Apprentice Breaana Smith was replaced on her rides tonight after receiving an injury from the TTC Wednesday nights meeting. Miss Smith was advised that she must submit a medical certificate prior to riding again.

Jockey Anthony Darmanin advised that he would not be able to fulfil his riding engagements after riding in Race 1 today as he was unwell. On course ambulance attendants and doctor assessed Mr Darmanin. Stewards were advised that Jockey Darmanin was dehydrated and not in a fit state to continue riding at today's meeting. Mr Darmanin was advised that he must submit a medical certificate prior to riding again.

RACE 1 – TAB HOBART CUP FEB 10TH – CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Permission was granted for Jockey Mehmet Ulucinar to ride **Joe Palooka** one kilogram over the gelding's allotted minimum weight.

Pymble (B Muhcu) – Laid in over the concluding stages.

Lord Derby (N Beriman) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Rider Nikita Beriman stated that the gelding failed to respond to her riding and never travelled well throughout. A post-race veterinary examination of **Lord Derby** failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Purple Rider (C Newitt) – Slow into stride. Jockey Craig Newitt reported that the gelding did not handle today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary inspection of **Purple Rider** failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer Cameron Thompson advised Stewards that **Purple Rider** will now be retired.

Arving (S Kok (a)) – Momentarily held up near the 400 metres.

Shinvada (A Darmanin) – Stewards spoke with Trainer J Luttrell on the improved performance of Shinvada. Mr Luttrell stated that the mare was back in distance and over a distance that better suits. He also stated that the mare is highly strung and he has doubled the mares work load due to the mares behaviour.

Joe Palooka (M Ulucinar) – Laid in near the 350 metre mark and then for the remainder of the race.

RACE 2 – LITTLE BEE FAMILY DAY FEB 8TH – MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 3YO & UPWARDS – 1100 METRES

Banca Syd (R Bishop) – Shifted in on jumping, bumping with **Gee Gee Runaway**. Caught three wide without cover in the early and middle stages. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the home straight. Rider R Bishop was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground inwards.

Gee Gee Runaway (S Kok (a)) – Raced in restricted room passing the 400 metre mark after receiving pressure from his outside and had to be steadied by its rider.

Loladere (C Newitt) – Caught four wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

Saint Laura (T Voorham (a)) – Hampered shortly after the start when **Banca Syd** shifted out.

RACE 3 – SILK LASER CLINICS FOTF CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to strong winds which loosened the bill-board signage in the home straight. All bill-boards were removed and the start times for the remainder of the race meeting went back one race. This information was disseminated via social media and the Course Broadcaster prior to the start of this race.

Correct weight was delayed when Jockey Troy Baker, the rider of the second placegetter **The Auditor**, asked to view the official patrol film. After doing so Jockey Baker was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Nidoking (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride.

The Auditor (T Baker) – Hampered near the 200 metres when attempting a tight run between **Levissi** and **Gee Gee Pengala** when **Tough Rubble** shifted out marginally.

Tough Rubble (R Bishop) – Jumped awkwardly and was then slow into stride.

Gee Gee Pengala (S Kok (a)) – Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

Geegees Cash Cow (I Toker) – Rounding the home turn, was held up for a clear run before shifting to the inside. Ismail Toker reported that his saddle slipped near the 100 metres.

Miss Iso was declared a late scratching at 2.00pm as there was no available rider. Prior to the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered all monies invested on **Miss Iso** to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 2.00pm were to be paid less three cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less three cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket.

RACE 4 – AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS – BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

Barjeel (J Maskiell) – Jason Maskiell stated that when placed under pressure the gelding failed to run on. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

The Decider (S Carr) – Over-raced in the early stages. Sigrid Carr reported that the gelding shifted out abruptly at the start inconveniencing **La Dernier Fille** and **Cunning Fox**. Rider Carr added that **The Decider** then wanted to lay out throughout the race.

Somerset (N Beriman) – At about the 200 metres, shifted inwards inconveniencing **Geegees Gran Lodge**. Nikita Beriman was advised that she must stop and straighten her mounts earlier than she had done on this occasion.

RACE 5 – SEPPELT ELWICK STAKES – LISTED – SET WEIGHTS – 2YO – 1100 METRES

The start of the race was delayed three minutes due to the late scratching of **Gee Gee Bay Watch**.

