Comments / Explanations:

Trainer J Blacker was fined \$50 for the late notification of his rider in race 1.

Apprentices L Riordan and S Kok and Jockey J Maskiell were fined \$200 under AR160B(3) for having mobile phones present in the jockey's area.

RACE 1 – TASMANIA'S OWN REDLINE OPEN HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

Shot Of Irish (S Carr) – Lay in in the home straight. Rider S Carr explained that the gelding lay in in the home straight however could offer no further explanation for the performance. When questioned trainer S Brunton stated that the gelding may not have been suited by its first try over the 1600 metre distance today, and in his view the gelding's race manner may have been detrimental to its performance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected.

Gone Girl (C Newitt) – Rider C Newitt reported that the mare failed to respond to his riding, and that in his opinion was not suited to the soft track conditions.

RACE 2 – GEE GEE HORSE STUD MAIDEN– 1100 METRES

Brimondo (A Patis) – Approaching the finish was inconvenienced and carried wider by Jayemara which shifted out under pressure.

Iowna (E Kacmaz) – Shortly after the start was restrained when tightened for room between Buzzambo and Jayemara (C Newitt) which shifted in. C Newitt was advised to exercise care when permitting his mount to shift ground.

Jayemara (C Newitt) – Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

Nahla (T Baker) – Rider T Baker reported that in his opinion the mare may be better suited to a firmer track than today's.

Saint Laura (T Voorham) – Over raced in the early and middle stages, raced wide without cover throughout.

Mountain Music (D Thornton) – Near the 900m was inconvenienced by Leeuwin (A Darmanin) which shifted in. A Darmanin was advised to exercise care when shifting ground. Rider D Thornton stated in his opinion that the filly may be better suited to a firmer track surface than today's.

RACE 3 – WILLIAM SHEILDS MEMORIAL MAIDEN– 1400 METRES

Brundah Bob (G Catania) – Connections advised will attempt to be ridden further forward. Settled mid field.

Stormont (L Riordan) – Slow into stride.

Gee Gees Keylargo (S Kok) – The saddle slipped forward near the 1000 metres placing rider S Kok at a severe disadvantage and as a result the gelding was eased down in the home straight.

On Sunshine (A Patis) – Rider A Patis stated that the mare lay in in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer V Poke advised that the mare will now be retired.

Who's The Rider (S Carr) – Rider S Carr stated that the mare raced greenly and would benefit from the addition of blinkers.

Need A Bella (T Baker) – Slow into stride.

RACE 4 – LITTLE BEE EDUCATION AND CARE CLASS 1– 1200 METRES

Little River Boy (S Carr) – Underwent a veterinary examination at the barrier which revealed a minor amount of blood in its mouth however was passed suitable to race. Approaching the 100m layed out toward the heels of Alfred Street and had to be steadied. Performed below expectations. Rider S Carr stated that the gelding failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure in the home straight and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer J Luttrell stated that the gelding may be better suited to a firmer track surface than today's.

Our Artie (T Voorham) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages

Geegees Cash Cow (I Toker) – Stood flat footed was slow into stride 4L, a warning has been issued on the mare.

Emsgem (A Patis) – Attempted to buck shortly after the start. A warning was issued. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider A Patis stated that it was her intention to find cover however after the mare raced ungenerously in the early stages it then commenced to race keenly and she elected to race wide.

Knitting (B Muhcu) – Performed below expectations. Rider B Muhcu stated that the gelding dipped in the going near the 500 metres and then failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure.

RACE 5 – CARBINE CLUB PLATE– 1200 METRES

Hatrick Hero (R Bishop) – Raced wide throughout the event.

Oh So Needy (B Muhcu) – Lost a near side winker in running.

RACE 6 – AUSTRALIAN NAVY BENCHMARK58 HANDICAP– 1600 METRES

Stewards delayed correct weight as the incorrect placings were semaphored with number 7 (Geegees Granlodge) being incorrectly displayed as third placegetter. After consulting with the judge this was corrected to number 11 (Super Leanne) and correct weight was declared.

