Comments / Explanations:

Trainer V Poke was reprimanded for the late notification of his rider in race 7. In not taking further action Stewards took into consideration Mr Pokes unblemished record regarding this rule.

RACE 1 – MARTIN COLLINS AUSTRALIA MAIDEN– 1400 METRES

Blackburn (B McCoull) – Performed below expectations. Rider B McCoull stated that the gelding wasn't suited by the slow tempo of the race and did not appreciate racing tightly between runners.

Cunning Fox (C Graham) – Held up for clear running rounding the home turn, before shifting wider near the 300 metres. Near the 100 metres shifted in under pressure and had to be straightened. Rider C Graham stated that the gelding which was racing in blinkers for the first time, was slightly slow to begin was unable to muster early pace. C Graham added that he had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn.

Master Da Vinci (R Bishop) – Commenced awkwardly. Near the 500 metres was inconvenienced by Doc Yule Do, which shifted in.

Zipponet (C Newitt) – Raced wide from the 700 metres.

Doc Yule Do (J Maskiell) – Inclined to lay in throughout and raced greenly.

Fagin's Touch (B Muhcu) – Approaching the 1200 metres, restrained away from the heels of Doc Yule Do.

Detention Miss (T Voorham) – Near the 300 metres, momentarily tightened for room between Fagin's Touch and Blackburn, which was taken out slightly by Cunning Fox (C Graham), which shifted out to obtain clear running. C Graham was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Fontein Ali (S Carr) – Rider S Carr explained that it had not been her instructions to lead, and to ride the mare mid field, however after beginning well and with the lack of early pace to her inside, she was able to take up the lead which was not her intention. Trainer C Thompson confirmed these instructions and was surprised to see the mare so far forward in the run.

Posh Pursuit (A Patis) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 2 – CHAFF CUTTER LONGFORD CUP 1ST JANUARY CLASS 1 HCP– 1200 METRES

Silent Bid (B Muhcu) – Commenced awkwardly. Over raced during the middle stages.

Swinley Forest (D Thornton) – Shortly after the start, steadied off the heels of Hatrick Hero. Rider D Thornton stated that the gelding was unable to muster early speed which left him further back in the field than intended. Trainer C Thompson reported that the gelding had been galloped on during the run. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a minor abrasion to the outside of the left fore cannon.

Hatrick Hero (T Voorham) – Bumped at the start.

Fiveandfurther (R Bishop) – Bumped at the start. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.

Geegees Cash Cow (S Carr) – Near the 300 metres, was restrained when momentarily tightened between Om Nom, which shifted out slightly away from the heels of Remigny (M Ulucinar) which shifted out slightly and Bunker Star, which shifted in slightly. M Ulucinar will be advised to exercise care when shifting ground. Approaching the 100 metres, steadied when tightened for room between Hatrick Hero, which lay in and Bunker Star.

Kwai (C Newitt) – Shifted out on jumping away, bumping with Bunker Star, which was carried out onto Fiveandfurther which in turn was carried out onto Hatrick Hero. As a result, Swinley Forest steadied off the heels of Hatrick Hero. Rider C Newitt explained that at its first race start on the 1st of July 2018, the filly was slow to begin and settled further back in that race than intended and tonight after being ridden along in the early stages when caught wide he was able to take up a forward position, which had been the intention at its first start. C Newitt further added that the filly raced greenly when leading.

Remigny (M Ulucinar) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running near the 100 metres. Shifted wider on the track carrying Blackberry Rose wider.

Miss Smith (A Patis) – Near the 800 metres, steadied off the heels of Kwai, when that filly eased the pace. From the 200 metres was unable to obtain clear running when disappointed when attempting a run where barely sufficient room to the inside of Kwai which shifted in slightly, and could not be fully tested to the finish.

Blackberry Rose (J Benbow) – Slow into stride. Had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn and in the early part of the home straight.

Bunker Star (C Graham) – Bumped at the start. Shortly after inconvenienced by Kwai which shifted out. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Om Nom (I Toker) – Incorrectly shown in the race book as wearing blinkers.

Track upgraded to a soft 5 following the running of this race.

RACE 3 – BETTA MILK 3YO MAIDEN– 1200 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when connections and A Darmanin (A Tad More) 2nd past the post, wished to view the official photo. After doing so, a developed print was requested. After viewing the developed print, Stewards were satisfied with the judge's placings and correct weight was declared.

Gee Gee Fiorente (C Newitt) – Commenced awkwardly. Shortly after the start, lay in, carrying Keiserinne in over the heels of Honky Tonk Girl. Passing the 200 metres lay inwards and had to be straightened. Raced greenly in the homes straight.

