Comments / Explanations:

Trainer T Keys was fined \$100 for the late notification of her riders.

Four riders underwent urine tests.

RACE 1 – DRUMMOND GOLF F&M BENCHMARK 64 HCP– 1100 METRES

Miss Smith (C Newitt) – Trainer J Luttrell was fined \$50 for presenting the mare to the mounting yard without its tongue tie.

Quick Quill (A Patis) – Performed below expectations. Rider A Patis explained that she had been instructed to ride the mare positive however it failed to muster early speed and got back in the field further than intended. A Patis added that the mare failed to respond when placed under pressure. Trainer S Carr confirmed the instructions and added that she expected a forward showing tonight and was disappointed with the mare's performance. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Gee Gee Rich Ruby (T Baker) – Rider T Baker stated that the mare was inclined to lay in in the home straight.

Party Planner (T Voorham) – (*Second place*), Prior to correct weight, rider T Voorham viewed the official photo, after doing so T Voorham was satisfied with the judge's placings.

Ansaam (E Kacmaz) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 2 – BALMORAL ON YORK C&G MAIDEN– 1100 METRES

Needs A Scotch (T Baker) – Rider T Baker explained that he had been given no firm instruction other than to ride the gelding where comfortable. After being beaten for early speed, he then obtained cover behind the leaders. T Baker added the gelding which was racing without blinkers for the first time, then commenced to over race in the early and middle stages and when placed under pressure from the 400 metres failed to respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off fore and a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing. Trainer C Roach advised that he would not continue on training the gelding.

Gee Gee Runaway (B McCoull) – Rider B McCoull stated that on pulling up the gelding made some unusual respiratory sounds. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Miltons (G Catania) – Rider G Catania stated that the gelding raced greenly.

Little Raven (C Newitt) – Late scratching at 5:15pm on veterinary advice after lacerating its near hind leg in the float en-route to the course.

RACE 3 – EASTER GOOD FRIDAY FAMILY FUN TWILIGHT C&G BENCHMARK 64 HCP– 1100 METRES

Invincible Rock (C Newitt) – Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt could offer no explanation for the disappointing performance, other than the gelding should derive benefit from the run as it was first up since the 19th of December 2018. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Speedy Illusion (D Ganderton) – Rider D Ganderton stated that the gelding was inclined to lay out in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a very slow recovery with mild thumps. A veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again.

Vengeance of Fury (T Voorham) – Commenced awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 4 – FOOT & PLAYSTED PRINTERS F&M– 1100 METRES

Buzzered (C Newitt) – Inclined to lay in in the home straight.

Flannie (T Voorham) – Rider T Voorham dropped her offside rein approaching the 100 metres.

Stellartie (S Tsaikos) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Gee Gees Lovebeer (T Baker) – Rider T Baker stated that the filly may be better suited on tracks with more give.

Miss Bossey Belle (C Graham) – Late scratching at 7.53pm after the filly was unable to be loaded. This delayed the start. Stewards ordered all monies invested on Miss Bossey Belle to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 9.00 pm were to be paid less two cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less two cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket. Connections were advised that the filly must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

Still A Star (S Carr) – Rider S Carr stated that the filly which was having its first start, over raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 5 – FINAL NOGHT RACE MEETING SATURDAY 6TH APRIL CLASS 1– 1400 METRES

Pymble (C Graham) – Rider C Graham explained it had not been his intention to lead, however after being caught wide in the early stages he elected to push forward as he did not want to be caught wide without cover.

Needs Amore (C Newitt) – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

Arving (B Muhcu) – Underwent a veterinary examination at the barrier and was passed suitable to race. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Passing the 400 metres, steadied when momentarily tightened between Needs Amore and Dobell.

Fontein Harry (S Tsaikos) – Underwent a veterinary examination at the barrier and was passed suitable to race. Had difficulty obtaining clear running between the 200 metres and 100 metres.

Totally Wicked (E Kacmaz) – Commenced awkwardly and was slow into stride. Over raced in the early and middle stages. Ridder E Kacmaz stated that after not beginning well, the gelding got further back in the run than intended.

Roulette Star (T Baker) – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have injured its right eye in running, and a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again.

RACE 6 – PRESTIGE BOOKBINDERS BENCHMARK 58 HCP – 1200 METRES

Forever Alone (C Graham) – Passing the 100 metres, carried outwards by Little Pumba (T Voorham), who shifted out under pressure. T Voorham was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Our Artie (S Tsaikos) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Passing the 100 metres, brushed with Jupiter's Moon and shifted inward toward the heels of Forever Alone which had been taken out by Little Pumba.

Gee Gee Pureblonde (A Patis) – Rider A Patis stated it was not her intention to lead, however after beginning well, the gelding took up a more forward position than intended.

O'loughlin (M Ulucinar) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have blood present at both nostrils. Connections were advised of the provisions of AR79(4) in that O'loughlin may not be trained, exercised or galloped on any race-course for a period of two months and it may not start in any race for a period of three months and then only after a satisfactorily gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a steward. Trainer J Hill advised that he would now evaluate the gelding's racing future.

Pontypaul (S Carr) – Late scratching at 9.00pm on veterinary advice. Stewards ordered all monies invested on Pontypaul to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 9.00 pm were to be paid less eleven cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less ten cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket.

Little Pumba (T Voorham) – Trainer C Roach was fined \$50 for presenting the gelding to the mounting yard with the incorrect gear. Lay out in the home straight.

Ipotane (T Baker) - Trainer T Keys was fined \$50 for presenting the filly to the mounting yard with the incorrect gear. Late scratching at 9.01pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in the barrier. This delayed the start. Stewards ordered all monies invested on Ipotane to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 9.01 pm were to be paid less four cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less four cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket. Connections were advised that the gelding must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again. A veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again.

RACE 7 – ANZAC EVE RACE MEETING BENCHMARK 72– 2100 METRES

Gallow Gate (T Voorham) – Over raced in the early stages. Performed below expectations, rider T Voorham could offer no explanation for the disappointing performance other than the gelding failed to respond to her riding. Trainer J Blacker will be contacted in the coming days to see if any matter has arisen with the gelding which may have affected its performance.

Sentry Duty (S Carr) – Steadied at the 800 metres when Reann's Diamond (B Muhcu) shifted out. Rider S Carr stated that the gelding raced flat and failed to respond to her riding from the 800 metres. Trainer A Duggan advised that the gelding would now be retired.

Pelagia (C Newitt) – Rider C Newitt pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres, which is 1 more than permitted. C Newitt was fined the sum of \$500. In determining penalty, Stewards took into consideration C Newitt's guilty plea, record and totality of his whip use.

Don Pellegrino (M Ulucinar) – Slow into stride.

One Way Ticket (NZ) (C Graham) – Approaching the 400 metres, shied and became unbalanced.
