RACE 1 – AUSTRALIAN TRAINERS' ASSOCIATION BENCHMARK 70 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Earl Da Vinci (NZ) (T Baker) – Dipped after the start. Steadied off heels near the 1100 metres when **Boart** (A Patis(a)) shifted in when not quite clear. Apprentice Patis was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground in future.

King Manu (NZ) (S Carr) – Slow into stride.

Scouting Around (C Newitt) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and passed fit to take its place in the field today after an incident in the float en route to the race-course.

Boart (A Patis (a)) – Apprentice A Patis stated that it was her intention to ride the gelding with cover, however, due to the lack of early pace of other runners, she was left further forward than planned.

Ella (T Voorham (a)) - After heavily kicking the starting gates on two occasions, **Ella** underwent a veterinary inspection behind the barriers and was subsequently declared a late scratching at 12.41pm. Prior to the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered all monies invested on **Ella** to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 12.41 pm were to be paid less twenty four cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket.

RACE 2 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS BENCHMARK 70 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Our Shanakee (T Voorham (a)) – Failed to muster early speed.

Overplay (C Graham (a)) – Apprentice Chris Graham pleaded guilty and was fined the sum of \$400 under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 9 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is four more than the permitted number under this Rule.

Gee Gees Style (C Newitt) – Commenced awkwardly. Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt explained that the gelding would be better suited to a track with more give. Trainer L Wells advised that the gelding would now be spelled.

RACE 3 – GEE GEE HORSE STUD MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Gee Gee Countryboy (T Voorham (a)) – Bumped at the start.

Golden State (C Graham (a)) – Carried inwards shortly after the start by **Huontegz** (S Carr) which was not sufficiently clear. Jockey S Carr was advised to exercise more care in future than she had done on this occasion.

Orphanali (C Newitt) – Shifted in on jumping away and bumped with **Gee Gee Countryboy**. Shortly after the start, restrained when tightened between **Golden State** which was taken inwards by **Huontegz**.

Ty's Missile (B Smith (a)) – Slow into stride. Got its head up and over-raced near the 1000 metre mark.

Heaven's Venture (M Ulucinar) – Slow into stride.

Orange Roughie (B McCoull) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Digger's Girl (T Baker) – Slow into stride. Rider T Baker explained that the filly, which was wearing blinkers for the first time, was slow to begin. However after riding along in the early stages, he was able to take up a forward position.

*** Stewards upgraded the track rating to GOOD (3) at 2.05 pm ***

RACE 4 – HANSON FAMILY BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Gee Gee Sun Valley (T Voorham (a)) – Held up for a clear run approaching the 200 metres.

Chloe's King (A Patis (a)) – Checked passing the 200 metre mark when Gee Gee Sun Valley (T Voorham (a)) shifted in when not clear.

Miss Scandilous (C Newitt) – Bumped and carried slightly wider at the 200 metre mark.

Gee Gees Can Tell (S Carr) – Over-raced approaching the 800 metre mark. Held up for racing room between the 400 metres and the 200 metres. Shifted out near the 200 metres, bumping with **Miss Scandilous**.

Apprentice Teagan Voorham pleaded guilty of a charge under AR 137(a) careless riding in that approaching the 200 metres, she allowed her mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of **Chloe's King** (A Patis (a)) resulting in this gelding having to be checked by its rider. Stewards deemed the interference to be in the mid level and the carelessness to be in the mid level. Apprentice Voorham's licence to ride in races was suspended for one (1) Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight tonight and to expire at midnight on 3 October 2018. In arriving at penalty, Stewards look into consideration Apprentice Voorham's very good record under this Rule.

RACE 5 – BRUNTON RACING CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Hirvonen (S Carr) – Slow into stride.

RACE 6 – ROAT CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Paion (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride. Laid in over the concluding stages.

Gee Gees Cash Cow (T Voorham (a)) – Held up for clear running from after the 400 metre mark until near the 300 metres.

Splash Around (S Carr) – Rider S Carr elected not to ride her mount out over the concluding stages as she felt there may have been something amiss. A post-race veterinary inspection of **Splash Around** revealed the mare to have cardiac arrhythmia. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance and a clear ECG is required following a 1000 metre gallop in the presence of a Steward before **Splash Around** will be permitted to start in a trial or a race. Trainer S Carr advised she will consider the mares racing future.

RACE 7 – ROYSTON CARR MAIDEN / CLASS 1 – 2100 METRES

Kingsclere (T Voorham (a)) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after slipping in its race-day stall. Subsequently passed fit to take its place in the field. Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres. Rider Voorham accidentally dropped her whip at approximately the 300 metre mark.

Master Onslow (M Ulucinar) – Over-raced in the early stages and jumped the crossing at the 1700 metre mark. M Ulucinar felt there may have been something amiss and eased the gelding down over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary inspection of **Master Onslow** failed to reveal any abnormalities. The connections were advised that **Master Onslow** must satisfactorily complete an official barrier trial before the gelding will be permitted to race again.

Pinkeyes Pride (A Patis (a)) – Slow to begin (3L).

RACE 8 – trchobart.com.au BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

Trusted Warrior (B McCoull) – Passing the 400 metres, accidentally struck over the nose with the whip of Rider Troy Baker (**Cascade City**).
