Comments / Explanations:

Trainer T Keys was fined \$200 for the late notification of her riders.

RACE 1 – CANCER COUNCIL MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Greykap (C Graham) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider C Graham stated that the gelding lay out throughout the run.

Jackson James (D Ganderton) – Change of tactics. Trainer advised will attempt to be ridden further forward if circumstances permit. Re-saddled after arriving at the barrier. Raced outside the leader. Lay out rounding the home turn and bumped with Pincen Van Gogh. Lay in in the home straight. Rider D Ganderton stated the gelding failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure in the home straight.

Needs A Scotch (T Voorham) – Near the 200 metres lay in behind Day Trader and had to be straightened by its rider.

Pincen Van Gogh (NZ) (C Newitt) – Near the 400 metres bumped by Jackson James. Rider C Newitt stated that the gelding would be better suited to a track with more give.

Zipponet (J Maskiell) – Raced wide from the 700 metres.

Furrenzy (R Bishop) – Commenced awkwardly and was slow into stride. Had difficulty obtaining clear running over the concluding stages.

Saigon Princess (S Amano) – Over-raced in the early stages.

Fagin's Touch (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride. Raced four wide without cover throughout.

RACE 2 – VILLAGES OF LIFE FOUNDATION MDN/CLASS 1 – 1600 METRES

Akbar Jay (D Ganderton) – Stood flat footed and was slow into stride (2L). Tailed the field throughout and tailed off in the home straight. Rider D Ganderton stated that the gelding felt awkward in its action and as such elected not to ride the gelding out in the home straight. Subsequent to the race trainer P Luttrell advised that the gelding had pulled up okay, however it would undergo a thorough examination prior to starting again. The gelding now must trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing again.

Bless Me Father (S Amano) – In the early part of the home straight steadied when momentarily tightened by Louise NZ (C Graham) which shifted in. C Graham was advised to exercise care.

Geegee Blackprince (J Maskiell) – Rider J Maskiell stated that the gelding laid in throughout the run. When questioned, Trainer S Gandy explained that he had not been too disappointed with the geldings previous run on 10 October 2018 after racing three wide without cover throughout and added the gelding benefited from a softer run tonight. S Gandy added that a gear change to a near side blinker may have also had an effect on the gelding's performance.

Lord Derby (I Toker) – Over raced in the early stages. When questioned regarding the amount of times he looked over his shoulder in the early part of the home straight, rider I Toker explained that he initially glanced over his shoulder to assess the remainder of the field to see who was progressing forward. He then looked again after hearing a number of calls behind him to ensure that he wasn't causing interference. Stewards accepted I Toker's explanation however advised him that he must not continue to look around excessively in future.

Rusty Devil (B Muhcu) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Near the 500m when weakening was restrained when buffeted and tightened for room between Geegee Blackprince (J Maskiell) which lay in before being corrected and Sudden Shock (T Voorham) which after shifting out to obtain clear running, then lay out. J Maskiell and T Voorham were both advised to exercise far greater care than they did on this occasion. Rider B Muhcu stated the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Sudden Shock (T Voorham) – Near the 400 metres restrained when momentarily tightened between Geegee Blackprince (J Maskiell) which lay in and Roulette Star (T Baker) which shifted out slightly, shortly after brushed with Voices (C Newitt). J Maskiell was advised exercise care. Near the 150 metres was disappointed for a run between Geegee Blackprince and Voices before switching to the outside of that mares heels.

RACE 3 – JASON READ WORKFORCE EXTENSIONS OPEN HCP – 1400 METRES

Geegees Goldengirl (S Carr) – Rider S Carr explained that due to the early speed in this race the mare settled further back than anticipated.

Box Of Frogs (R Bishop) – Rider R Bishop explained that after crossing to sit outside the leader near the 1200 metres the gelding then commenced to over race. R Bishop further added that in his opinion the gelding would be better suited on a track with more give.

Underplay (C Graham) – Passing the 400 metres was momentarily tightened between Jerilderie Letter and Box Of Frogs which shifted out slightly when weakening.

RACE 4 – UNIQUE DOORS CLASS 2 HCP (F&M) – 1400 METRES

Party Planner (A Darmanin) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Rider A Darmanin stated that the mare was not suited to the step up in distance to 1400 metres.

Triple Strip (C Newitt) – Slow into stride.

Gee Gees Can Tell (T Voorham) – Lay out under pressure in the home straight.

