Comments / Explanations:

Apprentice S Kok was incorrectly shown in the race book as being a 0kg claiming apprentice when in actual fact he is a 3kg claiming apprentice.

RACE 1 – PURCHASE YOUR LAUNCESTON CLUP TICKETS ONLINE NOW MAIDEN 3YO & UP–1200 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to Saint Laura being reluctant to make its way to the barrier and Poolside Hendrick dislodging its rider, with both horses requiring assistance to the start.

Kentan (A Patis) – Raced wide throughout. Rounding the home turn, lay inwards, having to be steadied off the heels of Fagin's Touch.

Needs A Scotch (A Darmanin) – Raced three wide without cover until the 800 metres. Performed below expectations. Rider A Darmanin explained that after beginning from a wide barrier and racing wide in the early stages to take up a forward position the horse then failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure.

Poolside Hendrick (S Amano) – Harmlessly dislodged rider S Amano on route to the barrier. Bumped at the start. Performed poorly. Rider S Amano stated that the gelding hung in quite badly from the 1000 metres and proved very difficult to ride. S Amano added that his saddle also slipped, which placed him at a disadvantage. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. The gelding must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

Fagin's Touch (I Toker) – Shifted out on jumping away, bumping with Jeremiah, which was taken out onto Poolside Hendrick. Shortly after, had to be steadied when tightened for room between Jeremiah and Secret Gold which shifted out. Momentarily held up for clear running rounding the home turn.

Jeremiah (T Baker) – On jumping, bumped with Fagin's Touch. Lay out in the home straight. Rider T Baker stated that the gelding raced greenly. T Baker was advised to exercise care when shifting ground and ensure he straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

Princess Of York (D Ganderton) – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn. Rider D Ganderton reported that the mare lay out rounding the home turn.

Life's a Poem (S Carr) – Fractious in the barrier. Warning issued. Rider S Carr stated that after being fractious in the barrier, the filly over-raced in the early and middle stages which was detrimental to its performance today. Trainer S Brunton advised the filly would now go for a let up.

Secret Gold (C Graham) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn and in the early part of the home straight.

Saint Laura (E Kackmaz) - Rider E Kackmaz stated that the mare after beginning awkwardly raced greenly in the early and middle stages.

Gee Gee Runaway (S Kok) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn and in the early part of the home straight.

RACE 2 – FASHION FOR FILLIES SUNDAY 24TH FEBURARY MAIDEN 3YO & UP – 1600 METRES

Tuki Tuki (M Ulucinar) – Slow into stride. Near the 400 metres was inconvenienced by Dunaway (E Kacmaz), which shifted in when not fully clear. E Kacmaz was reprimanded. On the latter part of the home turn, momentarily held up for clear running behind Dunaway.

Zipponet (C Newitt) – Shortly after the start, Steadied off the heels of Furrenzy, which had been taken outwards by Miss Bomber Belle. Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt could offer no explanation for the performance.

Trumpcash (S Amano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

C'est Bon (T Baker) – Rider T Baker explained that it had not been his intention to lead, however after being caught wide and with no early pace to runners on his inside, he elected to allow his mount to stride forward.

Furrenzy (W Costin) – Bumped at the start with Miss Bomber Belle and shifted out.

Miss Bomber Belle (A Patis) – Bumped at the start with Furrenzy.

Rodessa (C Graham) – Raced four wide without cover in the early and middle stages before obtaining cover approaching the 800 metres.

Dunaway (R Kacmaz) – Shifted in under pressure near the 400 metres.

Geegees Rock Opera (S Kok) – Performed below expectations. Rider S Kok stated that the filly failed to respond to his ridding when placed under pressure from the 500 metres. Inclined to lay out rounding the home turn. Rider S Kok was severely reprimanded under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on 11 occasions prior to the 100 metres. In not taking more severe actions Stewards took into account the totality of his whip use and gave concession as this was S Kok's second race ride in Tasmania.

Glass Warrior (B Mahcu) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn.

RACE 3 – TREVALLYN CRICKET CLUB BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 1400 METRES

Invincible Rock (S Carr) – Lay in in the home straight resulting in rider S Carr being unable to ride the gelding out in her normal manner.

One Way Ticket (C Graham) – Harmlessly dislodged rider C Graham on route to the barrier.

Son Of Faith (D Ganderton) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Super Fun (A Darmanin) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the presence of blood at both nostrils. Connections were advised of the provisions of AR53A(4) in that Super Fun may not be trained, exercised or galloped on any race-course for a period of two months and it may not start in any race for a period of three months and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a steward.

