### *Riding Changes / Jockey Information*

*Trainer Tegan Keys was fined \$200 for the late notification of a rider for **King Manu (NZ)** in Race 6.*

### RACE 1 – RAINE & HORNE KINGSTON MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS - 1200 METRES

The start of this race was delayed when **Joe Palooka** had to be withdrawn from its barrier stall and re-saddled behind the barriers.

**Apologize** (M Ulucinar) – Cast a near hind shoe and had to be re-shod in the mounting yard prior to the start of the race. Slow into stride. Rider M Ulucinar explained that the gelding laid out throughout the run. A post-race veterinary inspection of **Apologize** failed to reveal any abnormalities. A warning was issued on the gelding's race manner.

**Huontegz** (S Carr) – Rider S Carr reported that the gelding laid in throughout the run.

**Pincent Van Gogh (NZ)** (D Ganderton) – Rider D Ganderton explained that after racing in restricted room between the 200 – 100 metres, the gelding then failed to respond and on pulling up, made an abnormal respiratory noise. A post-race veterinary inspection of **Pincent Van Gogh (NZ)** failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Bullion Fringe** (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride.

**Ty's Missile** (B Smith (a)) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Approaching the 200 metres, restrained when momentarily tightened between **Joe Palooka** which shifted out slightly and **Miss Iso** which shifted in slightly.

**Miss Iso** (T Voorham (a)) – Commenced awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout.

**Shady Hustle** (R Bishop) – Held up from the 400 metres until obtaining clear running near the 100 metres.

**Verdancy** (S Amano) – Unable to obtain clear running over the final 100 metres and went to the finish not fully tested.

### **RACE 2 - RAINE & HORNE SORELL 2YO MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS - – 1000 METRES**

The start of this race was delayed several minutes due to a number of runners proving difficult to load and **Gee Gee Manpower** undergoing a veterinary inspection behind the barriers.

**Fitzwilliam** (T Voorham (a)) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Gee Gee Bay Watch** (C Graham (a)) – At the start, shifted in and bumped with **Maceyanna**. Raced greenly.

**Gee Gee Manpower** (G Catania) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after striking its hind legs on the barrier structure whilst being loaded, and was subsequently passed suitable to race.

**Gee Gees Punter** (R Bishop) – Near the 900 metres, restrained when tightened for room between **Gee Gee Manpower** and **Gee Gee Bay Watch** which was taken in slightly by **Gee Gee Double Hot** which was laying in.

**Man of the Moment** (D Ganderton) – Shortly after the start, steadied when tightened between **Gee Gee Double Hot** which shifted in and **Gee Gee Bay Watch**. Rider D Ganderton reported that the gelding race greenly.

**Banca Star** (T Baker) – Had to be re-saddled behind the barriers. Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

**Maceyanna** (B Muhcu) – Bumped and inconvenienced at the start by **Gee Gee Bay Watch** which shifted in. Rider B Muhcu stated that the filly did not appreciate the delay to the start and being in the barriers for longer than expected.

### **RACE 3 - RAINE & HORNE EASTERN SHORE CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES**

**Goodbye Lonesome** (B McCoull) – Rider B McCoull reported that the gelding felt awkward in its action. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Our Artie** (S Carr) – Approaching the 200 metres, had difficulty obtaining clear running behind **Party Planner** before shifting back to the inside of that mare and then racing tight for a short distance between **Party Planner** and **City of Dreams**.

**City of Dreams** (C Newitt) – Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt could offer no explanation for the disappointing performance today. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to be uneven behind. Trainer Adam Trinder was advised that he must tender a veterinary certificate of soundness before **City of Dreams'** next race start.

**Party Planner** (I Toker) – Performed below expectations today. Rider I Toker stated that he felt something may have been amiss with the mare's action. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer Graeme McCulloch advised that **Party Planner** would now be spelled.

**Levissi** (C Graham (a)) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Acronym** (T Baker) – Slightly fractious prior to the start. Shortly after the start, was restrained when tightened between **Levissi** and **Divi** which shifted out.