RACE 5 – CANCER COUNCIL RELAY FOR LIFE CLASS 2 HCP (C&G) – 1400 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to the late scratching of The Greatness.

Invincible Rock (C Newitt) – Change of tactics. Trainer S Carr advised would attempt be ridden with cover. Trainer S Carr was reprimanded under AR135A for failing to notify stewards of her intended change of tactics within the prescribed time. Inconvenienced at the start by Gasnier which shifted in and then settled toward the rear of the field with cover. Rider C Newitt stated that the gelding got further back in the run than intended after suffering some minor interference at the start.

The Greatness (T Baker) – Late scratching at 8:31pm by order of stewards after the horse harmlessly dislodged its rider behind the barrier and then galloped a considerable distance back to the mounting enclosure.

Gee Gees Cricket (D Ganderton) – Slow into stride. Approaching the finish was held up and unable to obtain clear running.

Little Pumba (S Amano) – Slow into stride. Laid out rounding the home turn and in the early part of the home straight when laying out had to be checked off the heels of Littlerayov (T Voorham). When questioned, rider S Amano explained that he had been instructed to ride the gelding vigorously out of the barrier given that at its most recent start the gelding tailed off in the early stages. S Amano added that after being slightly slow to begin he then urged his mount along and after being caught wide he elected to continue forward and sit outside the leader which left him further forward than anticipated.

Cranny Flyer (A Patis) – Over raced during the middle stages. Approaching the 100m momentarily steadied when Littlerayov (T Voorham) shifted out. T Voorham will be advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Littlerayov (T Voorham) – When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer K Kennedy explained that she had been happy with the geldings first up run on the 10th October 2018 when only beaten 3.7L and after the gelding had worked well since, she was expecting a forward showing tonight.

RACE 6 – ANDREW COOGAN ELECTRICAL CLASS 1 HCP – 1200 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to Evil In Me undergoing a veterinary examination at the barrier and Flikpix being unable to be loaded into its barrier.

Gee Gee Secondover (C Newitt) – Inconvenienced after the start by Miss Smith (A Patis) which shifted out.

Speedy Illusion (D Ganderton) – Rider D Ganderton stated that the gelding got shuffled back in the early and middle stages which left him further back than intended. D Ganderton further added that over the concluding stages he was unable to ride his mount out fully due to him feeling ill. Following the running of this race D Ganderton was examined by the on course medical officers after feeling dizzy and nauseous. The examination revealed D Ganderton to be dehydrated, however given he had no further riding engagements D Ganderton was not stood down from any riding duties.

Breathtaking (A Darmanin) – Near the 400 metres was steadied when momentarily tightened by Speedy Illusion (D Ganderton) which shifted out. D Ganderton was advised to exercise care.

Evil In Me (T Baker) – After being loaded in its barrier stall, lunged at the front of the gate and broke through, before being reined in shortly after. Underwent a veterinary examination and was passed suitable to race. A warning was issued on the mares barrier manners. Passing the 200 metres lay in and brushed the running rail.

Flikpix (T Voorham) – Late scratching at 9:03pm when the mare was unable to be loaded. Flikpix must now trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing again.

Miss Smith (A Patis) – Rider A Patis accidentally dropped her whip near the 200 metres.

RACE 7 – THE 10TH ANNUAL GOLFING TRIP BENCHMARK 64HCP – 1200 METRES

Cheers Chappy (T Baker) – Near the 400 metres when racing in restricted room was disappointed for a run when momentarily tightened by Al Cosmic Gift (I Toker) which lay in slightly and Dothraki Princess (C Graham) which shifted out slightly. I Toker and C Graham were advised to exercise care in future.

Gee Gee Sun Valley (C Newitt) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt explained that after racing wide the mare in his opinion would appreciate a track with more give.

Gee Gee Rich Ruby (A Darmanin) – Bumped at the start by Reann's Diamond.

Reann's Diamond (M Ulucinar) – Commenced awkwardly and bumped with Gee Gee Rich Ruby.

RACE 8 – CRESSY CRICKET CLUB BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 2100 METRES

Another Brother (C Newitt) – Slow into stride.

Really Sure (T Baker) – Slow into stride.

Push Pause (C Graham) – When questioned rider C Graham stated that he had been instructed to roll forward on the gelding tonight as it was having its first start over this distance and races one paced. C Graham added that after riding the gelding along in the early stages and with the lack of early pace to runners on his inside, he was able to take up a forward position with little effort.
