Comments / Explanations:

The explanation of Trainer's T Keys and M Trinder was accepted for the late notification of their riders in race 5.

RACE 1 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP NEW YEAR'S DAY 2YO MAIDEN– 1100 METRES

Fitzwilliam (S Carr) – Performed below expectations. Rider S Carr could offer no explanation for the disappointing performance. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Gee Gees Punter (B McCoull) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Raced keenly during the middle stages. Rider B McCoull reported that the gelding raced greenly. Stewards will inquire into the whip use of rider B McCoull.

Gee Gees Bay Watch (C Newitt) – Approaching the winning post had to be retrained when tightened for room by Gee Gees Punter (B McCoull), which shifted in under pressure before being corrected. B McCoull was advised to exercise care when permitting his mounts to shift ground.

Gee Gee Manpower (G Catania) – Proved difficult to load, delaying the start. The gelding must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again. Rider G Catania stated that when the pace quickened from the 500 metres, the gelding was left flat footed. Trainer Mr S Gandy advised that the gelding will now be spelled.

Mystical Pursuit (C Graham) – Commenced awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Had difficulty obtaining clear running between the 300 metres and 200 metres. Rider C Graham reported that the gelding raced keenly during the middle stages and was placed awkwardly on heels.

Speed Angel (I Toker) – Slow into stride.

Maceyanna (B Muhcu) – Commenced awkwardly. After pulling up distressed following the race underwent a veterinary examination which revealed the filly to have recovered satisfactory and no abnormalities were detected.

Trainer S Gandy was fined \$50 for presenting his runners late into the mounting yard.

RACE 2 – PFD SERVICES MAIDEN– 1400 METRES

Cunning Fox (C Newitt) – Rider C Newitt explained that as the gelding has been slowly away recently, and after being loaded into its barrier it then stood toward the back of the barrier and as such he was endeavouring to encourage his mount to come forward. Trainer J Blacker explained that he had instructed rider C Newitt to be positive at the start in an attempt to have the gelding begin better. J Blacker added that given the early pace of other runners the gelding settled slightly further forward than he expected. Rider C Newitt was spoken to advisedly regarding the use of his whip prior to the horse being loaded into the barriers and the manner in which attempted to move the horse forward when in its starting stall.

The Name's Bond (I Toker) – As the gelding had not raced since the 25th of January 2017, underwent a veterinary examination after arriving on course and passed suitable to race. Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race. Tailed off from the 400 metres. Connections advised that they would not be continuing on with the gelding. The gelding must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing again. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities

Off The Show (R Bishop) – Rider R Bishop reported that the gelding raced greenly.

Luvahussy (T Voorham) – Over raced in the early stages when racing wide without cover.

A Portrait (W Costin) – On jumping away, was tightened for room between Digger's Girl, which shifted out and Luvahussy. Shortly after, was bumped by Digger's Girl which continued to shift out. Approaching the 400 metres, held up and steadied off the heels of The Name's Bond, which was giving ground.

Digger's Girl (T Baker) – Shifted out after the start and bumped with A Portrait on a number of occasions.

RACE 3 – KEVIN SHARKUE BENCHMARK 58 HCP– 1200 METRES

Forever Alone (S Carr) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Approaching the 800 metres, steadied when tightened for room by Flikpix, (A Patis), which shifted in when not quite clear. A Patis was reprimanded and advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

Kenfromthebar (B McCoull) – Commenced awkwardly, shifted out bumping with Flikpix. Raced wide without cover in the early stages, before obtaining the lead passing the 800 metres.

Col's Hero (T Voorham) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Piped Abroad (R Bishop) – Commenced awkwardly.

Flikpix (A Patis) – Bumped at the start by Kenfromthebar.

Bedrock Dreams (T Baker) – Proved difficult to load, delaying the start. The mare must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

Orphanli (C Newitt) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 4 – JANSZ CORPORATE MARQUEE LAUNCESTON CUP DAY BENCHMARK 58 HCP–1600METRES

Voices (A Patis) – Shifted out at the start and bumped with Reann's Diamond. Over raced in the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.

Wyuna (T Voorham) – Harmlessly dislodged rider T Voorham on route to the barriers. Galloped free for some distance before being re captured. Underwent a veterinary examination at the barriers and passed suitable to race.