#### **RACE 4 TONY CARRICK 3YO VASE – NO CLAIMS - 1100 METRES**

**Gee Gee Queen Bee** (S Carr) – Rider S Carr explained that when leading, she raced away from the rail as in her opinion this was the better part of the track.

#### **RACE 5 - RAINE & HORNE HOBART BENCHMARK 70 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES**

**Agree To** (T Voorham (a)) – Raced three wide without cover from the 600 metres.

**Apriano** (A Patis (a)) – Commenced awkwardly and struck the outside of its barrier.

**Galeocerdo** (S Carr) – Commenced awkwardly and was slow into stride. Rider S Carr stated that the mare was not suited to being back in the field after missing the start and is better when able to be ridden forward.

**Tough Missile** (C Graham (a)) – Near the 700 metres, restrained when tightened for room by **Apriano** (A Patis (a)) which shifted in when not quite clear. Apprentice Patis was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

#### **RACE 6 – DIMENSION IV OPEN HANDICAP – 1400 METRES**

Correct weight was delayed when Jockey T Baker (**Geegees Goldengirl**) and the connections asked to view the official film. After doing so Jockey Baker was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

**Jerilderie Letter** (C Graham (a)) – After being slightly fraction in the barriers was then slow into stride. Rider C Graham explained that he had been instructed to ride the gelding mid-field. However, after being slow to begin, he then urged his mount along. The gelding then commenced to race keenly and he settled further forward than anticipated.

**Geegees Goldengirl** (T Baker) - Near the 1200 metres, inconvenienced and carried wider by **Minute Repeater** which commenced to over-race.

**Killin Falls** (I Toker) – Approaching the finish, had difficulty obtaining a clear run between **Century Arrow** which shifted out slightly and **Minute Repeater**. When questioned, Rider I Toker explained that approaching the 100 metres he had initially looked to take a run to the inside of **Century Arrow**. However, as he was of the view that **Century Arrow** had commenced to roll inwards, he then elected to attempt to take a run to the outside of that gelding. I Toker conceded that he would have been better suited to persevering with the run to the inside of **Century Arrow** as a clear run presented near the 100 metres. However, he had already committed to the outside of that gelding's heels.

**Geegees Baritone** (C Newitt) – Shortly after the start, restrained when tightened for room between **Killin Falls** and **Geegees Goldengirl**.

**Minute Repeater** (G Catania) – Slightly slow to begin. Near the 1200 metres, commenced to over-race and shifted out off the heels of **Century Arrow**, inconveniencing **Geegees Goldengirl** carrying it wider on the track and then continued to over-race for some distance.

**King Manu (NZ)** (S Carr) – Commenced awkwardly.

## **RACE 7 – HYPE TV CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES**

**The Greatness** (T Baker) – Near the 1000 metres, commenced to over-race when being restrained. Rider T Baker reported that the horse raced flat. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Wyuna** (R Bishop) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection behind the barrier and passed suitable to race.

**Quick Quill** (T Voorham (a)) – Connections advised that the mare will be ridden forward today due to the perceived lack of pace. After being slightly slow to begin, settled in a handy position. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer S Carr advised that the mare will now be sent for a spell.

## **RACE 8 – OPTIMUS HEALTH BRYAN ROBERTSON MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 2100 METRES**

**White Hawk** (B Muhcu) – Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

**Geegee Blackprince** (C Newitt) – Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt could offer no explanation for its disappointment performance today. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Argillite** (S Carr) – Performed below expectations. Rider S Carr reported that the mare failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure in the home straight.

**Geegees Lillybet** (R Bishop) – Near the 1900 metres, momentarily restrained away from the heels of **White Hawk** (B Muhcu) which shifted in when not quite clear. Rider B Muhcu was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

**Style Guru (NZ)** (A Patis (a)) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Near the 1700 metres restrained off the heels of **White Hawk** when the pace eased. Near the 1100 metres, commenced to over-race and shifted wider off the heels of **Gee Gee Lillybet** and was then allowed to stride forward three wide to sit outside the leader from the 600 metres.
