations, Rider C Willis explained that after not beginning cleanly and having to be restrained after the start, this left her further back than intended which was detrimental to the mare's performance as it is better suited when ridden forward. A post-race veterinary inspection of **Rubinic** failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer J Keys stated that he would assess the mares racing future with his stable.

Kepta (C Newitt) – Slow into stride.

RACE 2 – trchobart.com.au BENCHMARK 76 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Apriano (T Voorham (a)) – Slow into stride. Rider T Voorham reported that the gelding laid out rounding the home turn.

When questioned regarding the scratchings of his horses in this race, trainer Scott Brunton explained that **Orange River** which is an acceptor on Tuesday night at Mowbray, felt that the mare was better suited in that race than today. He further added that **Sav's Finale** and **Nunivak** worked on Friday, however, he was not satisfied with their work after they both blew heavily following gallops. Mr Brunton's explanation was noted and he was advised that in future he is to be totally satisfied with the fitness of his runners at the time of acceptances and leave no room for questioning.

RACE 3 – elwickfunctionsandevents.com.au MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

Chloe's King (A Patis (a)) – Knuckled at the start. Approaching the 800 metres when the pace eased, shifted out when improving up on to the heels of **Rogue One**, inconveniencing **Special Moment**.

Gee Gee Countryboy (T Voorham (a)) – Knuckled at the start.

I am the Dude (C Newitt) – Commenced extremely awkwardly and made contact with **Loladere**. Raced wide without cover throughout.

My Luck is Manny (M Ulucinar) – Bumped at the start. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Loladere (C Willis (a)) – Bumped at the start by **I Am the Dude**. Lay in in the home straight.

Rubikat (B Muhcu) – Bumped at the start. Held up rounding the home turn. Rider B Muhcu stated that after not beginning as well as expected, he raced further back than intended. Trainer G White confirmed that it had been his intention to have the mare ridden in a handy position today.

Special Moment (A Darmanin) – Near the 800 metres, inconvenienced by **Chloe's King** which shifted out to avoid the heels of **Rogue One**. Rider A Darmanin stated that after racing wide with cover, the filly raced greenly and in his opinion should derive benefit from the run.

RACE 4 – TRC MELBOURNE CUP LUNCHEON MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – 1600 METRES

Jaws of Life (A Patis (a)) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Near the 1200 metres when the pace slackened, shifted out after improving up on to the heels of **The Decider** carrying **Lord Derby** wider on the track.

Lord Derby (I Toker) – Passing the 1200 metres, inconvenienced and carried wider by **Jaws of Life** which shifted out. **Lord Derby** then commenced to over-race and throw its head in the air.

Submit Another (T Baker) – Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

The Decider (C Newitt) – Rider C Newitt explained that the gelding which was racing in blinkers for the first time, he had been instructed to race in a handy position. With the wide draw, he had to work hard in the early stages to take up a forward position and eventually took up the lead passing the 1200 metres which had not been his intention. Rider Newitt added that the gelding was not suited by being challenged for the lead by **Lord Derby** during the middle stages which may have been detrimental to the gelding over the concluding stages.

Master Onslow (M Ulucinar) – Commenced awkwardly and was slow into stride. Laid in in the early part of the home straight and raced greenly.

Movido (A Darmanin) – Change of tactics. Trainer B Baker advised will attempt to be ridden further forward today. After being ridden along in the early stages, was unable to muster speed and settled towards the rear of the field.

Pinkeyes Pride (S Amano) – Slow into stride (3L).

RACE 5 – T.H.A. CAULFIELD CUP LUNCHEON OCT 20 MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Aquietword (C Newitt) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Style Guru (NZ) (M Ulucinar) – Trainer J Luttrell was fined \$50 under LR7.2 for the late gear change of the removal of blinkers on the gelding. Commenced to weaken from the 400 metres after leading. Rider M Ulucinar stated that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages, however, in the home straight he felt there may have been something amiss with the gelding's off-fore leg and he elected ease the gelding down over the final 100 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Cést Bon (T Baker) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed suitable to race as the mare had not started in a race since November 2016.

Frisco Dame (G Catania) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Roulette Star – Late scratching at 7.48 am with lacerations to the off-fore leg. A veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again.

Smooth Pebbles (S Amano) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed suitable to race as the filly had not started in a race since August 2017.

RACE 6 – A.W.M. ELECTRICAL CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1000 METRES

Silent Savings (C Willis (a)) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Gee Gee Pengala (C Newitt) – Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt explained that the gelding travelled well, however, failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure in the home straight and on pulling up it made an unusual respiratory noise. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Kenfromthebar (I Toker) – When questioned on the improved performance today, Trainer Glenn Stevenson stated that he had reduced the gelding's work-load and subsequently the gelding trialled well at Longford on 18 September 2018. Mr Stevenson added that in his opinion **Kenfromthebar** is best suited to grass tracks with some give in the ground similar to today's conditions.

Quick Quill (T Voorham (a)) – Change of tactics. Trainer Miss S Carr advised will attempt to be ridden further back today. Bumped and tightened for room at the start then settled at the rear of the field.

RACE 7 – ROGERSON AND BIRCH SURVEYORS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Appmat (I Toker) – At the start bumped with **Wyuna**. Over-raced in the early and middle stages when racing three wide without cover.

Don Reggio (D Ganderton) – Rider D Ganderton explained that after beginning well and with the lack of early pace from the runners on his inside, he was left further forward than intended which did not suit the gelding.

Trusted Warrior (B McCoull) – Knuckled at the start.

Wyuna (C Newitt) – At the start bumped with **Appmat**.

Glistening Star (A Darmanin) – Rider A Darmanin explained that he had been instructed to race in a mid-field position however after beginning well and racing keenly in the early stages, the mare was positioned further forward than he had intended.

Race 7 - Benchmark 64 Handicap – 1150 metres

Gee Gees Queenie - Rider T Baker was reprimanded under AR 137(b) for failing to ride his mount out fully to the finish.

Vengeance Of Fury - Rider C Newitt was reprimanded under AR 137(b) for failing to ride his mount out fully to the finish.
