Comments / Explanations:

**R Bishop was reprimanded under AR120(b) for accepting a ride for which he was unable to make the weight.*

RACE 1 – SKY RACING MAIDEN/CLASS 1– 2100 METRES

Sudden Shock (T Voorham) – Near the 1700 metres restrained when momentarily tightened for room by Style Guru which shifted in when racing keenly. Performed below expectations. Rider T Voorham could offer no explanation for the disappointing performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a slow recovery rate.

The Last Godfather (C Newitt) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the presence of blood at both nostrils. Connections were advised of the provisions of AR53A(4) in that The Last Godfather may not be trained, exercised or galloped on any race-course for a period of two months and it may not start in any race for a period of three months and then only after a satisfactorily gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a steward.

Onnanoko (M Ulucinar) – When questioned, rider M Ulucinar explained that after being caught wide in the early stages he elected to ride the mare forward as he did not want to be caught wide throughout and felt that it would be detrimental to restrain the mare after beginning well.

Pinkeyes Pride (S Amano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Roulette Star (T Baker) – Dipped at the start. Steadied near the 1700 metres. Near the 500 metres momentarily inconvenienced by Style Guru (R Bishop) which shifted out when being held up. R Bishop was advised to exercise care. Momentarily held up rounding the home turn. Rider T Baker reminded of his obligations regarding making a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post.

Style Guru (NZ) (R Bishop) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

RACE 2 – ELWICKFUNCTIONSANDEVENTS.COM.AU MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Joe Palooka (M Ulucinar) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Near the 800 metres inconvenienced and taken wider by Je Ne Sais Quoi which shifted out abruptly.

The Sword (J Maskiell) – Slow into stride. Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

Zipponet (C Newitt) – Near the 500 metres steadied off heels. Near the 100 metres restrained off the heels of Ty's Missile which had been carried wider by The Sword (J Maskiell). J Maskiell was reprimanded under AR137(a) careless riding and advised to exercise far greater care than he did on this occasion. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Gee Gee Born Free (T Baker) – Near the 1200 metres got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short period when being restrained. Passing the 200 metres brushed and carried wider by The Sword.

Shinvada (A Patis) – Over-raced in the early stages.

Ty's Missile (B Smith) – Lay in in the home straight. Near the 100 metres brushed and carried wider by The Sword. Rider B Smith explained that after beginning well the mare raced further forward today.

Je Ne Sais Quoi (R Bishop) – Passing the 800 metres changed stride and shifted out abruptly. Rider R Bishop reported the filly felt short in its action. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

RACE 3 – TRCHOBART.COM.AU MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

Apologize (M Ulucinar) – Slow into stride. Lay out throughout.

Iron Throne (B McCoull) – As the gelding has not raced since 23 April 2017, underwent a veterinary examination after arriving on course and passed suitable to race.

The Chisholm Trail (I Toker) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Passing the 800 metres when over-racing restrained off the heels of Dazzle Street.

Bullion Fringe (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride.

Life's A Poem (S Carr) – Commenced awkwardly.

Needs Amore (T Baker) – Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

Jayemara (B Smith) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Honky Tonk Girl (C Newitt) – Slow into stride.

RACE 4 – AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS CLASS 1 HCP – 1200 METRES

Silent Bid (B Muhcu) – Commenced awkwardly and lost ground. Near the 600 metres steadied off the heels of Geegees Cashcow which shifted out away from Remigny.

Thewordsout (J Maskiell) – Near the 600 metres steadied when improved up onto the heels of Remigny.

Silent Savings (C Newitt) – Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt stated that the gelding was one paced and failed to respond to his riding.

Geegees Cash Cow (T Voorham) – Passing the 600 metres shifted out slightly away from Remigny.

Gold Phoenix (T Baker) – Performed below expectations. Rider T Baker stated that the mare failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure.