Highveld (D Thornton) – Bumped at the start with A Portrait. Near the 1000 metres, bumped with A Portrait. Approaching the 800 metres, restrained when momentarily tightened by Off The Show (S Amano), which lay in. S Amano was advised to exercise care when shifting ground. Tambro's Bobby and Needs Amore which were following had to restrain. Rider D Thornton stated that the gelding failed

to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Off The Show (S Amano) – Rider S Amano stated that the gelding lay in throughout. Raced four wide without cover throughout.

Ravage (J Maskiell) – Rider J Maskiell was reprimanded under AR137A(5)(a)(i) in that he used his whip in consecutive strides on one occasion prior to the 100 metres. J Maskiell pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres which is one more than permitted. J Maskiell was subsequently fined the sum of \$200. In determining penalty, Stewards took into account his guilty plea, his record and that he won the race.

Tambro's Bobby (T Baker) – Near the 800 metres steadied off the heels of Highveld.

A Portrait (I Toker) – Shifted out on jumping away and bumped with Highveld. Near the 1000 metres, bumped with Highveld and became slightly unbalanced. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Keiserinne (T Voorham) – Lay out rounding the home turn and shifted out abruptly. A warning has been placed on the filly. Rider T Voorham stated that the filly raced greenly and may benefit from the addition of blinkers.

Needs Amore (S Carr) – Near the 800 metres steadied off the heels of Tambro's Bobby. Rider S Carr stated that after being shuffled back in the middle stages she was placed further back in the field than anticipated.

RACE 4 – ELECTRO REWINDS MAIDEN/CL1– 2100 METRES

Kingsclere (C Newitt) – Raced three wide without cover in the early stages before being allowed to stride forward and sit outside the leader passing the 1600 metres.

Aquietword (D Thornton) – Raced in restricted room rounding the home turn. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the home straight.

He's Rushin' (J Maskiell) – Approaching the 150 metres, bumped by White Gazelle (B Muhcu) which shifted out to obtain clear running. B Muhcu was advised to exercise care when shifting ground

Roulette Star (T Baker) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Near the 400 metres steadied when momentarily tightened for room between Shivida (A Darmanin), which shifted in slightly and Aquietword which was taken out slightly by Style Guru, which in turn had been taken outward by White Gazelle (B Muhcu), which shifted out. A Darmanin and B Muhcu were advised to exercise care when shifting ground. Performed below expectations. Rider T Baker stated that mare was under pressure from the 600 metres and after receiving some minor interference rounding the home turn, it then failed to respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Style Guru (NZ) (J Benbow) – Approaching the 100 metres was disappointed for a run between Shivida and He's Rushin', which shifted out after bumping with White Gazelle.

Frisco Dame (A Patis) – Slow into stride (2L).

Pinkeyes Pride (T Voorham) – Late scratching at 8.10am on veterinary advice.

White Gazelle (B Muhcu) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running from the 400 metres until the 150 metres when shifted out, bumping with He's Rushin'.

RACE 5 – POLYTRACK TASMANIAN NEWMARKET– 1200METRES

I'm Wesley (B McCoull) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be showing signs of thumps.

Lord Da Vinci (J Maskiell) – Raced wide from the 600 metres. Performed below expectations. Rider J Maskiell stated that the gelding travelled well during the run, however failed to respond to his riding, when placed under pressure from the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Geegees Doublejay (A Darmanin) – Passing the 100 metres was tightened for room by Scrutineer (B Muchu), which shifted in to obtain clear running. B Muhcu was reprimanded under AR137(a), careless riding and advised to exercise far greater care than he did on this occasion.

Blaze Forth (J Benbow) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

O'Lonh Star (T Voorham) – Rider T Voorham reported that the buckle on her breast plate had come undone during the run.

Zatacla (I Toker) – Rider I Toker stated that the gelding would be better suited to distances greater than tonight's 1200 metres.

Liffeybeau (T Baker) – Approaching the 800 metres was restrained and tightened in onto Gee Gee Lanett, becoming unbalanced when I'm Wesley shifted in when not fully clear. Over the final 100 metres had difficulty obtaining clear running behind O'lohn Star

Gee Gee Lanett (S Carr) – Approaching the 800 metres was tightened for room and became unbalanced.

Scrutineer (B Muhcu) – Held up for clear running between the 200 metres and the 100 metres before shifting in.

B McCoull was found guilty of a charge under AR137(a) careless riding. The carelessness being that approaching the 800 metres, he permitted his munt to shift in when insufficiently clear of Liffeybeau, which had to be restrained and was tightened in onto Gee Gee Lanett, which became unbalanced. B McCoull had his licence to ride in races suspended for two Tasmanian race meetings, to commence midnight tonight 21 November 2018 and expire midnight 5 December 2018. In determining penalty Stewards took into account B McCoull's record and the incident was in the mid range.