Gee Gee Bay Watch (S Kok (a)) – Gee Gee Bay Watch which broke away on two occasions and galloped some distance, was withdrawn by order of Stewards at 4.13 pm. Prior to the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered all monies invested on **Gee Gee Bay Watch** to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 4.13 pm were to be paid less six cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less eight cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket. The connections were advised that prior to starting again, **Gee Gee Bay Watch** must trial to Stewards' satisfaction in an organised trial due to its pre-race manners.

Gee Gees Punter (S Carr) – Jumped awkwardly and was then hampered when **Strike Celebration** shifted in.

Gee Gees Darl (T Baker) – On jumping, shifted in abruptly, inconveniencing **Mileytude**.

Strike Celebration (C Newitt) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Momentarily held up for a clear run on the home turn.

Mileytube (N Beriman) – Raced three wide without cover until approximately the 600 metres. Rider Nikita Beriman reported that her mount blundered and almost fell at about the 450 metre mark putting her at a disadvantage. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities with the filly. Stewards spoke to Race Track Manager, Sam Webster, and showed him the official patrol films of the incident and requested immediate remedial attention to that section of the track before the next race.

RACE 6 – TAB STAKES – STANDARD WEIGHT FOR AGE – 1200 METRES

Hellova Street (J Maskiell) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Lord Da Vinci (S Carr) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Amaword (R Bishop) – Ryan Bishop was harmlessly dislodged from the gelding en-route to the barriers and was examined and passed fit by the on-course paramedics prior to the start of the race. Rider Ryan Bishop was reprimanded under AR137A(5)(a)(i) for using his whip on consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

Magnasa (C Newitt) – Shifted out on jumping.

RACE 7 – GREAT NORTHERN SUMMER CUP – STANDARD WEIGHT FOR AGE – 2200 METRES

Count da Vinci (NZ) (S Carr) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was passed fit to take its place in the field after sustaining a slight abrasion to its off-side hip en-route to the track today. Jumped awkwardly at the start.

Settler's Stone (S Kok (a)) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Bidirectional (J Maskiell) – Jason Maskiell reported that **Bidirectional** travelled OK but once the gelding hit the softer going at the 600 metres, failed to respond. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Speed Force (B McCoull) – Brendon McCoull reported that **Speed Force** travelled OK but once the gelding hit the softer going at the 600 metres, failed to respond.

Jodi Nicole (C Graham (a)) – Chris Graham reported that **Jodi Nicole** travelled OK but once the mare hit the softer going at the 600 metres, failed to respond.

RACE 8 – SALTERS HIRE MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – SET WEIGHTS - 1600 METRES

Silent Bid (C Newitt) – Slow into stride.

Sir Simon (S Carr) – Slow into stride. Crossed **Heaven's Venture** about the 1200m. Stewards advised Sigrid Carr to exercise more care when shifting ground in the future.

Beenagem (T Baker) – Slow into stride. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Heaven's Venture (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride. Bumped with **Bonduel Lily** at about the 600 metres.

Pinkeyes Pride (E Kacmaz) – Steadied near the 1200 metres when crossed by **Sir Simon** (Sigrid Carr) when not quite clear. Stewards advised Sigrid Carr to exercise more care when shifting ground in the future.

Poole Harbour (S Kok (a)) – Laid out at about the 1400 metres.

Bonduel Lily (A Patis (a)) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow into stride. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Bumped with **Heaven's Venture** at about the 600 metres

Style Guru (NZ) was declared a late scratching at 2.00pm as there was no available rider.

Race 8 – Devonport Cup – 1880 metres

Rider Raquel Clark (Speed Force) pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using her whip on 9 occasions prior to the 100 metres, which is 4 more than permitted. R Clark was subsequently fined the sum of \$200.

Tasmanian Turf Club – Wednesday, 23 January 2019

Race 5 – Thousand Guineas – 1600 metres

Stewards questioned Jockey Craig Newitt about the tactics adopted on **Our Long Sali**. C Newitt stated that from a wide draw he was obliged to race back in the field where he was able to obtain cover, however, he was still racing three wide. He then improved into the race from the 500 metres and shifted wider to obtain clear running and ran home well. He also stated that it was the connections riding instructions to ride further back. Stewards noted his comments.
