Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – TAB LAUNCESTON CUP 27TH FEBRUARY MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

The start of this race was delayed as **Jessie's Diva** refused to load and was a late scratching at 6:15pm. **Runaway Girl** was a late scratching at 6:15pm unable to load. Both horses must complete satisfactory barrier trials before racing again.

Maleluji (D Ganderton) – under-went a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not started in a race since the 13th August 2017 and was passed fit to take its place in the field. Jumped awkwardly at the start and shortly after eased off heels. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Starbration (C Graham) – Hung-out at about the 800 metres. Rider C Graham reported the horse raced greenly and hung-out on the home turn.

Brimondo (A Patis) – was re-saddled behind the barriers. Had to be ease at about the 150 metres when **Coal Hill** (I Toker) shifted in abruptly. The horse started to compound on the home turn and started to lose ground. Stewards questioned A Patis on her riding instructions for **Brimondo**, after taking evidence from A Patis she stated that she had drawn barrier 11 and on jumping the horse jumped exceptionally well and she was able to lead with ease, which she had previously not been able to do. However she conceded that she had erred in her judgement on how far in front the mare had lead by due to leading so easily. Stewards accepted her explanation.

Coal Hill (I Toker) – Laid-in about the 1000m. Hung-in under pressure in the home straight. Shifted in abruptly at approximately the 150m.

Jessie's Diva (T Baker) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after hitting the barrier gate when trying to be loaded and was passed fit to run. Refused to load and was a late scratching at 6:15pm. Must complete a satisfactory trial before racing.

Runaway Girl (S Kok) – Refused to load and was a late scratching at 6:15pm. Must complete a satisfactory trial before racing.

RACE 2 – ROY & DORA COGHLAN MEMORIAL MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – 1600 METRES

Beenagem (S Kok) – over-raced and steadied off heels of **Tuki Tuki NZ** near the 1200 metres, when the pace eased.

Gratius (I Toker) – shifted wider on the track over the concluding stages.

Tuki Tuki NZ (S Amano) – was slow into stride. Restrained off heels when **With No Name** jumped outwards at the start

Uncovered (B Muhcu) – was slow into stride and slow to muster early speed. Rider B Muhcu said he was disappointed with the mares run, it was on and off the bit throughout the race. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

With No Name (T Baker) Jumped outwards at the start.

RACE 3 – KEN EVANS MEMORIAL MAIDEN CLASS 1 – 1600 METRES

Fontein Harry (C Newitt) – eased off heels at the 1200 metres.

Rhode Away (A Darmanin) – over-raced about the 1200 metres.

Gee Gee Fiorente (S Kok) – over-raced early stages and caught three-wide without cover.

Need A Bella (B Muhcu) – Rider B Muhcu reported that he accidentally dropped his whip at about the 50m.

Secret Gold (C Graham) – Rider C Graham pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on 9 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 4 more than permitted. C Graham was subsequently fined the sum of \$300. Reprimanded under AR137A(5)(a)(i) for using the whip on consecutive strides prior to the 100m.

Short 'N' Regal (S Amano) – over-raced near the 1200m.

RACE 4 – JACK CHAMBERS BENCHMARK58 HANDICAP – 2100 METRES

Thanos (C Graham) – jumped inwards bumping with **Monmouth** which shifted inwards tightening **Style Guru** which lost its position. Rider C Graham pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on 9 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 4 more than permitted. C Graham was subsequently fined the sum of \$500.

Mag Wheels (B McCoull) – bumped with **Wyuna** when shifting out to improve at about the 500m.

Monmouth (B Muhcu) – jumped outwards and bumped with **Thanos** and then shifted inwards tightening **Style Guru**.

Really Sure (A Patis) – was slow into stride.

Berry Wise Fox (G Catania) – over-raced in the early stages. Shifted out momentarily hampering **C'est Bon** at the winning post on the first occasion.

