### **Comments / Explanations:**

Steward's accepted the explanation of rider D Schmitt for not attending tonight's meeting.

Trainer T Keys was fined \$100 for the late notification of her riders in Races 4 and 7

### **RACE 1 – TABCORP MAIDEN – 1200 METRES**

**Day Trader** (S Carr) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had not raced since 4 November 2016 and subsequently passed suitable to race. Shifted out on jumping away, carrying Jackson James out onto Gee Gee Born Free which shifted out and hampered Posh Pursuit, which in turn was carried out onto Rubikat and Style Guru (NZ).

**I Am The Dude** (C Newitt) – Bounded in the air on jumping striking rider C Newitt in the face and lost ground.

**Jackson James** (C Willis) - Bumped and carried outward at the start. Over raced in the early and middle stages. Lay out throughout. Rider C Willis stated the gelding raced greenly.

**Needs A Scotch** (T Voorham) - Held up rounding the home turn. Approaching the finish, had difficulty obtaining clear running to the inside of Evil In Me.

**Regal Red** (I Toker) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had not raced since 17 September 2017 and subsequently passed suitable to race. Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race. Near the 100 metres, when giving ground, had to be steadied away from Jackson James (C Willis) which shifted out. C Willis was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

**Rogue One** (S Amano) - Approaching the 100 metres when laying out steadied off the heels of I'm A Lucky Girl which shifted in slightly. Shortly after when shifting in, was then tightened for room between I'm A Lucky Girl and Special Moment (A Darmanin), which shifted out. A Darmanin was reprimanded under AR137(a) careless riding and notified to ensure that he is fully clear when shifting ground.

**Style Guru (NZ)** (R Bishop) - Bumped at the start.

**Posh Pursuit (A Patis)** - Hampered when carried wider at the start.

**Rubikat** (B Muhcu) - Bumped and carried wider at the start.

**Gee Gee Born Free** (G Catania) Bumped and carried wider at the start.

**Special Moment** (A Darmanin) - Momentarily held up approaching the 100 meters. Performed below expectations. Rider A Darmanin explained that after following Jackson James through the run which was racing greenly he was positioned further back than anticipated. A Darmanin added that the filly raced greenly, however after having difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight he was satisfied with the way it finished off the race, and in his opinion would be better suited over a further distance. Co-trainer I Miller stated that she was satisfied with the filly's performance which was having its fourth race start, given the filly is still immature and may not have been suited racing on the inside of other horses.

#### **RACE 2 – DAKIN REFRIGERATION CLASS 1 HCP– 1200 METRES**

**Lesnar** (C Willis) - Reared on jumping away and lost ground.

**Nidoking** (B Muhcu) - Change of tactics. To be ridden further back if circumstances permit. Slightly slow to begin and then brushed with Lesnar. Settled at the tail of the field.

**Bless Me Father** (S Amano) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**Gee Gee Mr Paul** (G Catania) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider G Catania stated that she felt something may have been amiss with the gelding's action in the home straight and added that the gelding may be better suited to a track with more give. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Zuberina** (S Carr) - Rider S Carr stated that after being caught wide in the early stages she elected to press forward and sit outside the lead.

**Mag Wheels** (I Toker) - Fractious in the barrier. A warning was issued.

#### **RACE 3 – TRADIES & LADIES 17 OCTOBER MDN/CLASS 1– 1600 METRES**

**Copperhead Road** (C Newitt) - Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

**Geegee Blackprince** (S Carr) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Kingsclere** (T Voorham) - Bumped at the start. Approaching the 1200 metres restrained when racing tightly between Geegee Blackprince and Tough Rubble. Rounding the home turn, carried wider on the track by Smooth Pebbles.

**Ramaadi Bullet** (B Muhcu) - Rider B Muhcu stated that after beginning extremely well the gelding was left further forward than anticipated.

**Tough Rubble** (A Darmanin) - Bumped at the start.

**Gee Gees Roughie** (M Ulucinar) - Bumped at the start. Shortly after was restrained when tightened for room between Copperhead Road and Tough Rubble, which had been taken inward by Kingsclere which had in turn been carried in by Ramaadi Bullet (B Muhcu). B Muchu was advised to exercise care when allowing his mounts to shift ground.

**Shivida** (G Catania) - Unable to muster early speed. Between the 500 and 400 meters restrained when held up after improving up onto heels. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the home straight.

#### **RACE 4 – SUN STUD BM70 HCP– 1600 METRES**

**Trusted Warrior** (B McCoull) – Raced three wide from the 1100 metres. When questioned, rider B McCoull explained that it had been his intention to follow Balearic through the run, however was unable to obtain that position as Leconte had established that run in the early stages, one of the fence. B McCoull added, as the gelding was not suited by the slow tempo he elected to remain three wide as the gelding lacks a turn of foot and if he had restrained further back he felt he would then not be able to

quicken into the race. B McCoull added that the gelding would be better suited to races with a quicker tempo and to a track with more give.