RACE 6 – CRESSY CRICKET CLUB BENCHMARK 84 HCP– 1200 METRES

Chillout (C Newitt) – Near the 400 metres, shifted out off the heels of Happy Halloween.

Settler's Stone (D Thornton) – Bumped on jumping away by Amaword.

Amaword (S Carr) – Shifted out on jumping away and bumped with Settler's Stone.

RACE 7 – UNIQUE DOORS & WINDOWS CLASS 3 HCP– 1200 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to Bedrock Dreams proving difficult to load.

Silzoar (J Maskiell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Island Pirate (C Graham) – Bumped with Enzian at the start.

Enzian (C Newitt) – Bumped with Island Pirate at the start. On the latter part of the home turn, steadied to avoid the heels of Col's Hero. An inquiry has been adjourned into this incident.

Exclusive Saturday (I Toker) - Rider I Toker explained that his offside stirrup had broken on jumping away, placing him and his mount at a disadvantage throughout the run and he was unable to ride his mount out fully to the finish.

Katy Kat (R Bishop) – Rider R Bishop accidentally dropped his whip approaching the 200 metres.

Fish Bones Fry (S Amano) – Shortly after the start, tightened for room between Katy Kat and Island Pirate, which bumped with Enzian.

Palagia (J Benbow) – Over the concluding stages, had difficulty obtaining clear running and was unable to improve its position.

Jack's Choice (B Muhcu) – Approaching the 800 metres, brushed the running rail when racing tightly to the inside of Col's Hero.

Bedrock Dreams (A Patis) – Proved very difficult to load, delaying the start. A warning was placed on the mare and trainer R Hamer was advised that if the mare's loading manners do not improve further action will be taken.

Gee Gee Rich Ruby (A Darmanin) – Near the 800 metres restrained off the heels of Gee Gees Queenie (S Carr) which shifted in when not quite clear. S Carr will be advised to exercise care when shifting ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running to the inside of Exclusive Saturday between the 200 metres, until passing the 100 metres.

Col's Hero (T Voorham) – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

RACE 8 – STEVE'S LIQUOR BENCHMARK 76 HCP– 1600 METRES

Prior to correct weight, C Newitt (Axion), 4th past the post, lodged a protest against Hugo (B Smith), 2nd past the post, alleging interference near the 150 metres. It was established that near the 150 metres, Axion had established a run to the inside of Hugo, before that gelding shifted in, resulting in Axion having to be checked and losing its position. Stewards were of the view that the interference suffered outweighed the final margin at the finish of the race. The protest was upheld with the numbers amended accordingly.

Geegess Brightstar (C Graham) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near fore leg and a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing.

Willby Rules (J Maskiell) – Entering the home straight, shifted out and bumped with Jodi Nicole.

Axion (C Newitt) – Near the 150 metres was checked when tightened for room by Hugo, which shifted in when not clear.

Jodi Nicole (I Toker) – In the early part of the home straight, bumped by Willby Rules. Eased down over the concluding stages. Rider I Toker stated that after being bumped in the early part of the home straight the mare felt short in her action and he elected not to ride out over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a slightly short action behind and a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again.

Datuk Zadragon (J Benbow) – On the latter part of the home turn, was restrained when attempting a tight run between Secrets She Has, which shifted out slightly away from the heels of Willby Rules (J Maskiell) and Gee Gees Brightstar which shifted in slightly. J Maskiell was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

B Smith pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(a) careless riding. The carelessness being that near the 150 metres she permitted her mount to shift in, when insufficiently clear of Axion which had to be checked and lose its rightful running. B Smith had her licence to ride in races suspended for one Tasmanian race meeting to commence midnight 28 November 2018 and expire midnight 5 December 2018. In determining penalty Stewards took into account B Smith's guilty plea, her good record and that the incident was in the mid range.

RACE 9 – KEVIN SHARKIE BENCHMARK 64 HCP– 1400 METRES

Triple Strip (C Newitt) – Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt could offer no explanation, other than the filly failed to respond to his riding throughout the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to have reduced lung sounds in the left lung and a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again which must include the satisfactory results of an endoscopic examination.

Dothraki Princess (C Graham) – Performed below expectations. Rider C Graham could offer no explanation for the disappointing performance. Stewards will follow up with trainer A Trinder in the coming days to see if any matter has arisen that may have affected the mares performance.

The Rockbank Flash (A Patis) – Raced keenly in the early stages when racing wide without cover to the 1100 metres. Performed below expectations. Rider A Patis could offer no explanation for the disappointing performance. Subsequent to the race meeting Trainer V Poke advised that the mare had struck herself during the race, however had pulled up well.
