Jockey Mehmet Ulucinar was reprimanded under AR 91 for arriving late on course today for his riding engagements.

Jockey Anthony Darmanin was fined \$200 under AR 160(B)(3) for having a mobile phone in the Jockeys' Room.

RACE 1 – AUSTRALIAN TRAINERS' ASSOCIATION MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

Apologize (M Ulucinar) – Slow into stride.

Sir Simon (S Carr) – Rider S Carr reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout. Had to be steadied off heels approaching the home turn and then had difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight.

Words of Pride (R Bishop) – Slow into stride. Raced three wide from the 800 metres to the 450 metres.

RACE 2 – trchobart.com.au CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Ilfracombe (T Voorham (a)) – Approaching the 400 metres had to be steadied away from the heels of **Swing It Sister** (T Baker) which shifted out when not quite clear. Rider T Baker was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Swing It Sister (T Baker) – Held up for a clear run over the concluding stages. Over the final 100 metres, had to be restrained to avoid the heels of **Remigny** (M Ulucinar). Rider M Ulucinar was issued with a reprimand under AR 137(a) careless riding for shifting ground outwards when insufficiently clear.

Remigny (M Ulucinar) – Raced three wide for a major part of the home straight before tiring and shifting ground over the concluding stages.

Odessa lad (B Muhcu) – Rider B Muhcu reported that the gelding was not suited to today's firmer track conditions.

RACE 3 – AVISO TAS PINK CUP – JAN 11TH – CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Street Tough (C Newitt) – Jumped awkwardly and was then slow into stride. Rider C Newitt explained that after commencing awkwardly, he had to work hard in the early stages to obtain a forward position. C Newitt further added that the gelding did not travel comfortably through the run and in his opinion, may appreciate a track with more give. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

West on Broadway (S Carr) – Over-raced in the middle stages.

Christopher Mac (B Muhcu) – Stood flat-footed and was then slow into stride (3– 4 L). The connections were advised that the gelding must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

Kepta (M Ulucinar) – Slow into stride.

Acronym (T Baker) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 4 – TAB HOBART CUP - FEB 10TH MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – 1600 METRES

Kandahar (R Bishop) – Upon entering the home straight, eased to avoid the heels of **Heaven's Venture**.

Lord Derby (S Amano) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Stewards questioned Rider S Amano regarding the tactics adopted on **Lord Derby**, regarding contesting the lead in the early and middle stages of the race, which resulted in both **Lord Derby** and **Lady Wynette** leading the main body of the field by a considerable margin. S Amano explained that his instructions were to go forward and race handy. However, due to the racing manners, the horse commenced to over-race and carry its head high and he was unable to settle his mount. Stewards confirmed these instructions with Trainer Brendan McShane. Stewards advised S Amano to show more initiative in future.

Fontein Ali (A Darmanin) – Near the 200 metres, eased to avoid the heels of **The Sword**.

Lady Wynette (G Catania) – Stewards questioned Rider G Catania regarding the riding instructions and tactics adopted on **Lady Wynette**, regarding contesting the lead in the early and middle stages of the race, which resulted in both **Lady Wynette** and **Lord Derby** leading the main body of the field by a considerable margin. G Catania stated that she was instructed to lead and allow the mare to roll along, however Ms Catania also stated that she was expecting S Amano to ease the pace. Stewards confirmed these instructions with Trainer Terence Evans. Stewards advised G Catania to show more initiative in future.

Style Guru (NZ) (M Ulucinar) – A post-race veterinary inspection, revealed the gelding to have a laceration to its off-hind cannon above the fetlock on the lateral side.

Heaven's Venture (B Muhcu) – A post-race veterinary inspection, revealed the gelding to have an abrasion on its medial pastern off hind leg.

Pinkeyes Pride (I Toker) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 5 – SCHWEPPE'S DERBY DAY - FEB 8TH BM72 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

Speed Force (B McCoull) – Hung out over the concluding stages and shifted wider on the track.

Gone Girl (T Voorham (a)) – Held up momentarily for a clear run at approximately the 450 metres.

Don Pellegrino (S Carr) – late scratching at 4.00 pm acting on veterinary advice after lashing out and striking the barriers. Prior to the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered all monies invested on **Don Pellegrino** to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 4.00 pm were to be paid less seven cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less eight cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket. The connections were advised that they must tender a veterinary certificate of soundness prior to **Don Pellegrino's** next start.

Westwood (C Graham (a)) - Tightened on jumping between **Manilenya** which shifted out and **Heaven's Delight** which shifted in.

Really Sure (T Baker) – Raced three wide without cover between the 900 metres and 450 metres. Rider T Baker accidentally dropped his whip near the 450 met

RACE 6 – BETTLE BLACK MEDIA OPEN HANDICAP – 1000 METRES

Gee Gee Lanett (S Carr) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Teriki (I Toker) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and passed fit to take its place in the field after not travelling well in the float en route to the race-course. Slow into stride. Held up at approximately the 450 metres. Over the final 100 metres, laid in over the heels of **Gee Gee Lanett**.

Tough Missile (C Graham (a)) – Tightened for room at the start between **Apriano** and **Gee Gee Lanett** which jumped outwards. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Galeocerdo (A Patis (a)) – Slow into stride. Over-raced in the early stages.

RACE 7 – CAMBRIDGE SELF STORAGE BM72 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Silver Bolt (C Graham (a)) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Shot of Irish (T Voorham (a)) – Laid in in the home straight. Rider T Voorham had to stop riding and straighten her mount.

Pateena Arena (C Newitt) – Slow into stride. Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt reported that, in his opinion, the mare was not suited to the firmer track conditions today. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to have a slow to recover heart rate.

Bosporus (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride.

Ivoryman (NZ) (T Baker) – Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres to the 500 metres.

Boart (A Darmanin) – Rider A Darmanin reported that the gelding did not handle today's firmer track conditions.

Paion (S Carr) - Slow into stride. Inconvenienced at the start when **Go for It** jumped outwards and **Ivoryman (NZ)** jumped inwards.

RACE 8 – HAZELL BROS CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Silent Bid (C Newitt) – Began awkwardly and shortly after the start was inconvenienced by **Fontein Harry** which jumped outwards. Soon after got its head up and over-raced and had to be restrained off heels and continued to over-race middle stages of the event. Held up rounding the home turn. Disappointed for a run at approximately the 200 metres to the inside of **His Nibs** which shifted in.

His Nibs (T Voorham (a)) - Apprentice Teagan Voorham pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR 137(a) in that at approximately the 400 metres she allowed her mount to shift out when insufficiently clear and as a result rider Craig Newitt (**Silent Bid**) who was improving to the outside of His Nibs (T Voorham (a)) had to check his mount and lost his position. Apprentice Voorham's licence to ride in races was suspended for one (1) Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight tonight and to expire at midnight on Wednesday, 19 December 2018. When assessing penalty stewards took into account Ms Voorham's guilty plea, her record in relation to this rule and stewards deemed the interference to be in the mid-range. Apprentice Teagan Voorham was reprimanded under AR 137(a) for allowing her mount to shift in at the 200m when C Newitt was disappointed for a clear run to the inside of Ms Voorham.

Bless Me Father (S Amano) – Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages. Had a tendency to over-race in the early and middle stages.

Hatrick Hero (A Darmanin) – Performed below expectations. Rider A Darmanin stated that the gelding travelled well, however, failed to respond to his riding in the home straight. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to have a slow to recovery rate.

Knitting (G Catania) – Raced four wide without cover in the middle stages.
