Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – DELORAINE FOOTBALL CLUB MAIDEN/CLASS 1– 2100 METRES

He's Rushin' (S Carr) – Rider S Carr was queried on the disappointing performance. S Carr stated that the gelding had to work hard in the early stages from a wide barrier and then raced outside the lead and did not finish off the race in the home straight. Stewards noted her comments.

Uncovered (B Muhcu) – Inconvenienced at the start when Style Guru shifted out.

Secret Gold (C Graham) – Rider C Graham advised to exercise care when shifting ground. In that upon leaving the home straight on the first occasion he shifted in abruptly to the outside of Roger Verbal Kint. C Graham was also advised to exercise care on the home turn when he allowed his mount to shift out when not fully clear of Short 'N' Regal. He then shifted further and momentarily tightening the running of Pinkeyes Pride.

Furrenzy (E Kacmaz) - Stewards queried the improved performance. Co-trainer T Hanson stated that Furrenzy is suited by racing over distance and she had changed nothing in the mares work leading up to today's event. Rider E Kacmaz was issued a reprimand under AR137(a) for careless riding, in that after passing the 400 metre mark he elected to shift in near the 400 metre mark to obtain a clear run to the inside of Rhode Away when not fully clear of Roger Verbal Kint. Roger Verbal Kint had to be steadied away from Furrenzy's heels. In not taking more severe action Stewards took into account the evidence from apprentice S Kok that his mount, after initially being tightened was then inclined to shift out wider on the track, contributing to the extent of the interference.

Pinkeyes Pride (T Baker) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover.

Bonduel Lily (A Patis) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow into stride.

Short 'N; Regal (D Ganderton) – Permission given to be ridden 1kg overweight. Jumped awkwardly. Steadied off heels on the home turn.

RACE 2 – CRESSY CRICKET CLUB MAIDEN– 1400 METRES

Poolside Hendrick (S Kok) – Proved difficult to load. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a puncture wound to the near side heel.

Starbration (C Graham) – Dropped whip near the 400 metre mark. Clipped heels entering the home straight, dislodging rider C Graham. An inquiry into the reasons for the rider falling was adjourned until C Graham is available. C Graham was stood down from his remaining engagements with a suspected fracture to his finger. He was transported to hospital for precautionary xrays.

Crackthebubbly (D Ganderton) – Hampered on jumping when Need A Bella shifted out. Had to be severely checked near the 300 metres to avoid the fallen rider.

Jessie's Diva (S Carr) – Slow into stride. Checked to avoid the fallen rider entering the home straight.

Oh So Needy (C Newitt) – Slow into stride.

RACE 3 – BISHOPSBOURNE CRICKET CLUB HCP– 1400 METRES

Enzian (D Ganderton) – Slow into stride.

Shot Of Irish (T Voorham) – Approaching the 100 metres shifted in under pressure and had to be steadied when Bosphorus shifted out to obtain a clear run.

The Master Speed (E Kacmaz) – Resaddled behind the barriers prior to the start of this event.

Shenanigator (R Bishop) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow into stride.

Concentrate (G Catania) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Island Pirate (A Darmanin) – Jumped awkwardly. Held up for a clear run on the home turn and again held up over the concluding stages.

RACE 4 – BRIDGNORTH FOOTBALL CLUB MAIDEN– 1200 METRES

Coal Hill (I Toker) – Jumped awkwardly. Slow into stride. Shortly afterward was inconvenienced by Who's The Rider which jumped outwards. Raced greenly in the early and middle stages. Raced wide without cover throughout. Stewards queried rider I Toker on the performance of Coal Hill. He stated that the horse raced greenly throughout and he believes the horse to be field shy. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality could be detected.

Gee Gees Liberty (S Kok) – Apprentice S Kok was reprimanded under AR137(c) – for a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post.

Jaymara (C Newitt) – Jumped awkwardly and was inconvenienced at the start when Gee Gees Liberty shifted out.

Nahla (T Baker) – Jumped awkwardly and blundered prior to being restrained off the heels of Buzzered which had shifted out on jumping. Held up for clear running at the 100 metres.

Who's The Rider (R Bishop) – Inclined to lay in under pressure in the home straight.

Honky Tonk Girl (G Catania) – Resaddled behind the barriers prior to the start of this event. Rider reported the filly was unable to maintain contact with the field in the early and middle stages despite her riding.

RACE 5 – CROSSFIT AGEMA GYM 2YO MAIDEN– 1100 METRES

A Darmanin (Sidorova) was dislodged on route to the barriers. The clubs medical officer performed precautionary checks of A Darmanin, clearing him to ride.

Astrabrook (T Voorham) – Carried wider on the home turn when Little River Girl shifted out.

Magic Styx (R Bishop) – Rider reported the saddle slipped at the 800 metre mark.

Oh So Innocent (T Baker) – Slow into stride. Tailed the field throughout. Rider T Baker reported that the filly was making respiratory noises. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality could be detected.

GENERAL

All riders submitted breath analysis tests at tonight's meeting.

All races after race 3 were put back 1 race due to a delay with thunderstorm activity. Prior to race 6 being called out onto the track Stewards again delayed the running of this event due to thunderstorm activity.

At approximately 10PM Stewards postponed the remainder of tonight's races due to continual thunderstorm activity.