Style Guru (B Smith) Tightened for room when inconvenienced by **Monmouth** at the start.

RACE 5 – ENSIGN LODGE ALFA BOWL – 1100 METRES

Gee Gee Bay Watch (B McCoull) – Difficult to load. Broke free and travelled a short distance before being caught. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to take its place in the

field. At the start **Gee Gee Bay Watch** jumped inwards and bumped with **Rebeccabianca**. Fractious in the barriers. Laid-in on the home turn. A warning was placed on the geldings loading manners.

Astrabrook (T Voorham) – laid-out on the home turn. Hung-out home turn and then in the home straight.

Deroche (C Newitt) – Rider reported that it raced greenly throughout and didn't handle tonight's track surface.

Little River Miss (A Darmanin) – raced three-wide without cover.

Zinstar (B Muhcu) – Difficult to load. Was caught wide throughout. Warning placed on the fillies loading manners.

RACE 6 – CRAIG HANSON MEMORIAL OPEN HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Step The Pedal (T Baker) – rider reported that he would have liked more pace in the race.

Speedonova (C Newitt) – rider C Newitt reported that the mare had a tendency to lay in and didn't appreciate the firm track.

Happy Halloween (R.Bishop) – rider R.Bishop reported that when put under pressure in the home straight the gelding failed to respond to his vigorous riding.

RACE 7 – RAY TRINDER MEMORIAL BENCHMARK58 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Lazy Democracy (B Smith) was a late scratching at 8.00pm after cutting it's nose in the tie up stalls. After under going a pre-race veterinary inspection of the gelding a veterinary certificate is required before the next start.

Col's Hero (S Kok) Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages. Rider S Kok was severely Reprimand under AR137(a) careless riding for allowing his mount to shift out at about the 100m. Causing **Speedy Illusion** (D Ganderton) to check his mount.

Merciabelle (T Baker) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Millmount (B Muhcu) – Jumped inwards shortly after jumping inconveniencing Emsgem, which was hampered and had to be restrained to avoid the heels of Speedy Illusion.

Emsgem (A Patis) – A Patis reported that she wasn't ready when the barriers released and that her horses head was turned inwards. **Emsgem** jumped inwards at the start and bumped with Speedy Illusion. Shortly after was inconvenienced when **Millmount** jumped inwards and was restrained to avoid the heels of **Speedy Illusion**. Had to be restrained off heels at about the 800m.

Kepta (A Darmanin) – Over-raced in the middle stages.

Speedy Illusion (D Ganderton) – Jumped outwards and bumped with **Emsgem**. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Checked off heels at about the 100m.

RACE 8 – CARRICK PLATE CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

A delay on correct weight occurred when the rider of **Sir Simon** (T Baker) wished to view the official photo finish. Stewards gave correct weight as rider T Baker was satisfied that the judges numbers were correct.

Shenanigator (R Bishop) - Jumped outwards at the start and bumped with **Om Nom**

Silent Bid (C Newitt) – Jumped in at the start and was slow to muster early speed. Restrained off heels of **Totally Wicked** at about the 1000m.

Sir Simon (T Baker) – Jumped outwards at the start.

Totally Wicked (C Graham) – Jumped out at the start hampering **Shenanigator** and **Om Nom**.

Om Nom (I Toker) – Stewards approved rider I Toker to ride 1kg over the allotted minimum weight. Hampered between **Totally Wicked** and **Shenanigator** shortly after jumping. Restrained off heels of **Sir Simon** shortly after.

RACE 9 – LAUNCESTON CUP JANSZ CORPORATE MARQUEE BENCHMARK72 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

Gone Girl (C.Newitt) – rider reported that the mare over-raced and pulled hard throughout the event. Steadied off heels of **Ivoryman** at about the 1200m when over-racing.

Submit Another (G Catania) – Jumped outwards at the start and restrained off heels of **Ivoryman** shortly after. Rider C Catania reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout.
