### **RACE 1 – WILLAMS ADAMS CAT CLASS A HANDICAP– 1000 METRES**

**Bonjour Belle** (B Smith) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after suffering a minor injury to its near side hip area and was passed fit to compete.

**Gem Hunter** (D Schmitt) – Carried wider on the home turn by Mindy, which was hanging out.

**Mindy** (C Newitt) – Hung out on the home turn.

### **RACE 2 – KING ISLAND SEAFOODS CLASS A HANDICAP– 1200 METRES**

**Skip** (J Philpot) – Tailed the field in the early stages of the event. When queried, apprentice J Philpot stated that the gelding was reluctant to race in the field. Skip then ran on over the concluding stages.

**Lemilkey** (M Ulcinar) – Steadied on the home turn when racing in restricted room inside Valcurl. Stewards inquired into the reasons of Lemilkey being checked and having to be steadied on the home turn. After taking evidence from rider R Mangan (Valcurl) and M Ulcinar (Lemilkey) stewards determined that M Ulcinar had attempted a run where there was sufficient room to the inside of Valcurl, however his mount resented racing in the restricted room and he elected to steady. Stewards advised both riders to exercise care.

### **RACE 3 – TASPORTS CORPORATION– 1400 METRES**

**Ex Words** (R Mangan) – Slow to begin. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**Skyshark** (C Newitt) – Slow to begin. Shifted out under pressure approaching the winning post.

**Skwosh** (B Smith) – Slow to begin. Carried marginally wider by Skyshark, approaching the winning post. Apprentice B Smith accidentally dropped her whip near the 100 metres.

### **RACE 4 – ERN CHITTS BRACELETT CLASS B HANDICAP– 2200 METRES**

**Stanfield Carus** (R Mangan) – Inclined to over race in the early stages.

### **RACE 5 – HARDINGS HOTMIX CLASS A HANDICAP– 1600 METRES**

**Cheer Up Charlie** (J Luxe) – Blundered on jumping.

**Jimena** (B Smith) – Became fractious in the barriers was examined by the on course vet and passed fit to run. Subsequent to this Jimena again became fractious before being removed from the gates undergoing a further pre-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be suffering from a laceration and therefore she was declared a late scratching at 4.20pm. Stewards issued a warning on the barrier manners of this mare for being fractious in the gates. A veterinary certificate of soundness must be submitted prior to Jimena racing again.
