Comments / Explanations:

Steward's accepted the explanation of trainer J Blacker for the late notification of his rider in race 2.

RACE 1 – THE EXAMINER CLASS 1 HCP– 1420 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to Geegee Rock'n'Run being resaddled.

Heza Heart Throb (R Bishop) – Passing the 1100 metres got its head up when over-racing.

Geegee Rock'n'Run (J Maskiell) – Resaddled after arriving at the barrier which delayed the start. Shifted out on jumping away.

Heaven's Delight (B Muhcu) – Rider B Muhcu reported that his saddle slipped backward slightly shortly after jumping.

Nova Vista (C Newitt) – After being slightly slow to begin was then inconvenienced by Geegee Rock'n'Run which shifted out.

Breathtaking (A Darmanin) – Slow into stride (2L). Passing the 1100 metres inconvenienced and then commenced to over-race for a short period. Performed below expectations. Rider A Darmanin could offer no explanation for the performance other than the mare failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Mag Wheels (I Toker) - Commenced awkwardly. Passing the 1100 metres bumped by Saigon Princess and brushed the running rail. Momentarily held up on the later part of the home turn.

Saigon Princess (M Ulucinar) – Passing the 1100 metres commenced to over-race shifting in and bumping with Mag Wheels which brushed the running rail. Breathtaking which was following was inconvenienced and steadied.

Lady Wynette (T Baker) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 2 – NORWOOD NEWS & POST OFFICE MAIDEN – 1220 METRES

Cunning Fox (I Toker) – Rounding the home turn, appeared to be galloped on by Fiveandfurther which was being held up. Approaching the finish, brushed with Stinker. Stewards will follow up with trainer J Blacker in the coming days to see if any matter has arisen with the gelding.

I Am the Dude (T Baker) – Commenced awkwardly. Shortly after the start, got its head up when being restrained off the heels of Iowna (M Ulucinar) which shifted in despite the efforts of its rider. M Ulucinar was advised to exercise care. Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

Stinka (C Newitt) – Approaching the finish, brushed with Cunning Fox.

Fagin's Touch (B Muhcu) – At the start, bumped with Iowna.

Iowna (M Ulucinar) – At the start, bumped with Fagin's Touch. Shortly after the start, shifted in despite the efforts of its rider. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Near the 200 metres bumped and carried wider by Fiveandfurther (R Bishop), which shifted out to obtain clear running. R Bishop was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Miss Tylly (B Smith) – Shortly after the start was tightened for room by Iowna, which shifted in and then raced ungenerously for some distance, throwing its head in the air and losing ground.

Ochanda – Late scratching at 3:50pm due to no rider being available.

Ronny Zacapa (T Baker) – Appeared to be galloped on, rounding the home turn, by Fiveandfurther which was being held up. Stewards will follow up with trainer S Carr in the coming days to see if any matter has arisen.

Fiveandfurther (R Bishop) – Held up rounding the home turn behind Ronny Zacapa and Cunning Fox and appeared to contact the heels of both runners despite the efforts of its rider. Near the 200 metres shifted out to obtain clear running.

RACE 3 – CRESSY NEWSAGENCY & IGA EXPRESS BENCHMARK 76 HCP – 1220 METRES

Geegees Baritone (T Voorham) – Held up rounding the home turn. Momentarily held up nearing the 200 metres behind Galeocerdo which was weakening.

Silver Bolt (A Patis) – Shortly after the start shifted in. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

Geegees Brightstar (C Graham) – Shortly after the start, was restrained when tightened for room between Silver Bolt which shifted in and Apriano which was carried outward by Speed Force. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Speed Force (B McCoull) – Shifted out shortly after the start. Rounding the home turn, brushed with Apriano

Apriano (B Smith) – Shortly after the start, carried wider by Speed Force. Rounding the home turn, shifted out and brushed with Speed Force.

Gee Gee Lanett (S Carr) – Lay out in the home straight.

Pateena Arena (C Newitt) – After being slightly slow to begin was then inconvenienced by Gee Gee Lanett which shifted out slightly. Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt explained that he felt something amiss with the mare behind and elected not to ride out over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be suffering from cardiac arrhythmia and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again which must include the satisfactory results of an ECG following a 1000 metre gallop.

RACE 4 – DELORAINE NEWSAGENCY 3YO MAIDEN 3-Y-O. Mdn – 1120 METRES

Elton Court (C Graham) – Resaddled after arriving at the barrier.

Tambros Bobby (T Baker) – On jumping away bumped with Dunaway. Lay in in the home straight. Over the concluding stages when laying in, rider T Baker momentarily lost the use of his near side rein.

A Portrait (I Toker) – Commenced awkwardly. Over the concluding stages was carried inward by Tambros Bobby, which lay in.

A Tad More (A Darmanin) – Proved difficult to load, delaying the start. Warning issued.