Gee Gees Doubleyou (S Carr) – Eased down over the final 150 metres. Rider S Carr explained that the filly travelled well however after dipping near the 400 metres felt something amiss with the mare's action and elected to ease down over the final stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a short action in front and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.

Pontypaul (R Bishop) – Rider R Bishop was reprimanded under AR137A(5)(a)(i) for using his whip in consecutive strides on one occasion prior to the 100 metres.

RACE 5 – HOBART CUP FEB 10 BENCHMARK76 HCPBM76– 1400 METRES

Hugo (B Smith) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Passing the 900 metres when over-racing steadied off the heels of Sentry Duty and then raced wide without cover for the remainder.

Sentry Duty (R Bishop) – Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

Willby Rules (T Voorham) – Bumped heavily at the start with Go For It

Trusted Warrior (C Graham) – Shortly after the start steadied off the heels of Willby Rules which shifted out after bumping with Go For It. Rider C Graham stated that on pulling up he felt something amiss with the gelding and elected to dismount. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have injured its near fore tendon and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.

Orange River (S Carr) - Slipped behind on jumping away and lost ground (4L). Rider S Carr stated that after missing the start badly the mare failed to finish off. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Go for It (A Patis) – Bumped heavily at the start with Willby Rules. Performed below expectations. Rider A Patis stated that the gelding which was up in class today failed to respond when placed under pressure.

Qui Samer (B Muhcu) – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

RACE 6 – XMAS@THERACES DEC 14TH BENCHMARK80 HCP– 3200 METRES

Up Cups (T Voorham) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have blood present a both nostrils. Connections were advised of the provisions of AR53A(4) in that Up Cups may not be trained, exercised or galloped on any race-course for a period of two months and it may not start in any race for a period of three months and then only after a satisfactorily gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a steward. Trainer J Luttrell advised that the gelding will now be retired.

Doc Holliday (S Carr) – Rider S Carr pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on 9 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 4 more than permitted. S Carr was subsequently fined \$500. In determining penalty Stewards took into account S Carr's guilty plea, the context of the race, that it was a staying race, the totality of her whip use and that she won the race.

Really Sure (A Patis) – Slow into stride.

The Grey Crusader (S Amano) – Slow into stride.

RACE 7 – UNIQUE DOORS & WINDOWS GOODWOOD HCP – 1100 METRES

Lord da Vinci (S Carr) – Rider S Carr stated that after not beginning cleanly the gelding raced further back than intended.

Geeges Doublejay (J Maskiell) – Slow into stride.

Zatacla (I Toker) – Bounded in the air at the start and lost ground (3L). A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Teriki (B Smith) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Derasa (C Newitt) – Approaching the 100 metres steadied when momentarily held up for clear running. Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt explained that in his opinion the mare did not appreciate the shifty track surface today and felt a little awkward in its action. C Newitt was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out fully to the finish. Trainer B Campbell will be contacted in the coming days to see if any matter has arisen that may have affected its performance.

Scrutineer (B Muhcu) – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

RACE 8 – SCHWEPES CLASS 2 HCPC12– 1600 METRES

Invincible Rock (C Newitt) – Eased down over the concluding stages. Rider C Newitt stated that he felt something was amiss with the gelding and elected to not ride out over the final stages. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer S Carr will be contacted in the coming days to see if any matter has arisen which may have affected the gelding's performance.

Geegee Blackprince (J Maskiell) – Rider J Maskiell dropped his off side rein passing the 200 metres before regathering them shortly after shifting in and brushing with Miss Bluegrass.

Argillite (T Baker) – When questioned regarding the tactics adopted when racing off the rail when leading, rider T Baker explained that his instructions were to race one off the fence when leading as connections were of the view that this was the better part of the track. Co-trainer I Miller confirmed these instructions.

Hirvonen (S Amano) – Momentarily tightened for room between Miss Bluegrass and Paion which shifted out slightly.

Miss Bluegrass (I Toker) – Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres. Passing the 200 metres brushed with Geegee Blackprince.
