Comments / Explanations:

All riders at today's meeting were breath tested before riding.

Trainer S Brunton was fined \$50 for the late rider declaration for Needs Amore in Race 1.

Stewards accepted the explanation for rider B Smith to be excused from today's meeting

RACE 1 – INCITEC PIVOT MAIDEN– 1400 METRES

Cunning Fox (C Newitt) – Slow into stride.

Real Acclaim (R Bishop) – Eased down over the concluding stages. When questioned, rider R Bishop stated that the gelding felt awkward in its action and did not travel at any stage throughout the event. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the left foreleg. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required before racing again.

lowna (E Kacmaz) – Commenced to over race near the 1000 metre mark.

Shinvida (A Patis) – Caught three wide throughout.

Needs Amore (T Baker) – Lay in in the home straight.

Post-race swab sample was taken from the winner of the event, Cunning Fox.

RACE 2 – T.A BRICKNELL BENCHMARK 64 HCP– 1400 METRES

Apriano (S Kok) – Led the event, compounded over the concluding stages. When questioned rider S Kok stated that after leading his mount had tired over the concluding stages.

Concentrate (C Graham) – Jumped awkwardly and lost ground. Held up on the home turn. Dipped in running on the home turn. Held up for a clear run approaching the 150 metre mark.

Go For It (A Patis) - Re-saddled behind barriers prior to start.

Balestrand (NZ) (E Kacmaz) – Raced three wide without cover.

RACE 3 – ARMIDAL STUD BENCHMARK 58 HCP– 1400 METRES

Katy Kat (T Voorham) – Raced 3 and 4 wide from the 800 metres.

Pelagia (S Kok) – Slow into stride.

Gee Gees Wild One (A Patis) – Over raced near the 1000 meter mark. Steadied off heels of Forever Alone nearing the 900 meters. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Hirvonen (R Bishop) – Dipped on a number of occasions approaching the 700 metre mark. Rider R Bishop reported that the gelding didn't handle today's track conditions.

RACE 4 – QUEENS ARMS HOTEL BENCHMARK 58 HCP– 1400 METRES

Prior to correct weight rider Erhan Kacmaz (Flying Geepee), fourth place getter wished to view the official patrol films of the home straight. After doing so lodged a protest against Arving (S Kok), second place getter alleging interference approaching the 50m. On the evidence it was established that Flying Geepee (E Kacmaz) had shied away from the whip and stewards weren't satisfied that there was any contact made and the protest was dismissed and any interference suffered outweighed the margin at the end of the race.

Stewards inquired into the reasons why Flying Geepee (E Kacmaz) checked and appeared to clip heels at about the 1000m, after taking evidence from C Newitt (Breathtaking), T. Voorham (Flikpix), C Graham (Mulleys Idol), E Kacmaz (Flying Geepee) and S Carr (Global Princess) stewards were unable to attribute the blame to any one rider. However all riders were reminded of their obligations when shifting ground.

Global Princess (S Carr) - Rider S Carr reported that the mare had hung out throughout the event.

RACE 5 – SUES OF INVERMAY MDN/CL1– 1800 METRES

He's Rushin' (C Newitt) – Raced three wide early.

Pinkeyes Pride (E Kacmaz) – Bumped on jumping with Smack Talk. Lay in and steadied off the heels of Smack Talk. Made the crossing at the 1400 metres awkwardly.

Glass Warrior (C Graham) – Slow into stride.

Smack Talk (R Bishop) – Bumped on jumping with Pinkeyes Pride. Lay out approaching the winning post on the first occasion. Rider R Bishop reported that Smack Talk did not handle today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Akbar Jay (A Patis) – Raced three wide throughout.

RACE 6 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP– 1800 METRES

The all clear was delayed in this race when connections and rider S Carr wished to view the official photo finish. After viewing correct weight was given.

Geegees Goldengirl (S Carr) – Over raced after being restrained at the 1400 metre mark.

Zatacla (C Newitt) – Threw head in the air when jumping. Over raced at the 1200 meters.

Secrets She Has (T Voorham) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after throwing itself down behind the barriers. Passed fit to run. Stewards placed a warning on its pre-race manners. Slow to begin. Over raced at the 1400 metre mark.

Sentry Duty (S Kok) – Shifted in under pressure in the home straight and over the concluding stages.

Ivoryman (NZ) (T Baker) – Over raced in early and middle stages.

Mister Marmalade (E Kacmaz) – Raced three wide from the 1000 metres.

King Manu (NZ) – (R Bishop) – Stewards gave permission for rider R Bishop to ride 1kg over the allocated weight. Slow to begin.

Jodi Nicole (I Toker) lost a near fore shoe in the run.

RACE 7 – TASMANIAN LIVESTOCK SERVICES BENCHMARK 58– 1800 METRES

The start of race 7 was delayed 1 minute when Don Pellegrino proved difficult to load.

Don Pellegrino (C Graham) – Warning on barrier manners continued. Tightened on jumping. Lost ground.

Monmouth (I Toker) – Tightened on jumping. Lost ground. Reminded of obligations when shifting ground at the 50m.

Reann's Diamond (S Kok) – On jumping shifted out marginally. Raced wide from the 1200m without cover.

Super Leane (R Bishop) – On jumping shifted in. Raced wide from the 1200m without cover. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities

Roulette Star (S Carr) – Had to be restrained at about the 50m after receiving pressure from the outside. Tired and under pressure at the 50m. Trainer S Carr reported the mare would be turned out for a spell.