Sh'bourne Star (C Newitt) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Inclined to lay out. Near the 800 metres, steadied when racing tightly to the inside of Son Of Faith, which shifted in slightly, away from Invincible Rock, which in turn had shifted in slightly away from Flying Geepee (E Kacmaz), which was racing keenly and shifted in. E Kacmaz was advised to exercise care when permitting his mounts to shift ground. Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt stated that the mare over raced in the early and middle stages when not suited to racing inside other runners. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Flying Geepee (E Kacmaz) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Raced four wide without cover throughout.

Westwood (M Ulucinar) – Slow into stride.

Mulley's Idol (W Costin) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 4 – GYPSY ROSE IN THE LAZY LOUNGE LAUNCESTON CUP DAY CLASS 1 HCP– 1200 METRES

Shenanigator (R Bishop) – Slow into stride. Approaching the 100 metres, was momentarily held up for clear running behind Silver Road.

Stinka (A Darmanin) – Approaching the winning post, steadied when tightened for room and unable to improve between Emsgem and Silver Road (C Graham), which shifted in under pressure. C Graham was reprimanded.

Uncovered (I Toker) – Performed below expectations. Rider I Toker stated the mare would be better suited over a further distance than tonight's 1200 metres. Trainer Mr P Luttrell stated that the mare has no first up form and would also be suited over a further distance.

Silver Road (C Graham) – Rider C Graham explained that the gelding was unable to muster early pace at its previous starts and with the addition of blinkers and the small field was positioned further forward.

RACE 5 – JANSZ 3YO TROPHY – 1400 METRES

Tiesto (W Costin) – On jumping away, checked when tightened between, The Inevitable and Blackberry Rose, which had been inconvenienced and taken inward by Gee Gee Secondover, which shifted in away from Gee Gee Wynette, which jumped inwards. Near the 1200 metres, commenced to over race and restrained off the heels of Our Long Sali. On the latter part of the home turn, carried wider by Blackberry Rose which lay out, and bumped with Appraise.

Gee Gee Secondover (C Newitt) – On jumping away, shifted in away from Gee Gee Wynette.

Cape Cardinal (A Patis) – Fractious in the barrier. Warning issued. Shifted out on jumping away.

Appraise (B McCoull) – On the latter part of the home turn, bumped by Tiesto.

Bullion Fringe (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride.

Our Long Sali (A Darmanin) – Held up for clear running rounding the home turn.

Gee Gee Wynett (D Ganderton) – Fractious in the barrier. Warning issued. Raced three wide without cover in the early stages, before racing outside the leader from the 1000 metres. Over raced during the middle stages. On the latter part of the home turn, lay out and steadied when racing tightly between The Inevitable and Cape Cardinal which shifted out marginally. Lay out rounding the home turn and the home straight.

Blackberry Rose (I Toker) – Inconvenienced shortly after the start by Gee Gee Secondover, which had been taken inward by Gee Gee Wynette. Lay out rounding the home turn.

RACE 6 – THE ULTIMATE SPORTING CLUB CHALLENGE 16TH JANUARY BECNHMARK 58 HCP – 1600 METRES

Fish Bones Fry (A Patis) – Rider A Patis stated that the gelding laid out throughout.

Pegalia (C Newitt) – Slow into stride

Geegees Gran Lodge (S Kok) – Near the 1400m steadied away from the heels of Savrajette (B Muhcu) which shifted in away from Om Nom. B Muhcu was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Little Pumba (W Costin) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Performed below expectations. Rider W Costin stated that after racing wide the gelding failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure.

Savrajette (B Muhcu) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Held up from clear running from the 400m until obtaining clear running to the inside of Fish Bones Fry approaching the 100m.

Beenagem (S Carr) – After becoming extremely fractious in the barrier was declared a late scratching at 9.31 pm on veterinary advice. The mare must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

Cranny Flyer (C Graham) – Commenced awkwardly and was slow into stride. Passing the 100m when making ground steadied off the heels of Berry Wise Fox.

RACE 7 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP NEW YEAR'S DAY BECNHMARK 76 HCP – 2100 METRES

Bidirectional (A Darmanin) – Slow into stride

Hugo (B Smith) – Over-raced during the middle stages. Approaching the 100m when racing tightly to the outside of White Hawk, brushed with that gelding and was taken up the track slightly before having to be restrained when tightened for room by Bidirectional (A Darmanin) which shifted in under pressure. A Darmanin was severely reprimanded and advised to ensure he make more effort to straighten his mounts.

White Hawk (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride

Perun (C Graham) – Got its head up in the early stages when being restrained. Had difficulty obtaining clear running between the 200m and 100m.

King Manu – Raced keenly in the early stages.