Forever Alone (C Graham) – Near the 300 metres momentarily tightened between Pelagia and The Decider (J Maskiell) which shifted out. J Maskiell was advised to exercise care. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after pulling up slightly distressed which revealed the gelding to have a slow recovery rate.

The Decider (J Maskiell) – Performed below expectations. Rider J Maskiell explained that the gelding travelled well during the run however failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure in the straight. Stewards will follow up with Trainer S Brunton regarding the gelding's performance.

Mulley's Idol (C Newitt) – Rider C Newitt explained that it had not been his intention to lead however after being caught wide and with a slow early tempo the gelding raced keenly and he allowed it to stride forward.

Hirvonen (A Patis) – Late scratching 9:35am, on veterinary advice. A veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again. Trainer Mr J Luttrell advised that the gelding would most likely be retired.

Lokitin (R Mangan) – Commenced awkwardly throwing its head in the air and losing ground. Momentarily held up rounding the home turn. Rider R Mangan pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii), in that she used her whip on eight occasions prior to the 100metres which is 3 more than permitted. R Mangan was subsequently fined the sum of \$200, in determining penalty stewards took into account R Mangan's good record, guilty plea and that she won the race.

Frisco Dame (B Muhcu) – Failed to leave the barriers and took no part in the event. The mare must now trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing again, trainer Mr G White advised that the mare would now be retired.

RACE 7 – SCHWEPPE'S TASMANIAN DERBY– 2200 METRES

Aspirate (R Bishop) – Underwent a veterinary examination on 5 February 2019 after sustaining a laceration to the near shoulder and was subsequently deemed suitable to race. After arriving on course underwent a veterinary examination and was passed suitable to race. Trainer R Hamer advised that would attempt to ride the gelding further back than at its most recent start. Had to be re-plated after arriving on course. Became fractious and reared in its barrier underwent a veterinary examination and was passed suitable to race which delayed to start. Trainer R Hamer advised that the gelding would now be spelled

Fagin's Touch (A Darmanin) – Raced wide throughout

Heir Of Tavistock (D Thornton) – Performed below expectations. Rider D Thornton could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected.

Swing It Sister (T Baker) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected.

RACE 8 – SEPPELTBOW MISTRESS– 1200 METRES

Life On The Wire (J Maskiell) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Rider J Maskiell pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A (5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 8 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 3 more than permitted. J Maskiell was subsequently fined the sum of \$600. In determining penalty stewards took into account that this was a group race, J Maskiell's record and that he won the race.

Gee Gee Double Dee (T Baker) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

Miss Norway (L Currie) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Performed below expectations rider L Currie explained that the mare may not have been suited by today's track conditions and in his opinion may benefit from the removal of blinkers. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected.

Miss Iano (B Park) – Performed below expectations rider B Park stated that the mare was disappointing and failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected.

My Bidy (B McCoull) – Eased down over the final 200 metres. Rider B McCoull stated that he felt something was amiss with the mare's action and as such did not ride the mare out to the finish of the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected.

Scrutineer (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride.

Speedonova (C Newitt) – Approaching the 100m was brushed by Miss Norway which shifted out under pressure.

RACE 9 – YAK ALES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP– 2100 METRES

Thanos (C Graham) – Performed below expectations, rider C Graham stated that the gelding layed out for the majority of the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected.

Don Pellegrino (J Maskiell) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.

Bareel (T Voorham) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn.

King Manu (G Catania) – Connections advised that the gelding would be ridden further forward if it begins well with the removal of blinkers. Raced in a handy position.

Monmouth (B Muhcu) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Rider B Muhcu stated that the gelding pulled hard during the event which was detrimental to its performance today.

Furrenzy (E Kacmaz) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn.

Really Sure (A Patis) – Raced wide throughout. An inquiry has been adjourned into the whip use of rider A Patis to allow her representation.