**Leconte** (T Voorham) – Re saddled behind the barrier delaying the start.

#### **RACE 5 – CHEF'S CATCH BM70 HCP– 1200 METRES**

**Mandela Effect** (T Voorham) – Lay in in the home straight.

**Apriano** (B Smith) – Knuckled at the start. Rider B Smith was severely reprimanded under AR137A(5)(a)(i) for using her whip in consecutive strides on 1 occasion prior to the 100 metres.

**Silzoar** (C Newitt) – Entering the home straight, brushed with Mandella Effect, which was laying in and placed closely to the heels of Balestrand (NZ). Had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 100 metres. Rider C Newitt stated that the gelding raced keenly in the early stages and was slow to balance up after brushing with Mandela Effect on straightening.

**Cheers Chappy** (T Baker) - Late scratching at 5.40PM on veterinary advice, after the gelding had an incident in the float on route to the track and a veterinary clearance will be required prior to racing.

**Westwood** (I Toker) - Late scratching at 7.44AM by order of Stewards. Trainer J Blacker was subsequently fined the sum of \$100 under LR14.1 for failing to scratch the gelding by the prescribed time.

#### **RACE 6 – ALLANS GARDEN CENTRE BM58 HCP– 1200 METRES**

**Dubbo** (B Smith) – Held up for clear running between the 500 and 300 metres. Between the 250 and until passing the 100 metres was held up when disappointed for a run between Lads Curfew (T Voorham) which shifted out under pressure and Go For It. T Voorham was advised to exercise care when allowing her mounts to shift ground.

**Astrobelle** (B Muhcu) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

**Crystal Flame** (I Toker) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. After racing wide from the 700 metres was eased down over the concluding stages. Rider I Toker stated that the mare travelled well in the run, however failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Gee Gees Can Tell** (S Carr) – Held up rounding the home turn.

**The Rockbank Flash** (A Darmanin) – Slow into stride.

Due to a short power outage following the running of this event with a number of lights having to be restarted, the remaining races were all put back 1 race with race 7 rescheduled to 9.30pm, race 8 rescheduled to 10pm and race 9 rescheduled to 10.30pm.

#### **RACE 7 – BIDFOOD LAUNCESTON OPEN HCP– 2100 METRES**

**Up Cups** (R Bishop) – Held up for clear running between the 500 metres and until obtaining clear running passing the 100 metres.

**Demons Run** (B Muhcu) – Re-saddled behind the barriers, delaying the start.

**Flash Missile** (S Carr) – Near the 50 meters when giving ground, was restrained when racing tightly to the inside of Up Cups (R Bishop) which had shifted in slightly. R Bishop was reprimanded under AR137(a) careless riding and advised to exercise care when shifting ground. Performed below expectations. Rider S Carr stated that the mare travelled well in running however felt something amiss with its action in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be in season, however no other abnormalities were detected. Subsequent to the race meeting Trainer S Gandy advised that the mare had pulled up fine and confirmed that she had been in season. S Gandy added that due to the delay prior to this race and the mare had become fractious and unsettled which

may have affected her performance. S Gandy further added that the mare may have been better suited to the slower early and mid-race tempo when she won on 25 September 2018, rather than the tempo of tonight's race

**Appmat** (I Toker) - Near the 1400 metres got its head up on a number of occasions when racing keenly.

**Really Sure** (A Patis) – Bumped at the start.

**The Grey Crusader** (S Amano) – Commenced awkwardly, shifted in bumping with Really Sure.

#### **RACE 8 – BETTOR MILK CAFÉ' CLASS 2 HCP– 1400 METRES**

**Invincible Rock** (S Carr) – Lay in near the 500 metres and brushed the running rail. Rider S Carr reported that the gelding lay in throughout the run. Subsequent to the race meeting Trainer S Carr explained that the gelding had pulled up satisfactory however may not have backed up from its run on 3 October 2018 and would look to space the gelding's runs in future. S Carr added that as the gelding lays in she would be considering a rider change at its next start.

**Jodi Nicole** (I Toker) – Lay in rounding the home turn.

**Miss Scandilous** (B Muhcu) – Restrained shortly after the start when momentarily tightened between Invincible Rock, which shifted in and Husson Park.

**Hirvonen** (S Amano) – Near the 400 metres when racing in restricted room, made contact with the hind quarters of Jodi Nicole (I Toker), which lay in, despite the efforts of its rider and became unbalanced. I Toker was advised to exercise care when permitting his mounts to shift ground.

#### **RACE 9 – HALLOWEEN SPOOKTAKULAR 31<sup>ST</sup> OCTOBER BM64 HCP– 1400 METRES**

**Al Cosmic Gift** (C Newitt) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Over raced in the early and middle stages. Near the 800 metres bumped with Boart. Lay in in the home straight. Rider C Newitt stated that the gelding after racing wide was inclined to lay in in the straight and was disappointing. Subsequent to the race meeting Trainer J Blacker reported the gelding had pulled up well and he would continue on with its preparation.

**Boart** (A Patis) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Bumped with Al Cosmic Gift near the 800 metres. Momentarily held up near the 150 metres.