Dunaway (A Patis) – Fractious in the barrier. Warning issued. On jumping away bumped with Tambros Bobby.

Flannie (B Muhcu) – Over raced in the early stages, throwing its head in the air. Raced greenly. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Miss Iso (S Carr) – Rider S Carr reported that the filly lay in throughout and proved difficult to ride out over the concluding stages.

RACE 5 – SHEFFIELD NEWSAGENCY BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 1620 METRES

Triple Strip (C Newitt) – Shifted in on jumping away and hampered Geegees Lillybet. Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt explained that in his opinion, the filly wasn't suited with tonight's weight of 58kg when racing against more seasoned horses. C Newitt added that the filly didn't appreciate racing tightly between runners and failed to quicken when placed under pressure from the 400 metres.

White Hawk (B Muhcu) – Rider B Muhcu explained that with the small field and the lack of early speed he was able to take up a more forward position with little effort.

Leconte (T Voorham) - Raced four wide without cover between the 1200 metres and 800 metres.

Geegees Lillybet (R Bishop) – Hampered on jumping away. Raced three wide without cover from the 1100 metres.

Quick Quill (S Carr) – Weakened over the concluding stages. Performed below expectations. Rider S Carr stated that the mare which had not raced for three weeks blew on pulling up, however added that she was disappointed with the performance. Stewards will follow up with train S Carr in the coming days to see if anything arises with the mare.

RACE 6 – THE EXAMINER CLASS 1 HCP – 1420 METRES

Arving (C Graham) – Performed below expectations. Rider C Graham stated that in his opinion the gelding failed to back up from its last performance on the 31st of October 2018.

Chloe's King (A Patis) – Slow into stride.

Copperhead Road (I Toker) – Change of tactics. Trainer advised will attempt to be ridden further forward. After commencing awkwardly, was ridden along and settled in a mid-field position. Near the 400 metres, was carried outward by He's Rushin (T Baker) which shifted out to obtain clear running before being corrected, as a result San You which was racing to the outside was inconvenienced out onto Aquietword. T Baker was reprimanded and advised to exercise far greater care than he did on this occasion.

Aquietword (J Maskiell) – Passing the 1200 metres got its head up when over racing. Passing the 400 metres bumped by San You.

He's Rushin' (T Baker) – Near the 1200 metres, steadied when momentarily tightened for room by Smack Talk (S Carr) which shifted in. S Carr was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

San You (M Ulucinar) – Passing the 400 metres inconvenienced and taken out onto Aquietword.

Voices (C Newitt) – Rider C Newitt reported that after beginning well he settled further forward than expected.

Special Moment (B McCoull) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the home straight.

White Gazelle (T Voorham) – Reared and was fractious in the barrier prior to the start. Warning issued. Held up from the 400 metres until obtaining clear running near the 100 metres.

Smack Talk (S Carr) – When questioned regarding the tactics adopted, rider S Carr stated that she had been given no firm instruction and after beginning well she elected to push forward. Trainer Miss M Ryan confirmed that she had not given rider S Carr any firm instructions, however did not expect the filly to be as far forward as it was tonight.

RACE 7 – PROSPECT MARKETPLACE NEWSAGENCY BENCHMARK 64 HCP– 1220 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to Sh'bourne Star having to be re saddled.

Gee Gee Queen Bee (S Carr) – Reared and was fractious in the barrier prior to the start. A warning was issued. Weakened for the 400 metres. Performed below expectations. When questioned rider S Carr stated that the filly, which was fractious prior to the start, over raced during the early and middle stages, however failed to respond to her ridding when placed under pressure and as she felt something was amiss, elected to not ride the mare out in the home straight. Ms Carr further added that she elected to race away from the rail when leading and she felt that this was the better part of the track. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to have a slow recovery and excessive mucus on auscultation and will require a Veterinary clearance prior to racing again.

Party Planner (A Patis) – Entering the home straight, momentarily held up behind the tiring Gee Gee Queen Bee and shifted wider on the track.

Sh'bourne Star (B McCoull) – Resaddled after arriving at the barrier which delayed the start.

Mulley's Idol (I Toker) – Commenced awkwardly.

Super Fun (C Newitt) – Failed to muster early speed.

RACE 8 – NEXTRA KINGS MEADOWS NEWS & LOTTO CLASS 3 HCP – 1420 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to Glory Blaze having to be resaddled.

Gone Girl (C Newitt) – Raced wide from the 800 metres.

Glory Blaze (B Muhcu) – Resaddled after arriving at the barrier which delayed the start. Performed below expectations. Rider B Muhcu stated that the gelding, which raced on the rail failed to handle tonight's track conditions.

Littlerayov (T Voorham) – Got its head up when over racing in the early stages.

Dothraki Princess (C Graham) – Change of tactics. Trainer advised will attempt to be ridden further forward. Led.

Geegees Gran Lodge (S Carr) – Raced wide from the 800 metres.