Geegees Lillybet (B McCoull) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the home straight.

Super Leane (S Amano) – Raced wide in the early stages.

Mag Wheels (C Newitt) – Change of tactics. Trainer advised will attempt to be ridden further back. Trainer J Blacker was reminded of his obligations to ensure he notifies any change of tactics no later than 30 minutes prior to race time. Settled towards the rear of the field.

Beenagem (S Carr) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn and in the early part of the home straight.

Reann's Diamond (W Costin) – Bumped at the start with Voices. Passing the 100 metres, steadied off the heels of Thanos, when attempting a run to the inside of that gelding.

Berry Wise Fox (T Baker) – Held up for clear running rounding the home turn.

RACE 5 – MCCRIMMON INSURANCE CONQUERING STAKES – 1400 METRES

Kenjorwood (T Baker) – Rider T Baker explained that after being slow to muster early speed, the gelding settled further back than intended.

I'm Wesley (B McCoull) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be showing signs of thumps.

Quick Difference (C Newitt) – Slow into stride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have jarred up slightly.

Geegees DoubleJay (R Bishop) – Rider R Bishop stated that the gelding over raced in the early stages and was left flat footed when the pace quickened from the 500 metres.

Lord Da Vinci (T Voorham) – Ride T Voorham explained that her instructions were to ride the gelding positively from the barriers and after being caught wide early, she allowed it then to stride forward. Trainer S Brunton confirmed these instructions and advised at its most recent start on 21 November 2018 the gelding was placed further back than intended after being caught wide for the entire race. S Brunton added that when the gelding raced 6 November 2018 in Hobart it was beaten for speed in the early stages over 1100 metres from the wide draw and big weight.

Jerilderie Letter (A Darmanin) – Performed below expectations. Rider A Darmanin explained that the gelding was off the bit for the entire race and felt awkward in its action. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer A Trinder will be contacted in the coming days to see if any matter has arisen which may have affected its performance.

Blaze Forth (I Toker) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Beaufort Lad (C Graham) – Near the 50 metres was accidentally struck across the nose by the whip of B Muhcu (Scrutineer), when racing tightly between that mare and Blaze Forth

Zatacla (W Costin) – Raced wide from the 800 metres.

Toorak Affair (S Amano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout

RACE 6 – FINANCE BROKERS OF TASMANIA MAIDEN– 1100 METRES

Holy Diamond (A Darmanin) – Bumped at the start with Need A Bella. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

The Chisholm Trail (W Costin) – Lay out rounding the home turn and in the home straight. Over the concluding stages when laying out, had difficulty obtaining clear running to the inside of Queen's Needs, which was laying in under pressure. Rider W Costin stated that the gelding lay out and proved difficult to ride in the home straight.

Those Red Colours (R Bishop) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider R Bishop pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(b) for failing to ride his mount out fully to the finish. R Bishop was subsequently fined \$150

Watch My Shadow (B Smith) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Runaway Girl (T Voorham) – Late scratching at 9.31pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in the barrier and getting its head under the front of the gates. Prior to the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered all monies invested on Runaway Girl to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 9.31pm pm were to be paid less 9 cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less 10 cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket. The mare must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again

Flourishing Future (A Patis) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Momentarily held up for clear running passing the 200 metres. Rider A Patis stated that the filly raced greenly.

Need A Bella (I Toker) – Bumped at the start with Holy Diamond. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages. Rider I Toker will be advised to exercise care and straighten his mounts when permitting them to shift ground.

Queen's Needs (S Carr) – Lay in in the home straight. Rider S Carr reported that the filly raced greenly.

RACE 7 – LEGER LAWN MARQUEE LAUNCESTON CUP DAY BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 2100 METRES

Rougeau (B McCoull) – Performed below expectations. Rider B McCoull stated that he felt something may have been amiss with the gelding's action. Trainer G Stevenson will be contacted in the coming days to see if any matter has arisen with gelding which may have affected its performance.

Geegee Blackprince (A Darmanin) – Raced wide without cover from the 800 metres.

Roulette Star (A Patis) – Over raced in the early and middle stages when leading. Performed below expectations. Rider A Patis could offer no explanation for the performance other than the mare may not have been suited by a quick back up after racing on the 7th of December 2018.
