Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – SCHWEPPE 2YO MAIDEN– 1000 METRES

Gee Gees Punter (B McCoull) – was momentarily crowded for room near the 100 metres when **Strike Celebration** raced tightly to its outside.

Dehere The Word (T Voorham) – laid-in under pressure in the home straight and as a result could not be ridden out over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Gee Gee Acehigh (S Kok) – raced greenly under pressure in the home straight.

Gee Gee Redhead (S Carr) – threw its head in the air and jumped awkwardly and lost ground at the start.

RACE 2 – NBCF BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 1200 METRES

Ifracombe was declared a late scratching at 2:12pm after suffering an injury to its nose on course prior to the race. **Ifracombe** will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.

West On Broadway (S Kok) – slow into stride.

Gee Gee Queenie (T Baker) – over-raced in the middle stages of the event.

Garland (C Newitt) – slow into stride. When questioned on the apparent disappointing performance C Newitt believed the mare may have had a breathing abnormality during the race.

Epidexios (S Amano) – slow into stride.

RACE 3 – IT'S ALL ABOUTH THE SHOES MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Apologize (M Ulucinar) – slow into stride.

Those Red Colours (N Beriman) – slow into stride.

Jeremiah (T Baker) – raced three-wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

Loladere (C Newitt) – proved difficult to load.

Portrait Painting (E Kacmaz) – had to be steadied off the heels of **Loladere** which had shifted out on jumping. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced for 12 months.

Queen's Needs (S Carr) – over-raced in the early and middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be suffering from atrial fibrillation. **Queen's Needs** will need to undergo a satisfactory ECG after a 1000 metre gallop before racing again.

Apprentice S Kok was reprimanded under AR 137(a) for careless riding in that passing the 1100 metre mark he allowed his mount to shift in when not fully clear of **Queen's Needs**, which had to be restrained away for his heels. In not taking further action stewards acknowledged that the racing manners of **Queen's Needs** had played a part in the incident as it was over racing at the time.

RACE 4 – UNIQUE DOORS & WINDOWS MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Heaven's Venture (B Muhcu) Slow into stride.

Zipponet (C Graham) Tightened and lost its position at the start when Sienna's Quest shifted out.

Bigable (R Bishop) Lost its position when Joe Palooka shifted out on jumping. Held up for clear running at the 300m and again at the 100m.

Trumpcash (N Beriman) restrained from a wide barrier and momentarily held up for clear running near the 450 metres.

Flourishing Future (T Baker) rider dropped offside rein near the 100metres

RACE 5 – AVISO TAS PINK CUP F&M CLASS 3 HCP – 1400 METRES

Acronym (A Patis) Tired over the concluding stages.

Swing It Sister (T Baker) – was inconvenienced at the start when **Flikpix** shifted in on jumping.

Special Moment (I Toker) – raced three-wide without cover until the 600 metre mark.

Berry Wise Fox (B Smith) – over-raced in the middle stages of the event.

Lady Wynette (M Ulucinar) – which began awkwardly over-raced in the early stages.

RACE 6 – OFF THE TRACK BENCHMARK 76 HCP – 1400 METRES

Barjeel (A Darmanin) – slow muster early speed.

RACE 7 – TAB TASMANIAN GUINEAS – 1600 METRES

Clever Charlotte(A Patis) Raced three wide from the 1000 metres.

Tiesto (J Maskiell) was caught wide in the early stages before gaining cover.

Aspirate (R Bishop) – had to be steadied away from the heels of **Our Long Sali** which had shifted out near the 300 metres. Stewards issued A Darmanin a reprimand under AR 137(a) for careless riding. In not taking more severe action stewards took into account the racing manners of **Aspirate** which was inclined to lay in had contributed to the incident.

Stewards inquired into the reasons for **Clever Charlotte** (A Patis) being steadied near the 350 metre mark. R Bishop (**Aspirate**) shifted in when not quite clear of **Clever Charlotte** which was compounding resulting in A Patis having to steady her mount. Stewards issued R Bishop a reprimand under AR 137(a) for careless riding.

RACE 8 – GREAT NORTHER SUPER CRISP BRIGHTON CUP – 2100 METRES

Manilenya (C Newitt) connections advised the mare would be ridden further back. Ridden accordingly.

Bidirectional (A Darmanin) – was slow into stride.

Sentry Duty (R Bishop) – which tailed the field and was beaten a considerable distance underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no apparent abnormalities. Stewards will place a warning on **Sentry Duty's** manners for its uncompetitive performance today.

White Hawk (B Muhcu) – raced three-wide without cover in the early stages.

Perun NZ (E Kacmaz) – raced three-wide without cover from the 900 metres.

RACE 9 – SILK LASER CLINICS CLASS 1 HCP – 1100 METRES

Iron Throne (B McCoull) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the barriers which revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Purple Rider (C Graham) – began awkwardly. After beginning badly Purple Rider slow to muster speed.

Gee Gees Wild One (R Bishop) – commenced to over-race when racing in restricted room near the 700 metre mark.

T Baker rider of **Esta Baby** reported the filly hung-out throughout.
